### حول هذا السجل


يبدأ الملف بنشرة سرية (برقم مرجعي S-279 لعام ١٩٣٩) من ترانشارد كرافن ويليام فاول (المقيم السياسي في الخليج)، بتاريخ ٣٠ مارس ١٩٣٩ من المقمية البريطانية والقنصلية العامة ببوشهر. النشرة موجهة إلى الوكلاء السياسيين بالبحرين والكويت ومسقط وتطلب منهم إرسال ملخصات أسبوعية لأي مواد إخبارية تتعلق بمناطقهم تكون قد وردت في البث العربي لمحطات الإذاعة الأجنبية.

يتكون الجزء الأكبر من الملف من عدد من الملخصات الإخبارية باللغة الإنجليزية لنشرات عربية تعبر في أغلبها عن آراء مناهضة لبريطانيا، وكان قد تم بثها من محطات إذاعة أوروبية وشرق أوسطية إلى المستمعين في دول الخليج. معظم الملخصات مأخوذة عن راديو برلين وتتضمن أخبار عن هجرة اليهود إلى فلسطين الواقعة تحت السيطرة البريطانية، وأخبار عن برقية سلام من الرئيس روزفلت إلى هتلر في ١٤ أبريل ١٩٣٩. يوجد أيضاً ملخصان موجزان عن فلسطين من وجهة النظر


البريطانية وقد أخذها عن إذاعة إمبايير سيرفيس (أو راديو دافينتري) المنتمية لهيئة الإذاعة  
البريطانية (بي بي سي) بإنجلترا.

يظهر الرقم المرجعي '1.1-a' على برقتيين في الملف (ff.17-18). وهو يعود على ملف ذو صلة في نفس السلسلة. توجد أيضًا إشارة إلى جزء معينه من الملف في ملاحظة بخط اليد على غلاف الملف نصها: "رجاء مراجعة ملف III.1-25/a للمراسلات المستقبلية". ولكن يبدو أن ذلك الجزء من الملف قد ضاع أو تلف.



Berlin began broadcasting in Arabic since the evening of 25th April. On that evening the broadcast was mostly about Palestine and Syria, and most of the messages, about 5 or 6 in number, are <sup>said</sup> to be from Baghdad. An announcement was also made about Hitler's speech on the 28th as taking place at 12 O'clock and that all German factories and works will stop for 90 minutes to listen to the speech.

Last evening the broadcast was also about Palestine and Syria but in addition a great deal was devoted to the Dubai disturbances which they said were caused by the British.

On both evenings I have missed listening to it but many of those who listened say that they have recognised the voice of the announcer as that of a certain Yunus Bahrani better known as "As-Sayih el-Iraqi" i.e. the Iraqi Traveller who, as his title signifies, is said to have travelled a great deal and is a newspaper correspondent and was some months ago Radio announcer at Baghdad. Mention was made of some Oman Shaikhs by name. Qatar and nine Oman states which were spoken about as being "The ten protectorates" (British Protectorates) were mentioned. P.A.'s air trip to Dubai was also mentioned as being for the purpose of protecting British Indians. It was also said that great disturbances are expected to happen there.

Something like the following was also said:-

"Some newspapers write that Germany has promised Turkey that in the event of war Germany will try to return Syria, Palestine, Iraq and other parts of Arabia to Turkey. These reports are false and have been started by the British to create hatred for Germany in Arab countries."


The announcer, unlike the Arabic announcers of London, Italy and France, pronounced all names of persons and towns correctly thus showing himself to be not unfamiliar with persons and towns of the trucial coast.

1. The Jewish immigration in Palestine is increasing rapidly owing to the attitude of the British Govt & which has given permission to the Jews to enter Palestine without prospects. The Jews are given shelter & home in the midst of the Arab land; & it is a matter of life & death to the Arabs. Where is the justice? And where is the truth? Is it not a shame that the Arab territory is wrested from the Arabs & handed over to the Jews?

BAGHDAD :-

Indistinct re\_cception on the 23rd April, to the effect that as in the days of Turkish rule the Gulf States were attached to Iraq the Iraqi Home Minister is seeking means of taking action against the Shaikh of Kuwait for killing three persons and imprisoning members of the Majlis in "Iraqi" Kuwait.

BERLIN :-

(i) On the 25th April the announcer made a statement rejecting President Roosevelt's "interference" in European politics, and attacking British policy in Palestine and India, and French policy in Syria.

(ii) He refuted a rumour that Germany intended to restore Syria, Palestine, Iraq and other Arab countries to Turkish rule, as having been started by the British to create hatred for Germany in Arabic countries.

(iii) On the 26th April, he spoke of the Dubai troubles as having been fermented by the British. He said that the Political Agent's visit was on the pretext of protecting British Indian subjects, and that by such methods the British were extending their protectorate over the Trucial Coast States (from a list of which he omitted Abu Dhabi) and Qatar.

(iv) He said that "Sir" Sultan bin Saqr had agreed to return Shaikh Mani' to Dubai, and that Shaikh Mani' had done so, his followers having been killed by Shaikh Sa'id.

The Arabic papers have expressed the opinion that - the speech of Hitler is a straightforward forward reply to President Roosevelt's speech.


A French paper (name was clear) says that Hitler's speech has allayed the anxiety which was prevalent in the world. According to Italian press the speech has been received with ~~some~~ utmost satisfaction by smaller countries. By the Spanish newspapers it has been described as a speech based entirely on truths. The German papers are of opinion that - President Roosevelt should had better confine himself to what concerns U.S.A.

2. An Italian newspaper writes that - the conclusion drawn by it from the article in a French newspaper is that France & England are preparing for an attack on Germany & Italy.


3. A goodwill pact - ~~long-awaited~~ concluded today in Tehran between Turkey, Iraq, Iran & Afghanistan.



1. Usual news about Palestine.
2. The Jerusalem correspondent of the Times, London, reports that the Berlin Arabic broadcast did not in the least interest the Arabs in Palestine. His message was on Monday whilst the Arabic broadcast from Berlin only began on Tuesday. The broadcast has so annoyed the British that there is no wonder we find them in such confusion. The Berlin Arabic broadcast has been opened with the purpose of telling the whole world what is really going on in the Arabian countries and not as is shown through British binoculars.
4. A message from Cairo says that the French have offered the district of Aleppo in Syria to Turkey to induce her to join the democratic powers in case of war.

Italy.

1. Same as No. 4 above with the addition of the British and French instead of the French, and also "but Turkey is sympathetic with the Arabs".
2. Much resentment is felt in Egypt about the rumours started by the British, French and Jews in Egypt against Italy and Germany. The Egyptian paper "Al-Misri" says that we have nothing against Italy and Germany for which we may be in enmity with them. Egypt has been asked by her ally before to make sacrifices which she did, and now she is being asked to sacrifice the blood of her youth in a war in which she has no interest. Our friendship with Britain is not that of one Government with another but of one people and another. Egypt will not agree to plunge herself into the fire of a volcano in eruption.


