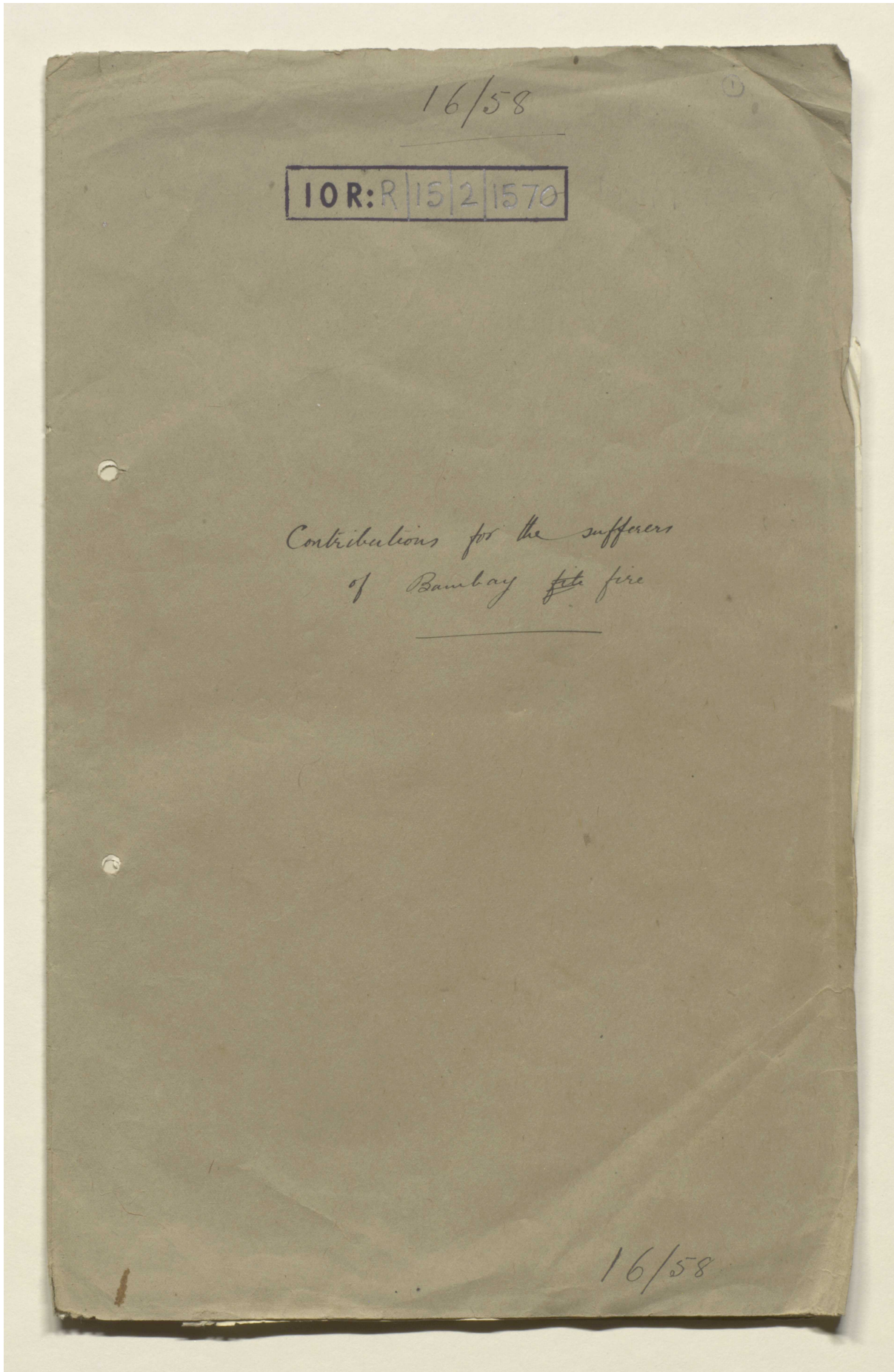

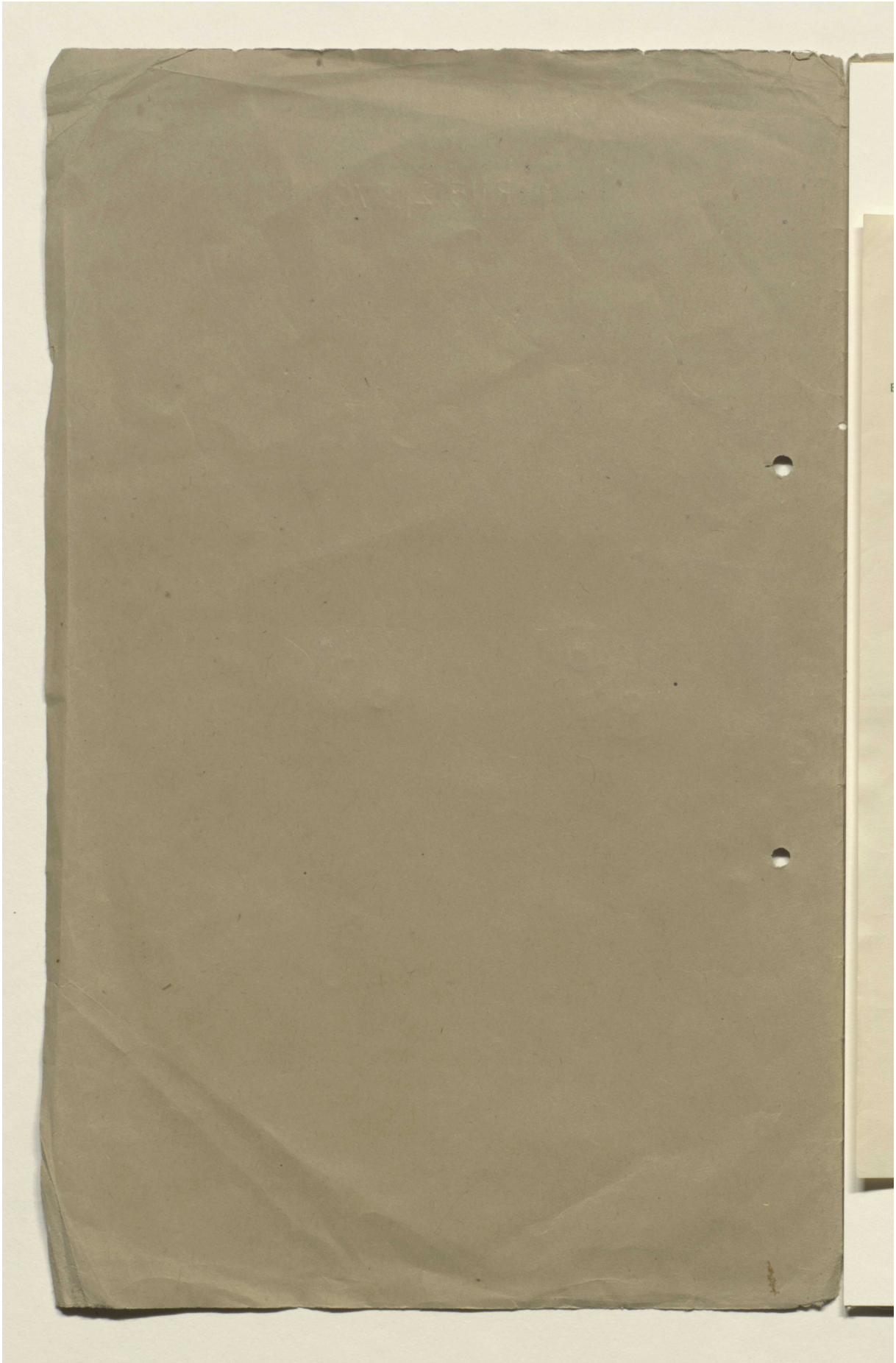
About this record

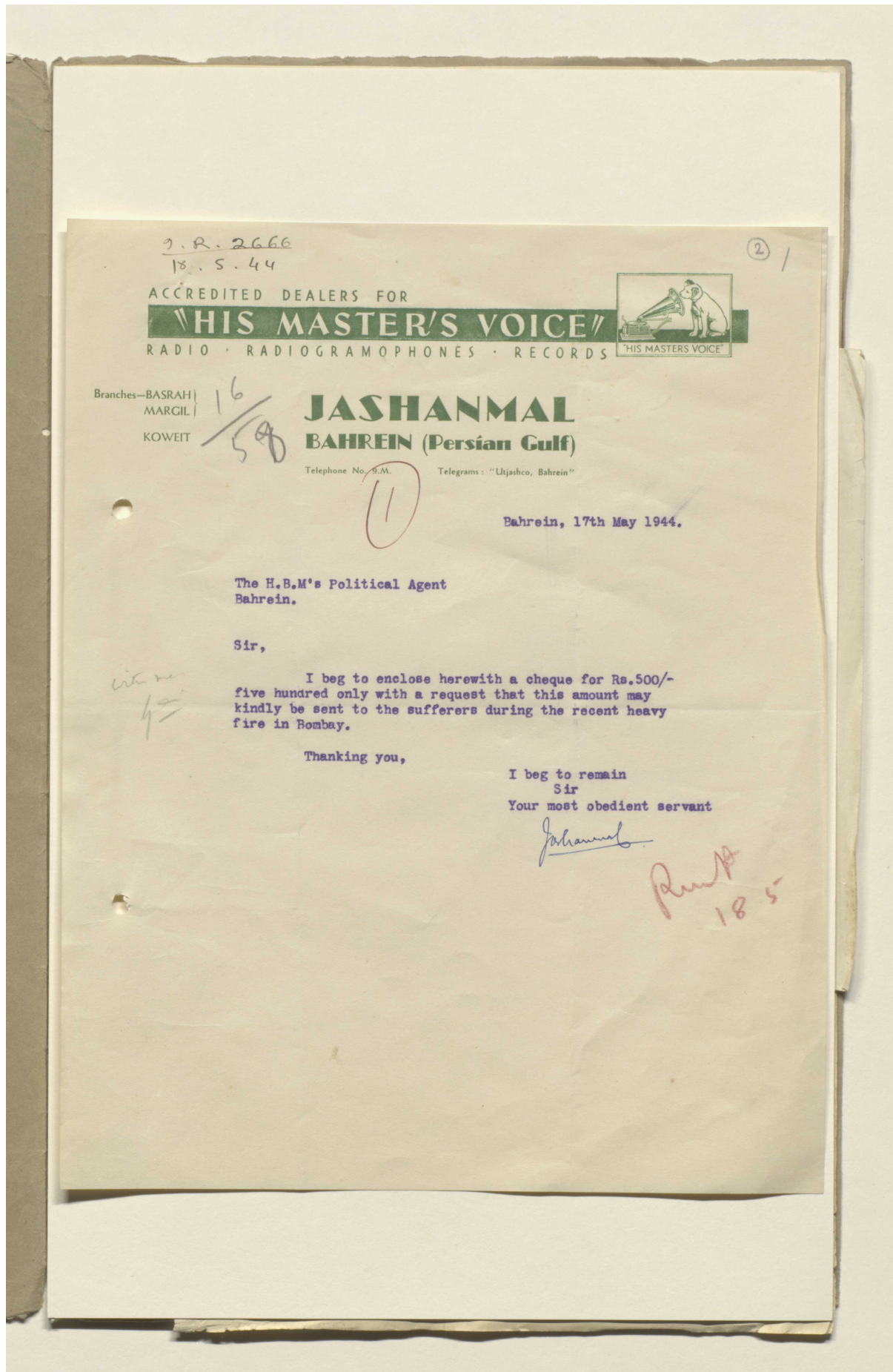
'16/58 Contributions for the sufferers of Bombay fire' [front] (1/16)



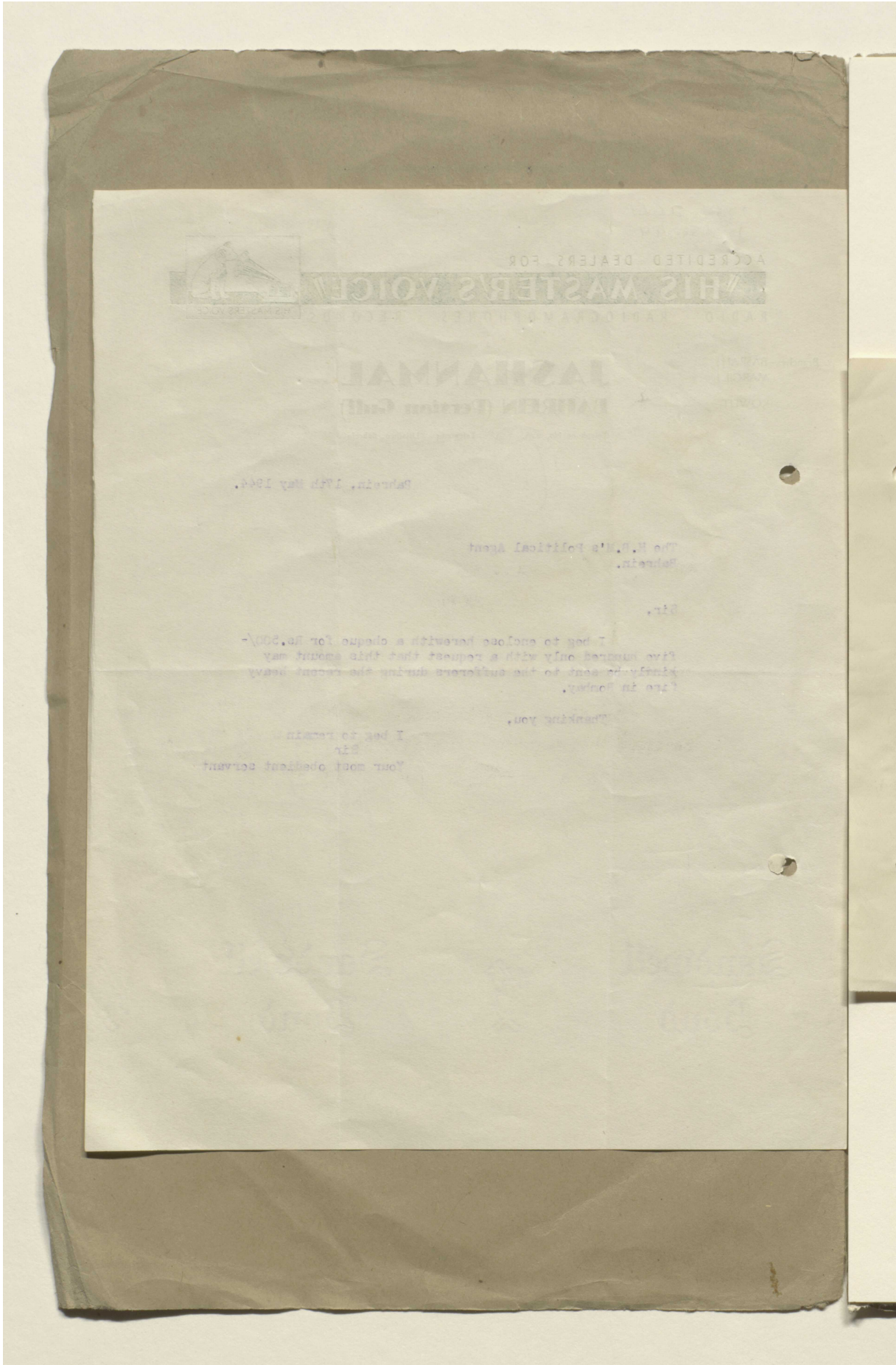
'16/58 Contributions for the sufferers of Bombay fire' [front-i] (2/16)



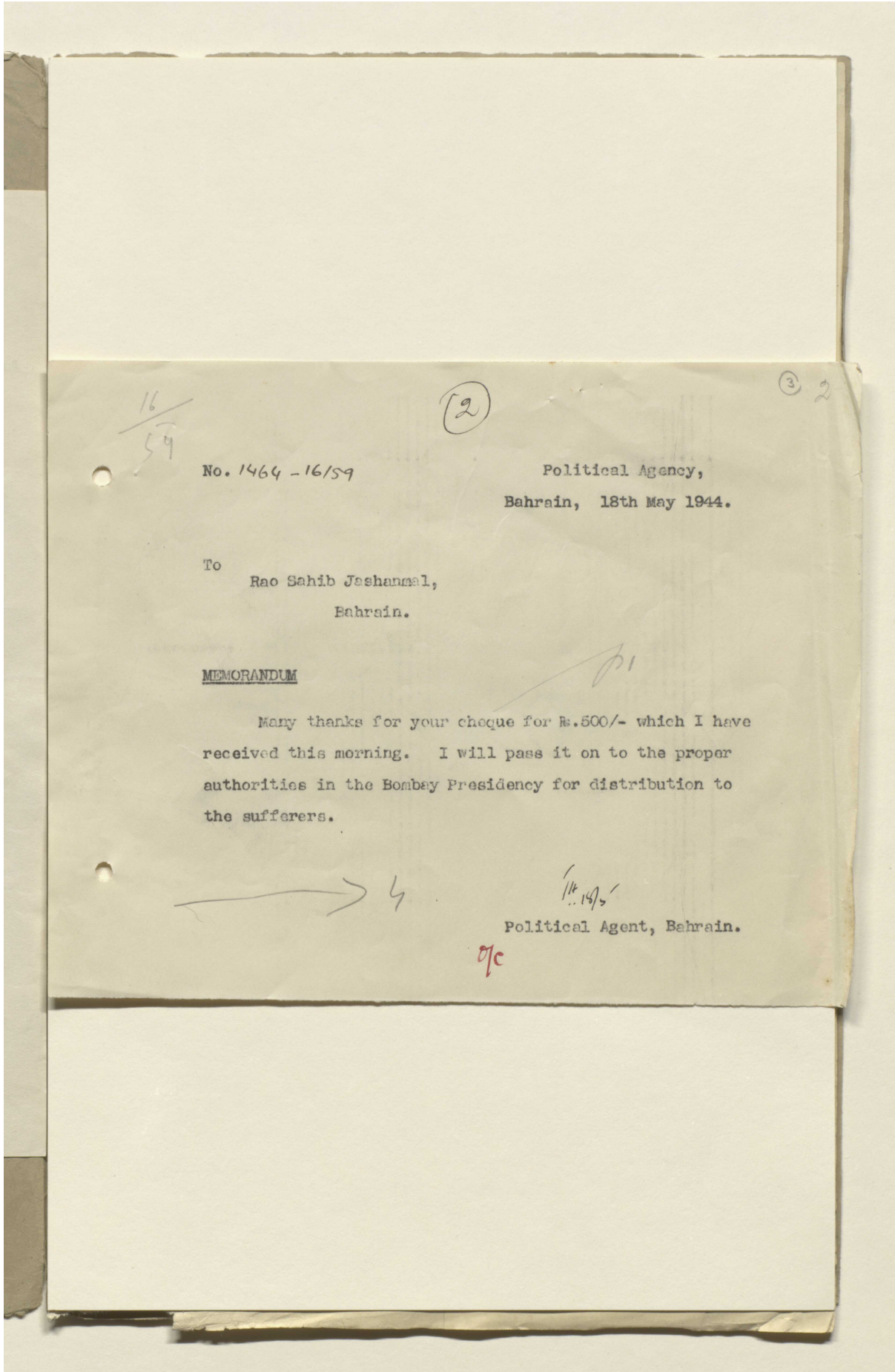

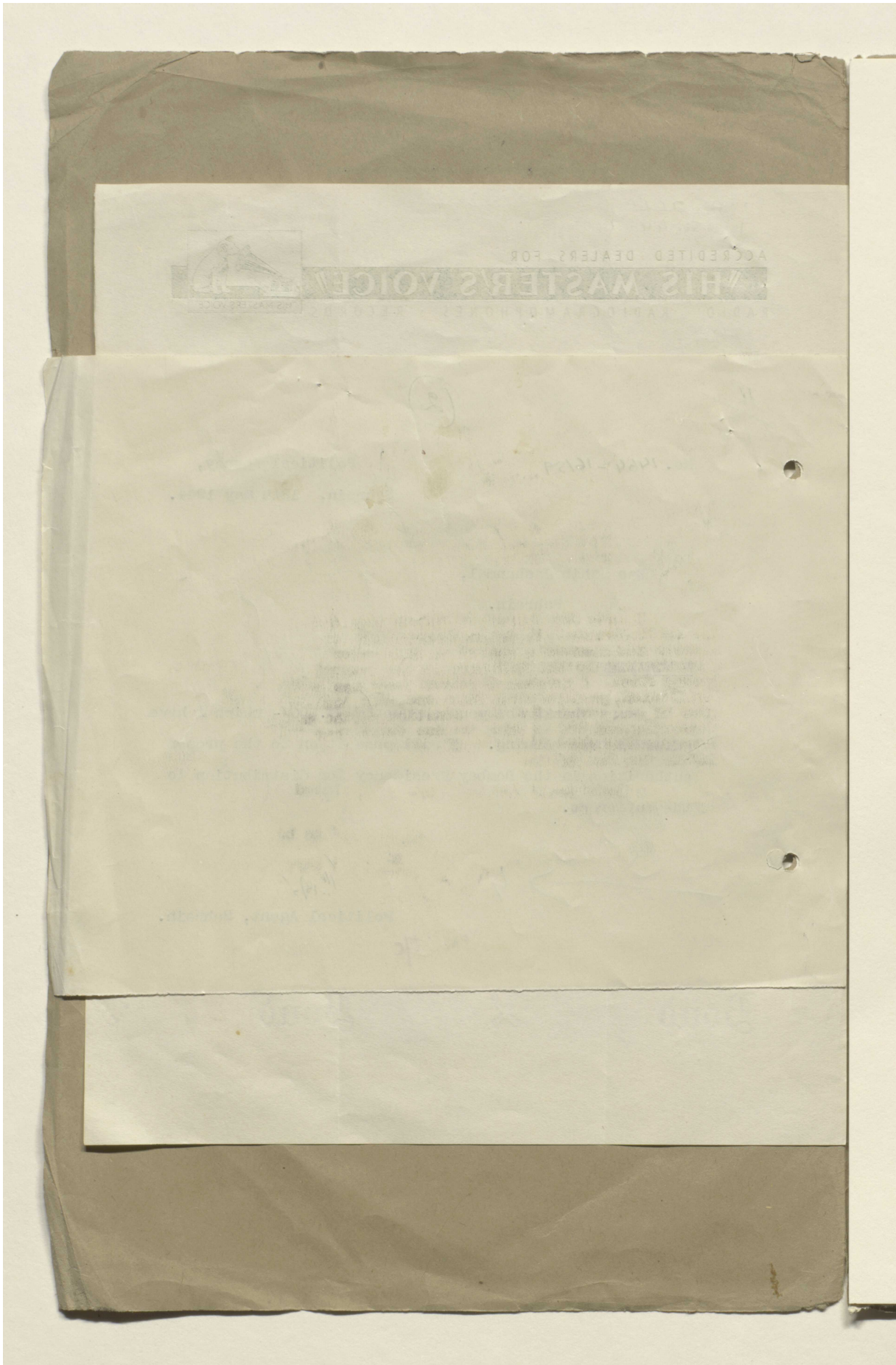

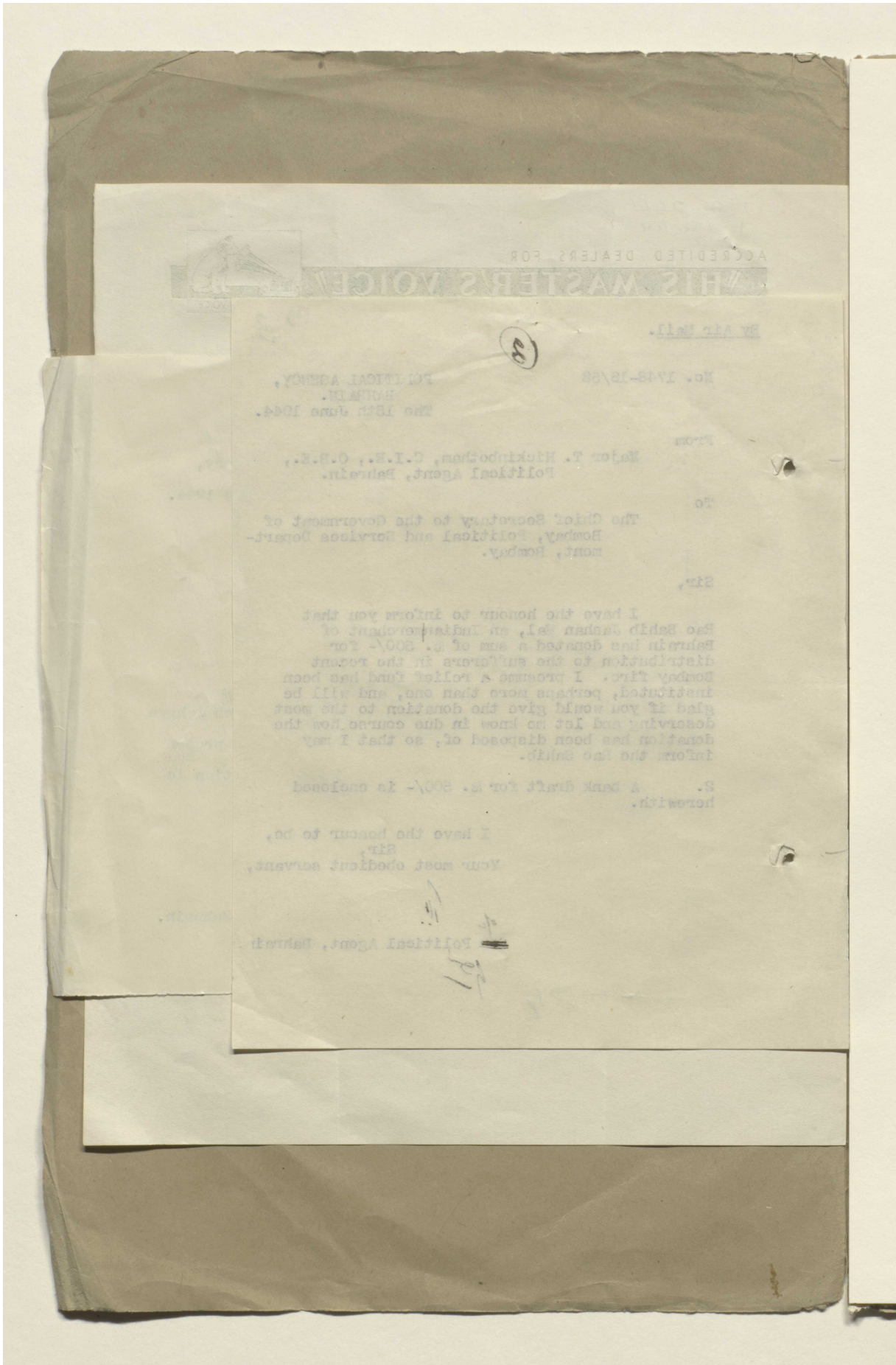
I have the honour to inform you that

herewith.

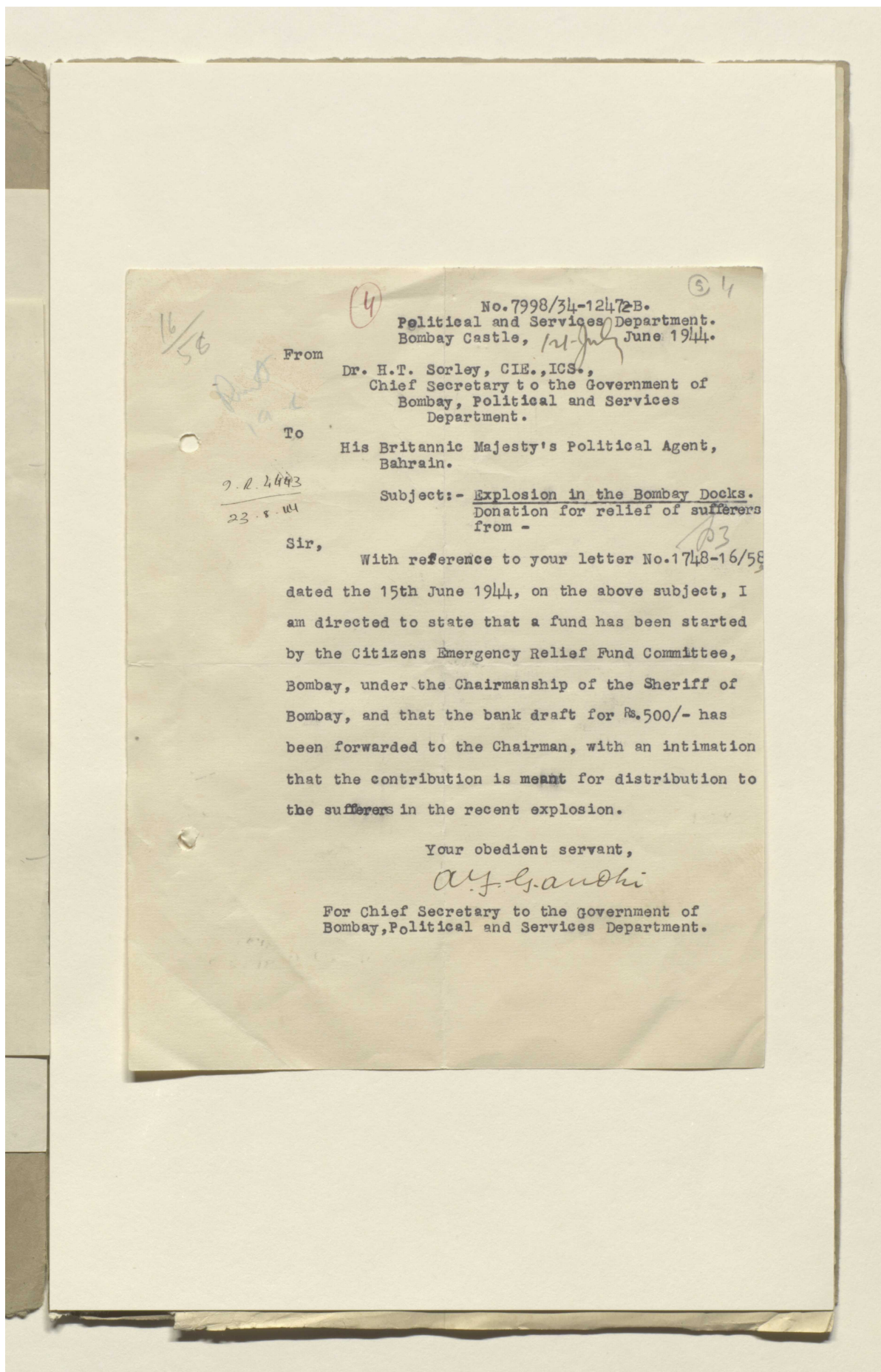

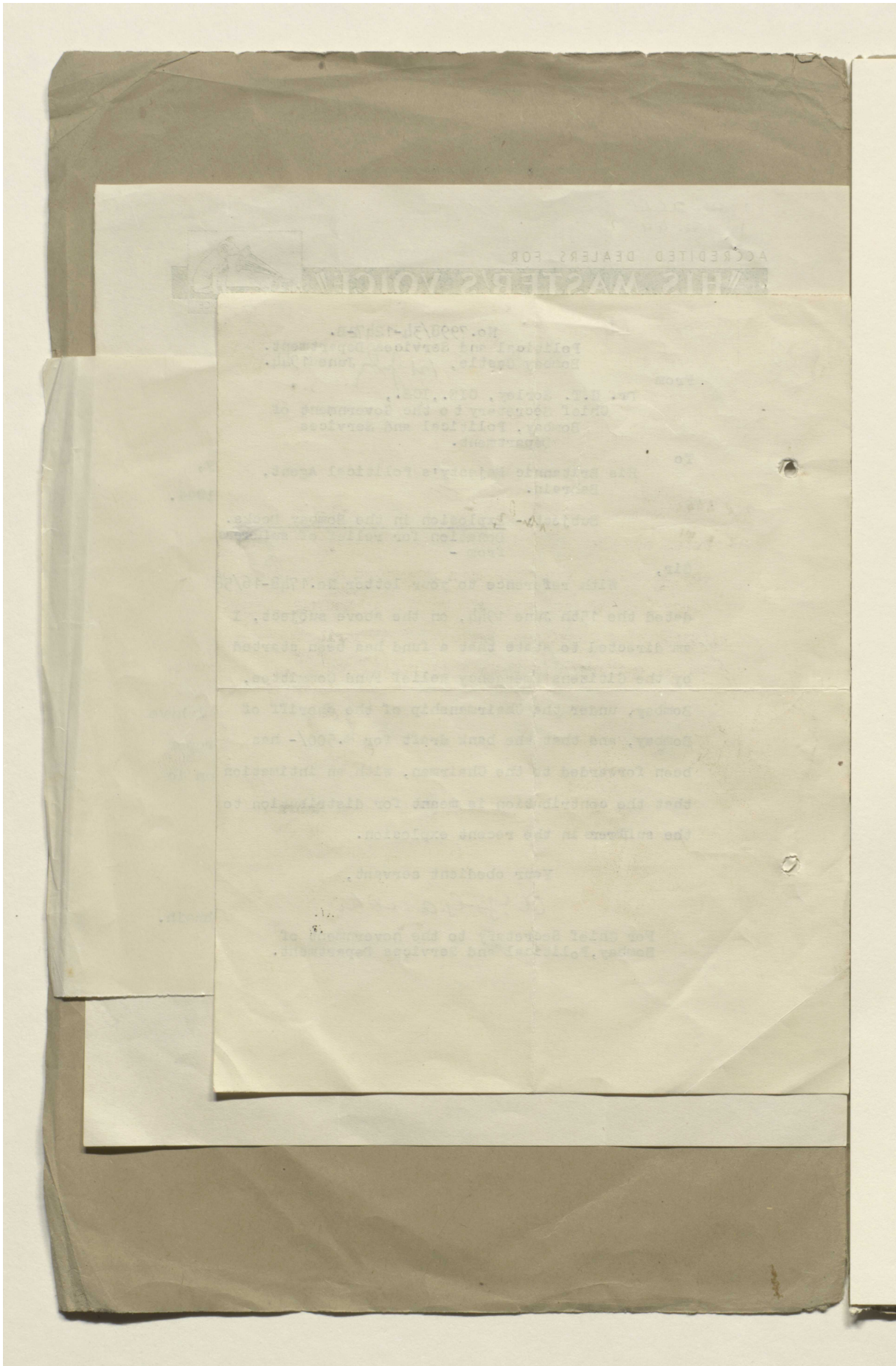
