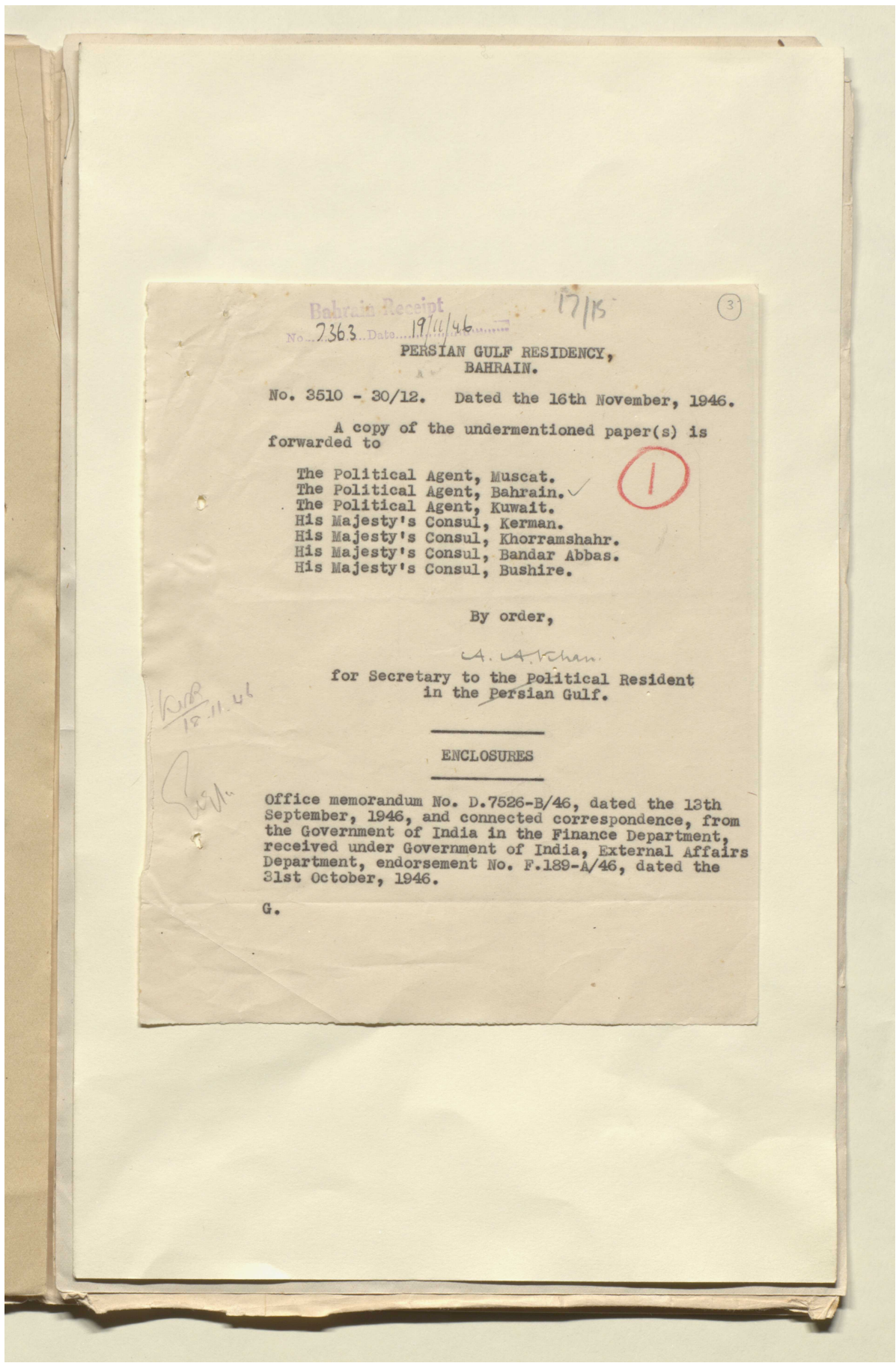

RESOLUTION.

Simla, the 13th May 1937.

No.D.3139-F.--- The Governor General in Council has had under consideration the question of the continuance of the advances at present admissible to Government servants employed under the Central Government under the rules in Chapter 9 of the Civil Account Code, Volume I. In view of the fact that the circumstances, under which provision for the grant of most of these advances was made, no longer exist, and also of the facts that the price of mechanical conveyances (e.g., motor cars, motor cycles, etc.) has fallen considerably in recent years, and that they can now be purchased on the instalment system, the Governor General in Council is pleased to direct that the grant of the advances referred to in Articles 155, 156, 157, 158 and in clause (j) of Article 159 of the Civil Account Code, Volume I, shall be discontinued from the date of this Resolution in the case of persons entering Government service after that date and from the 1st March 1938 in the case of others.

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Gazette of India.

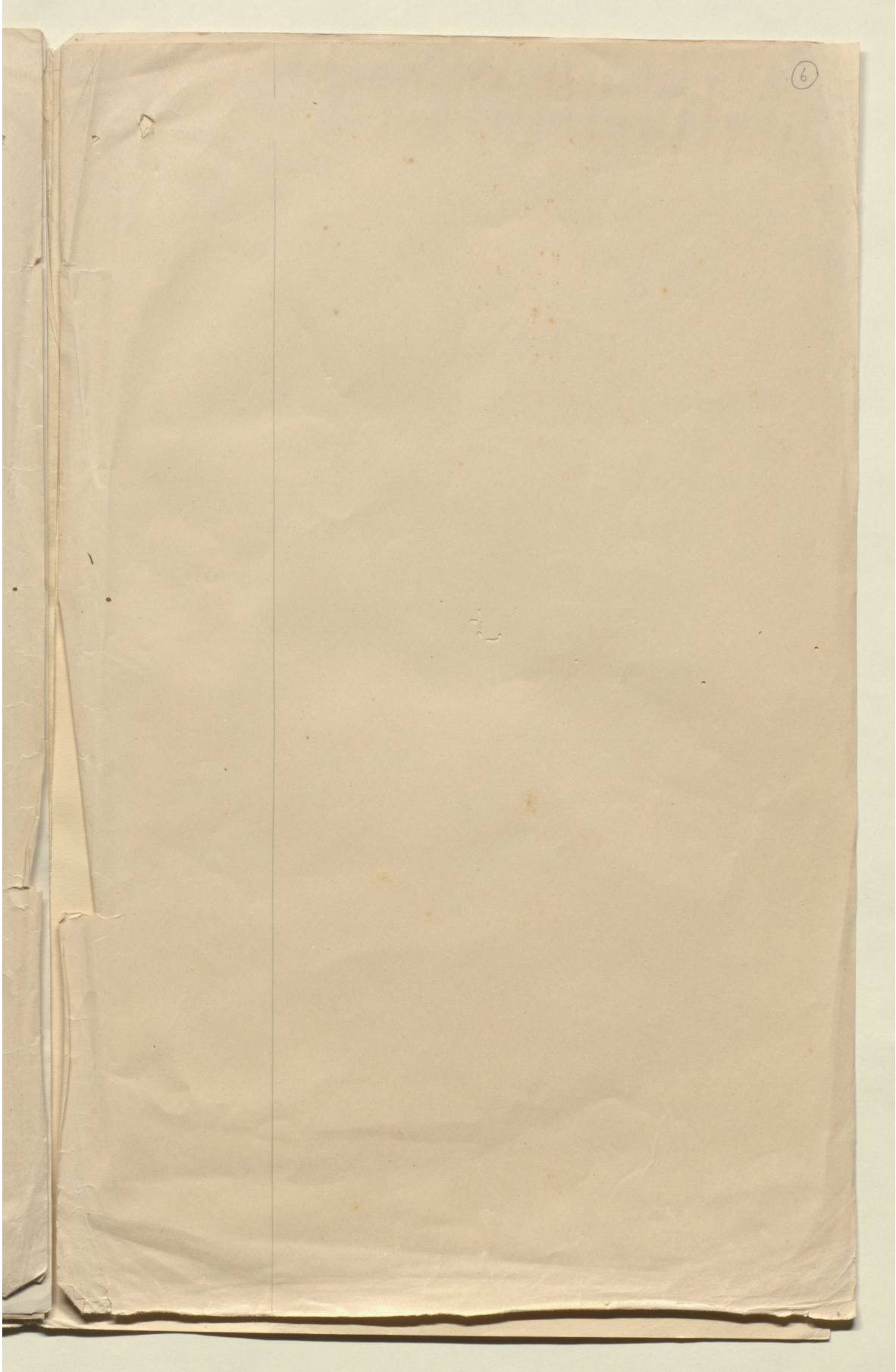

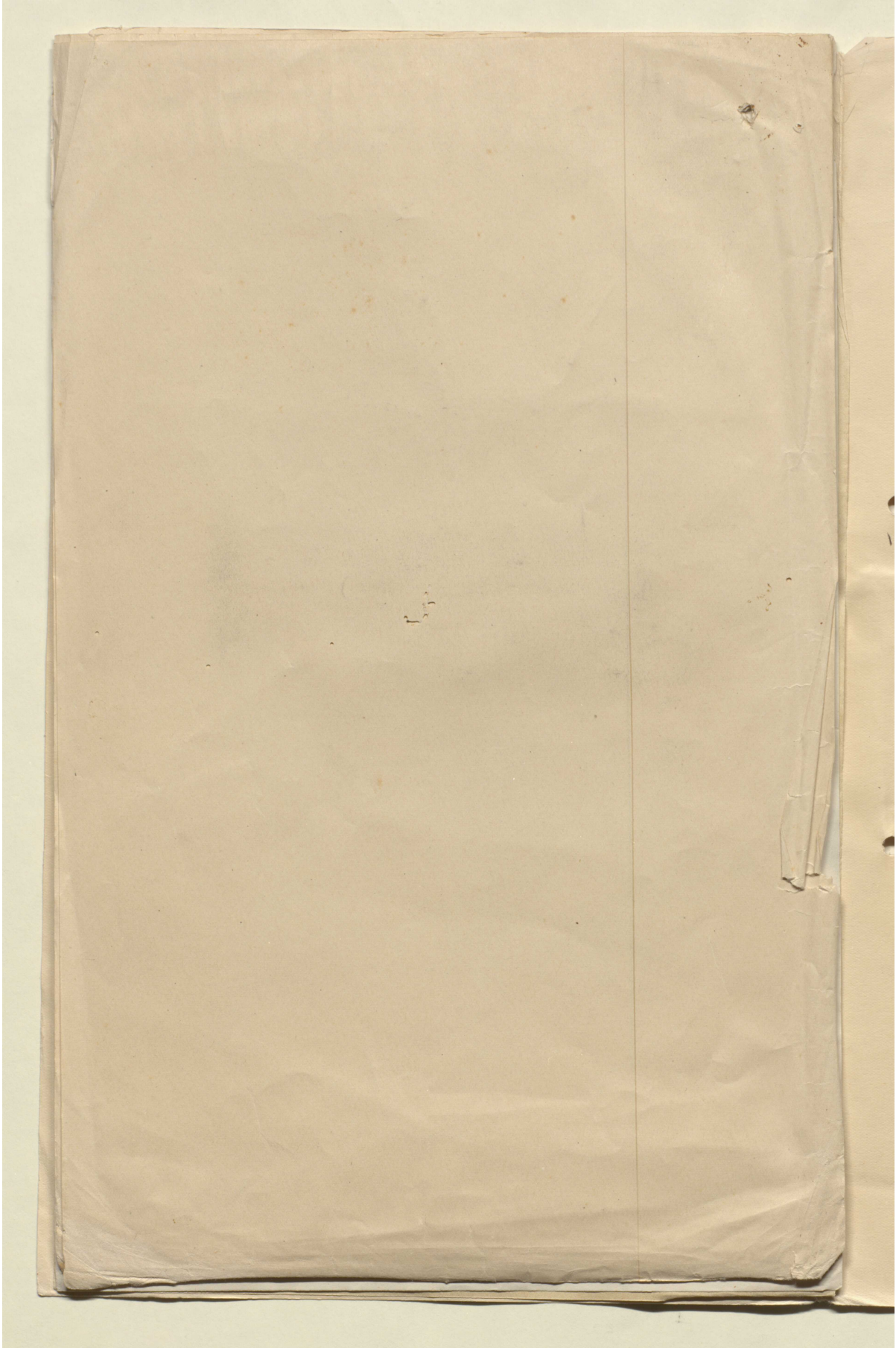

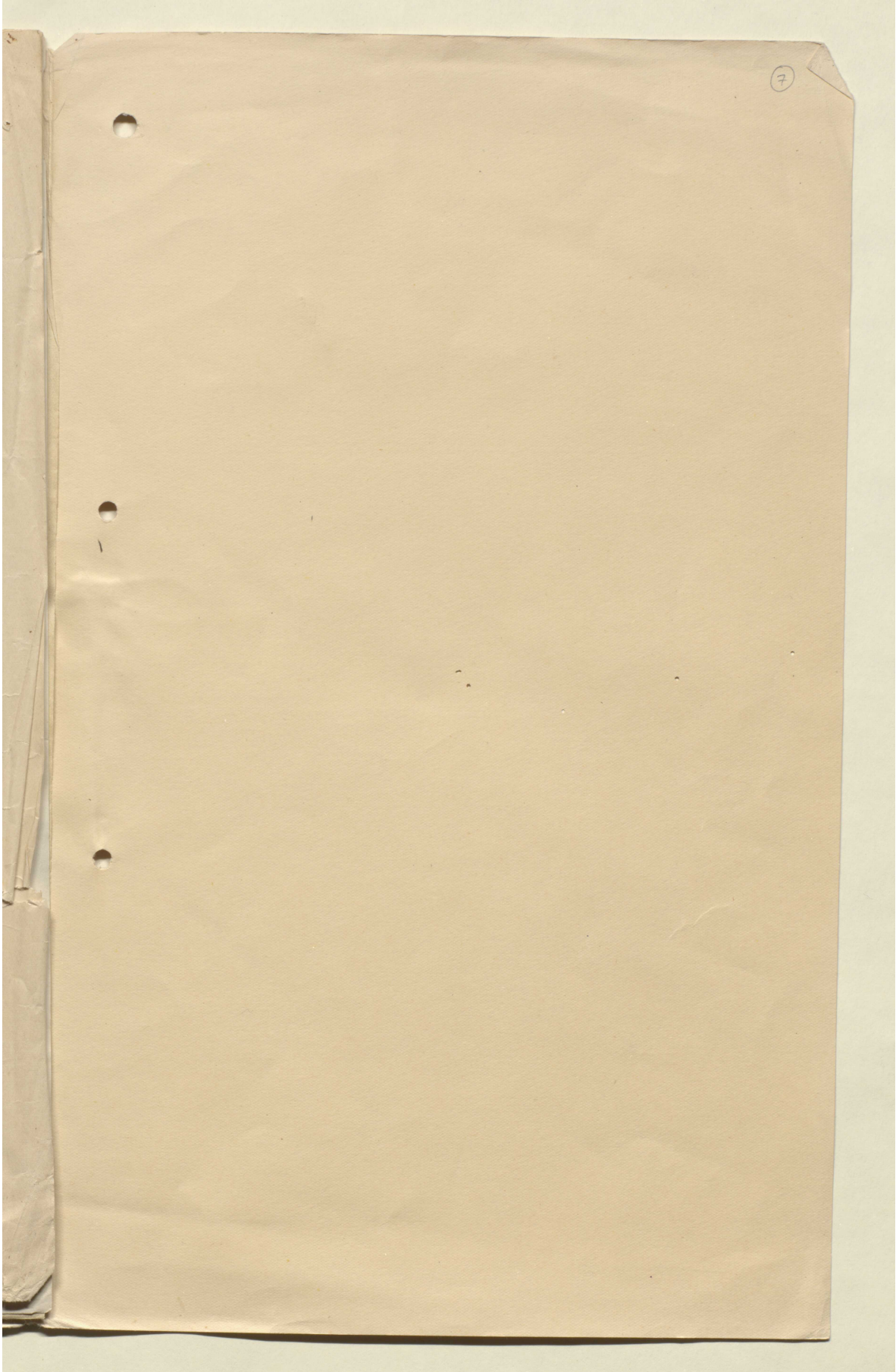
