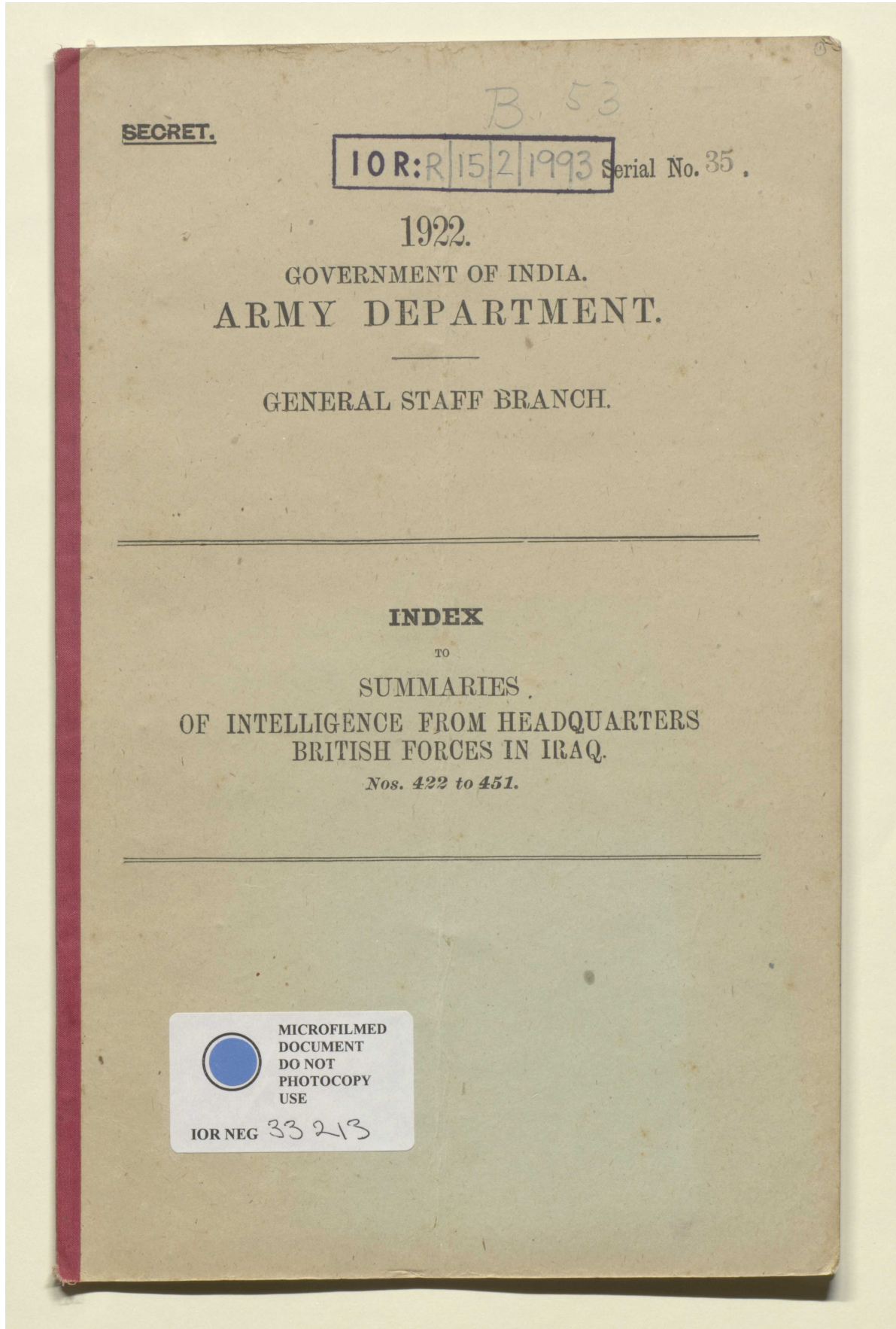


About this record

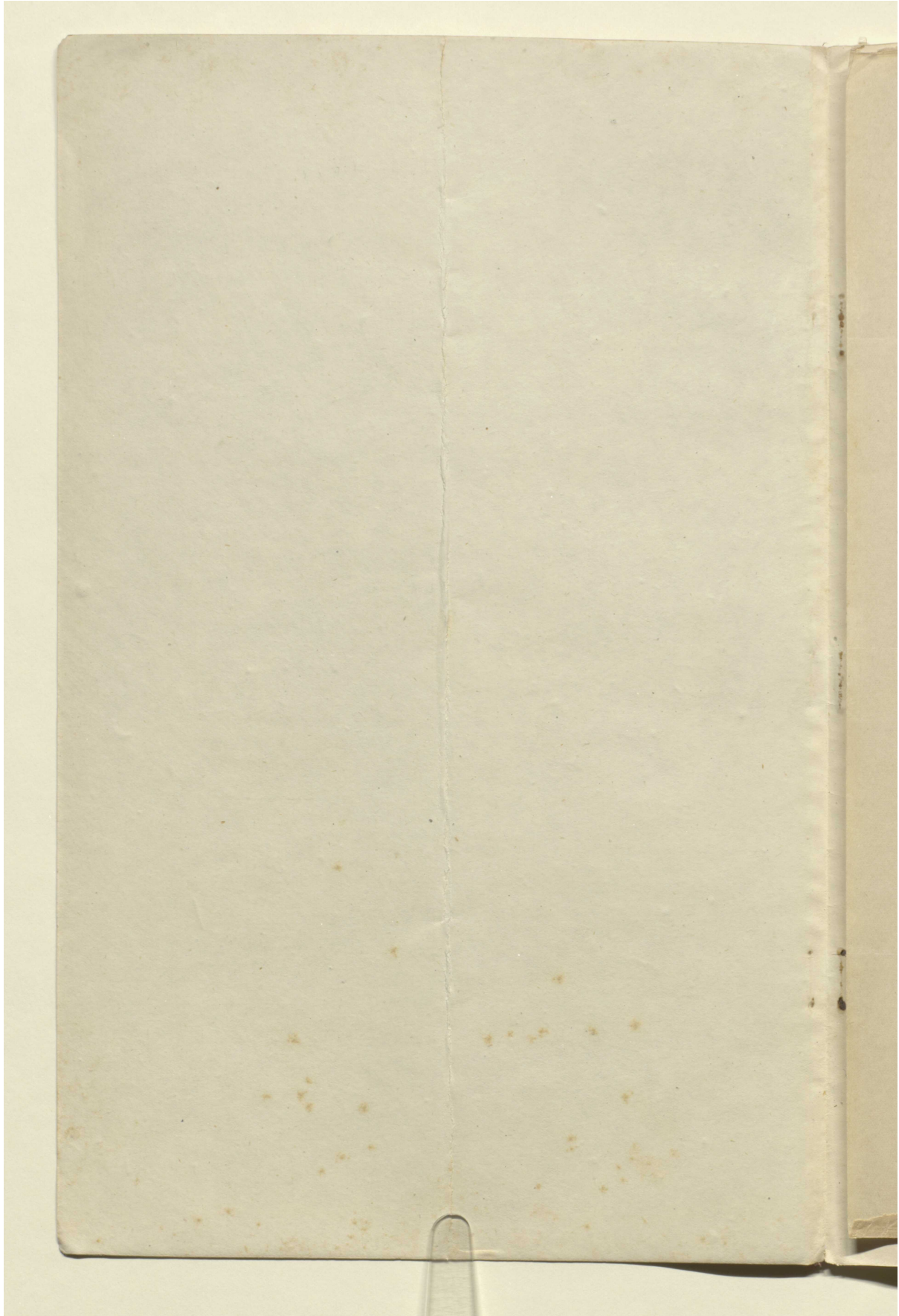

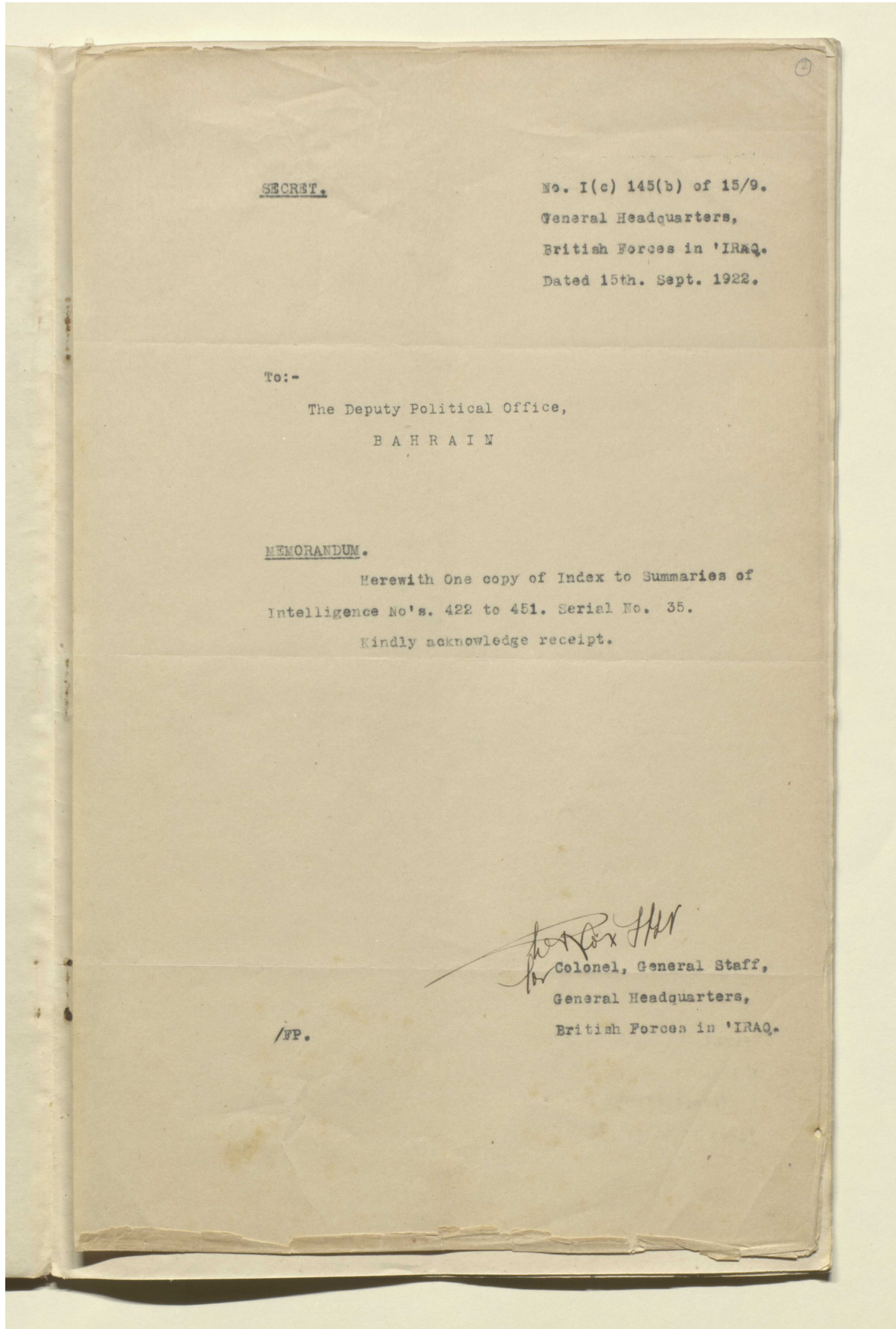
