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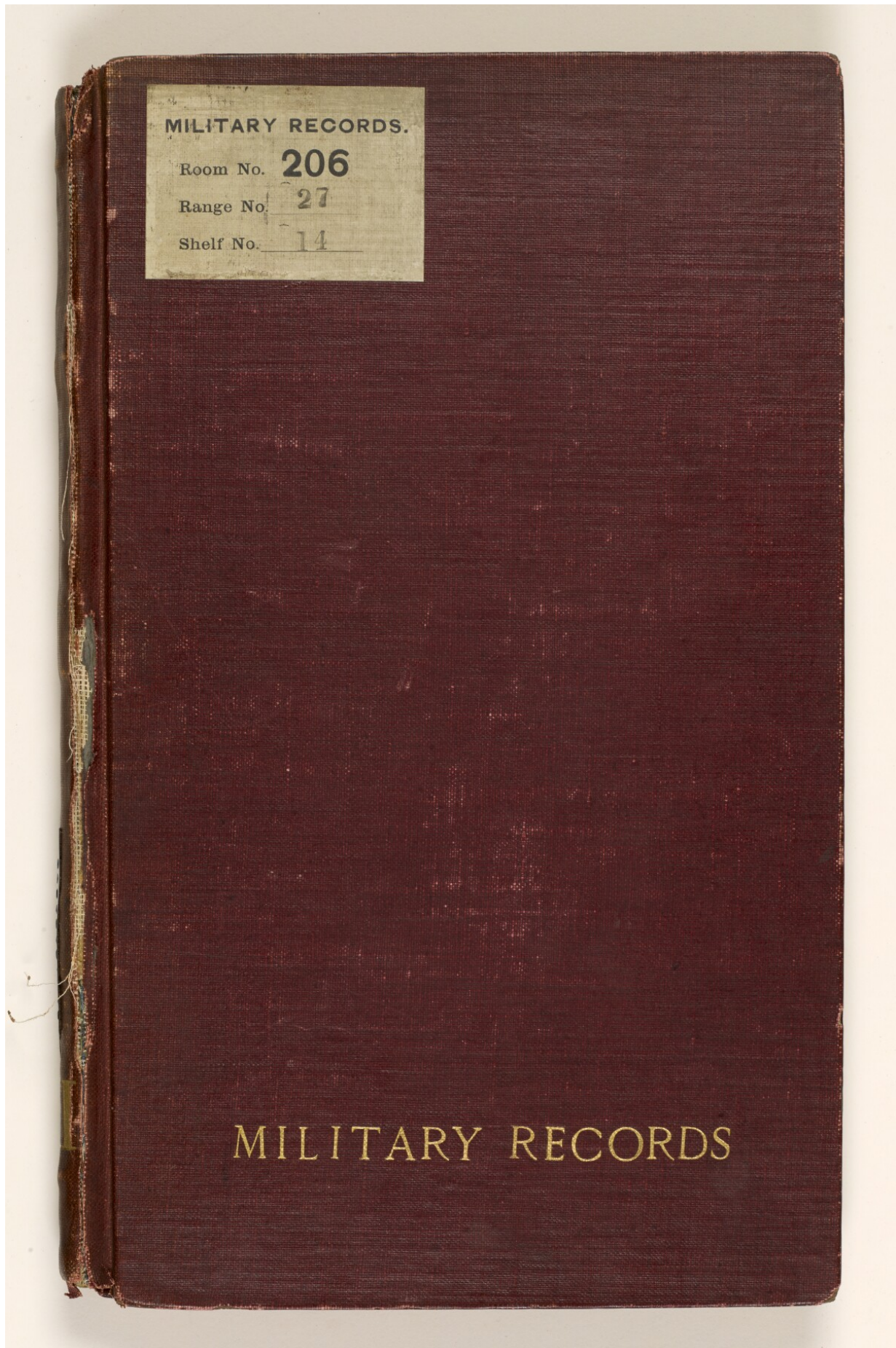
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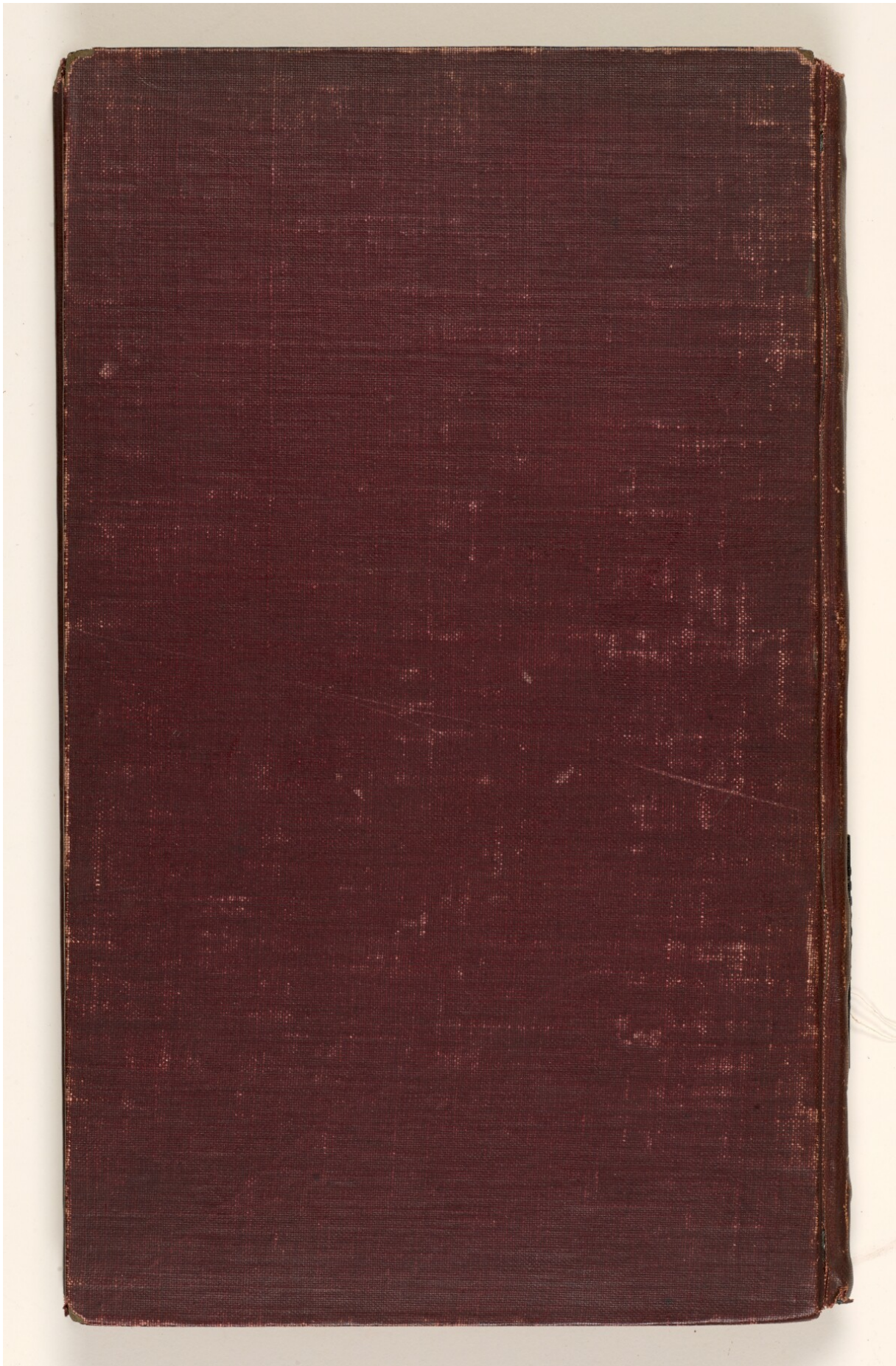

About this record

The troops were involved in a Persian expedition conducted by the EIC, and the related correspondence is regarding the payments and measures to give and receive the refund.

Principal correspondents are: War Office; Treasury Chambers; India Office; Government of India's Financial Department; Government of India's Military Department; and Acting Controller of Military Accounts.



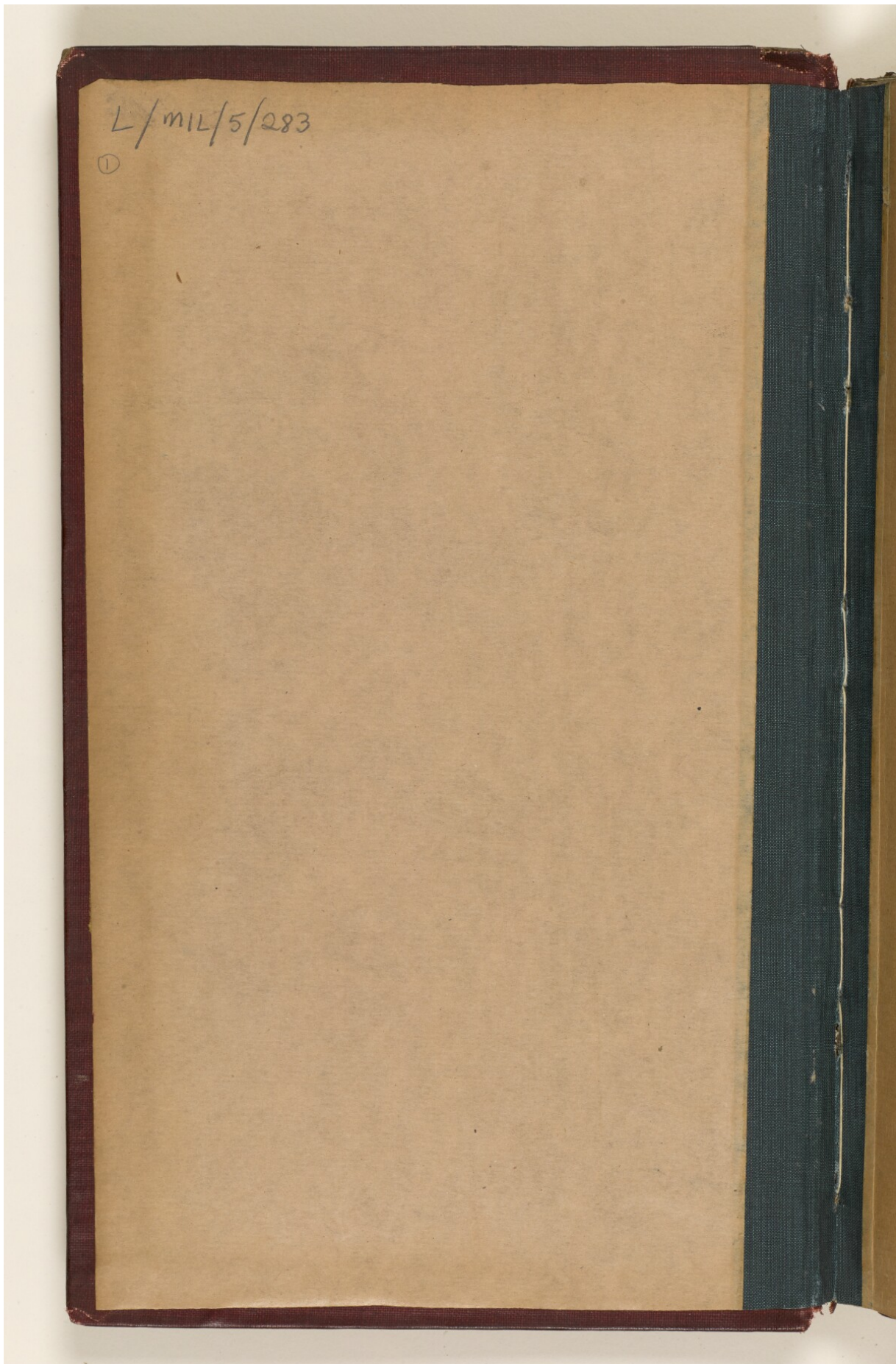


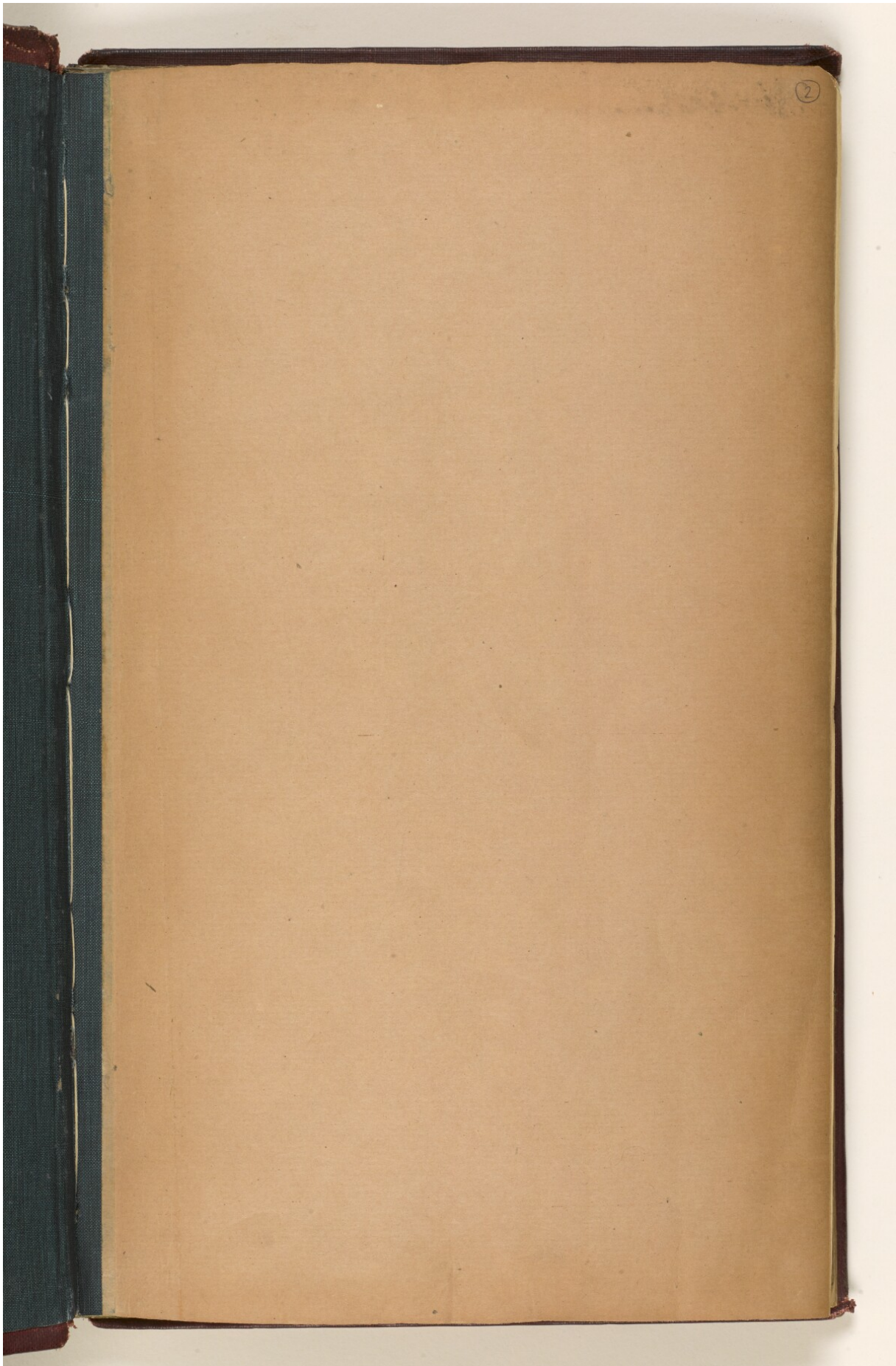


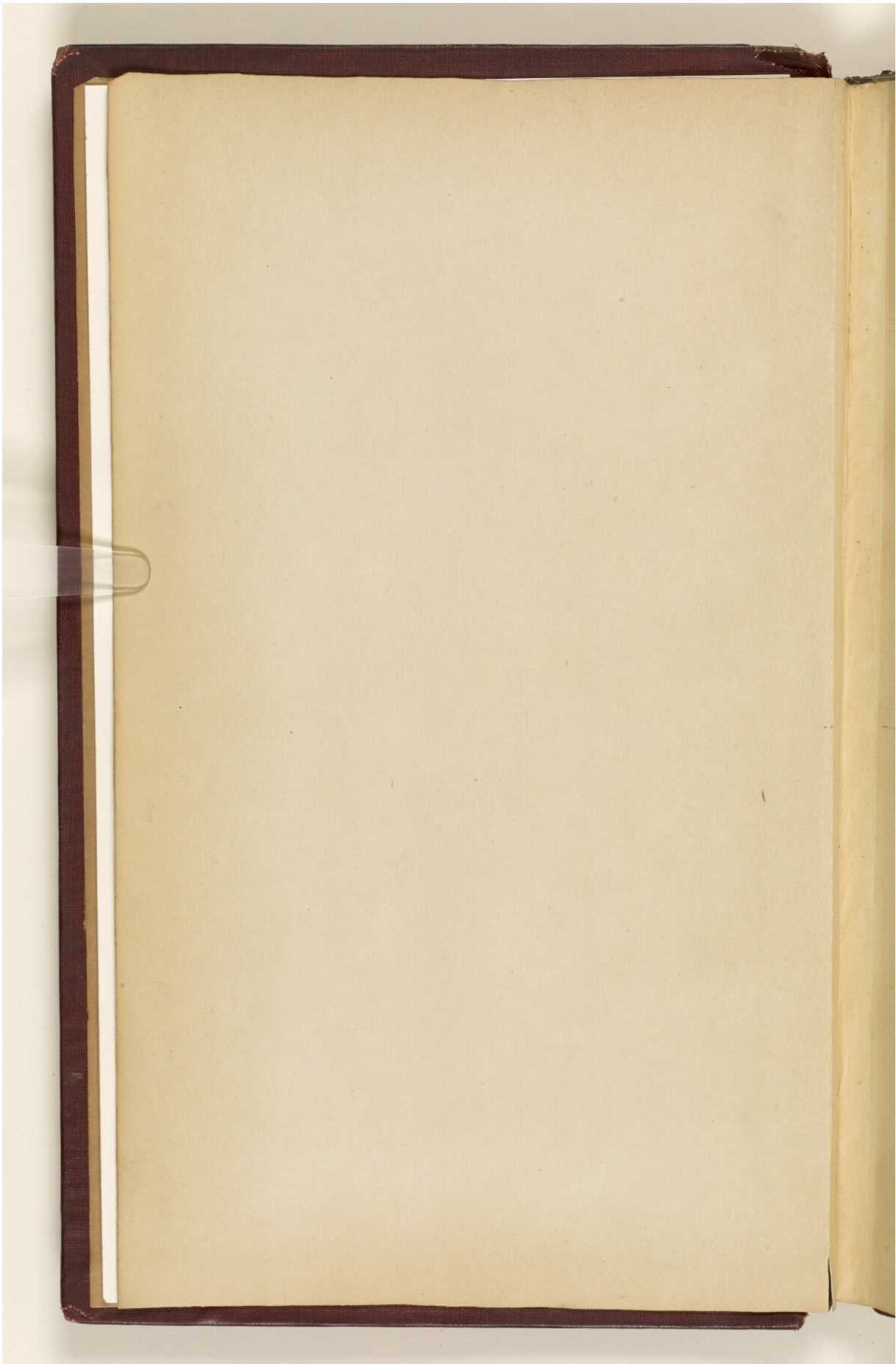


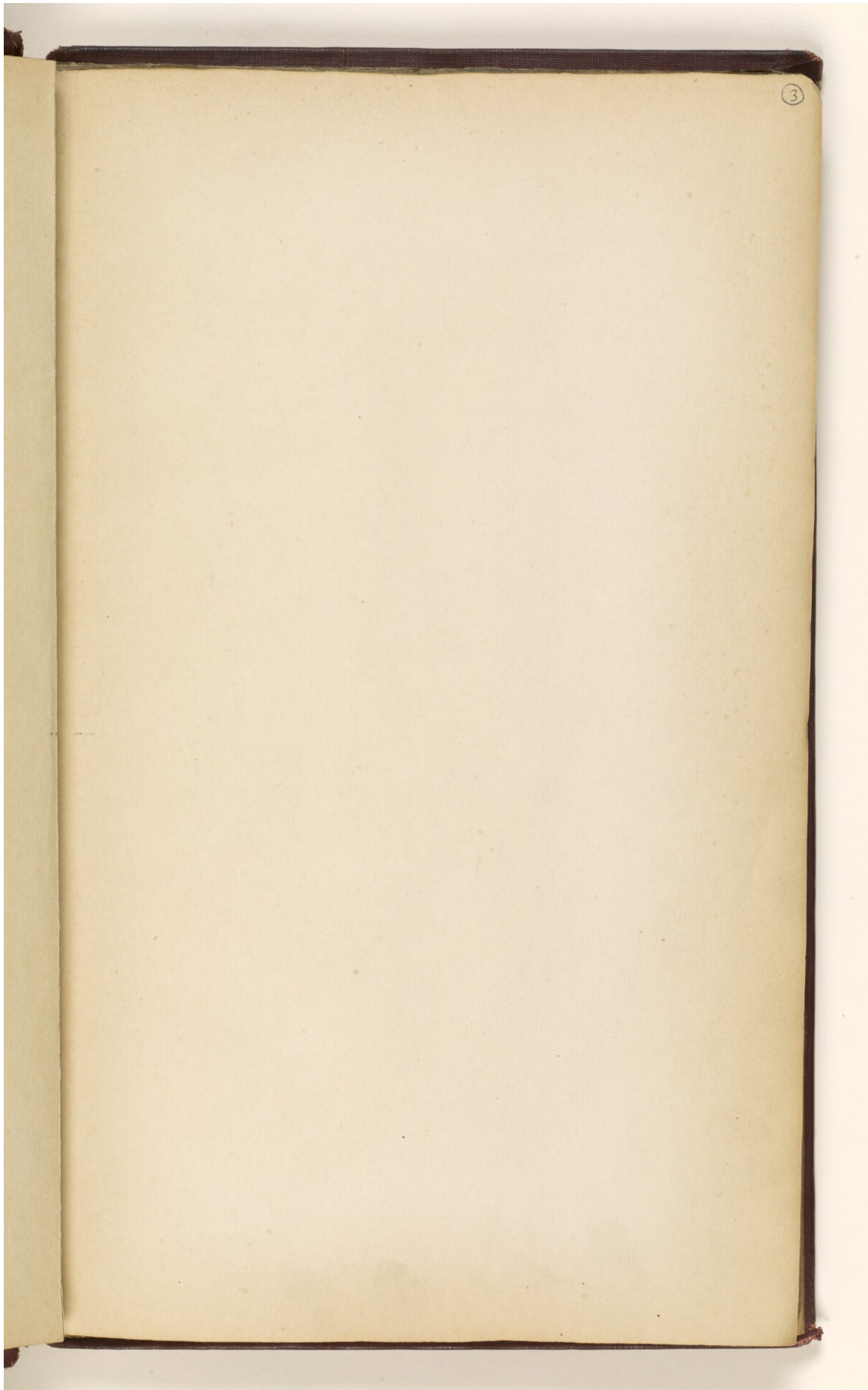


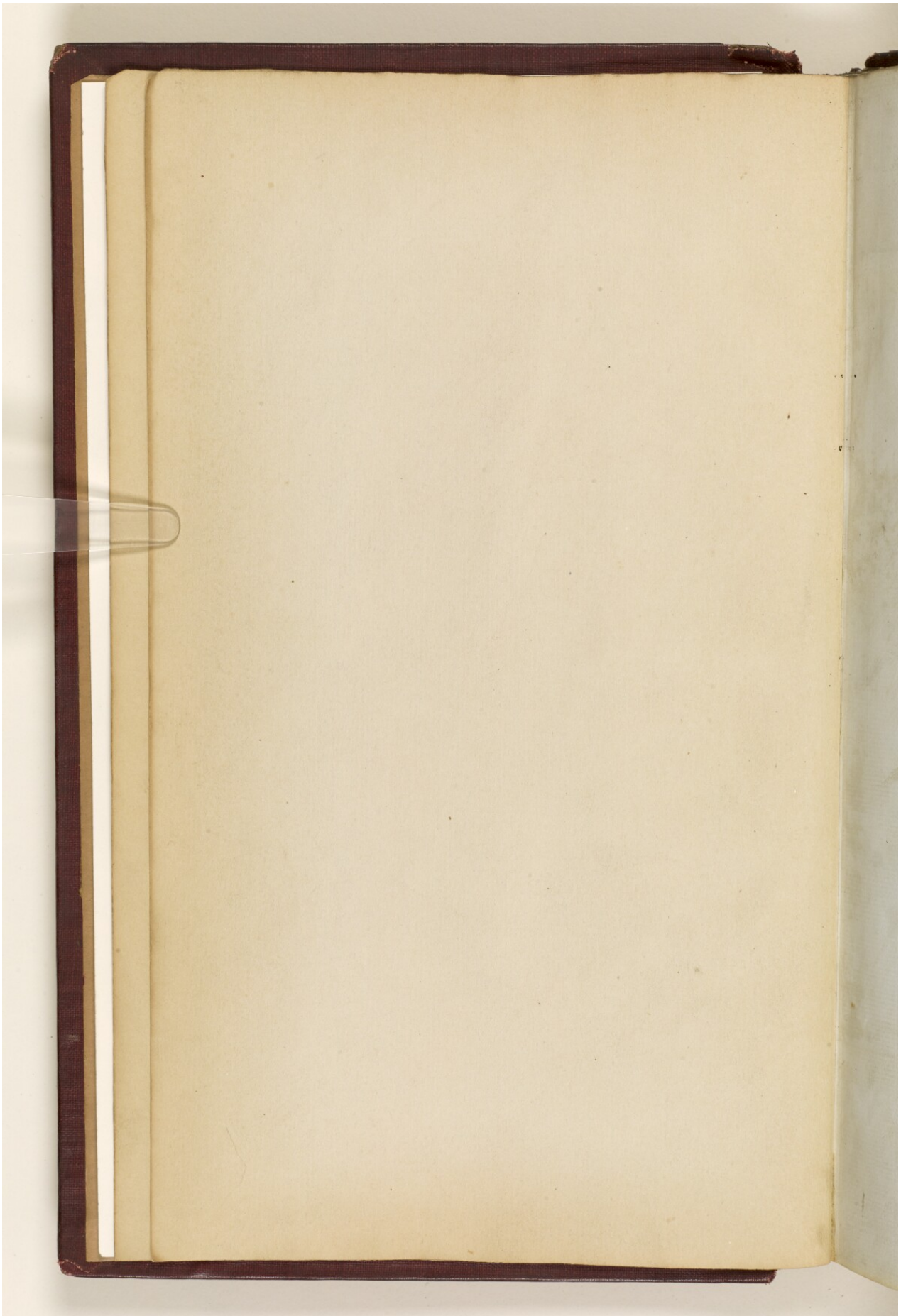


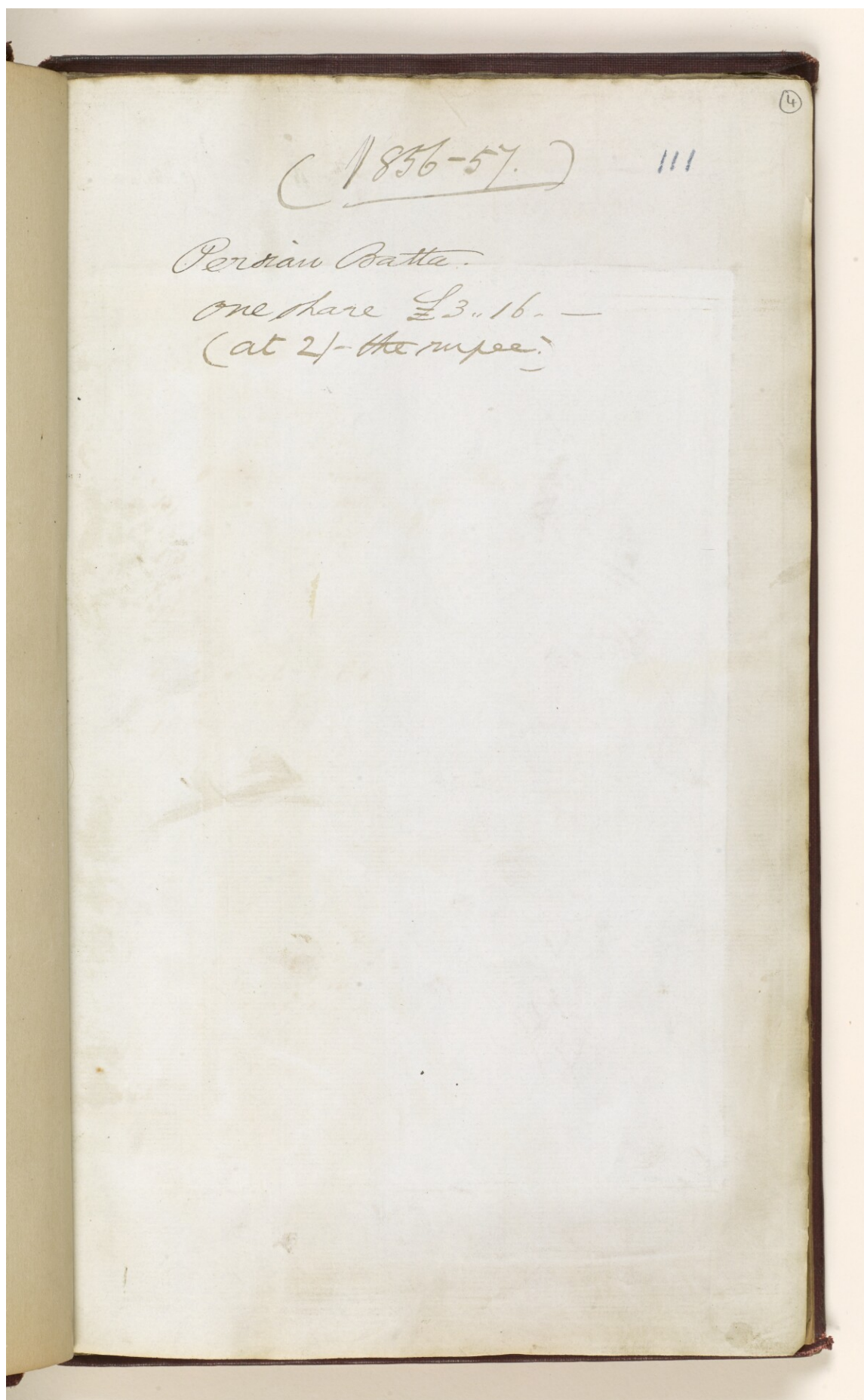


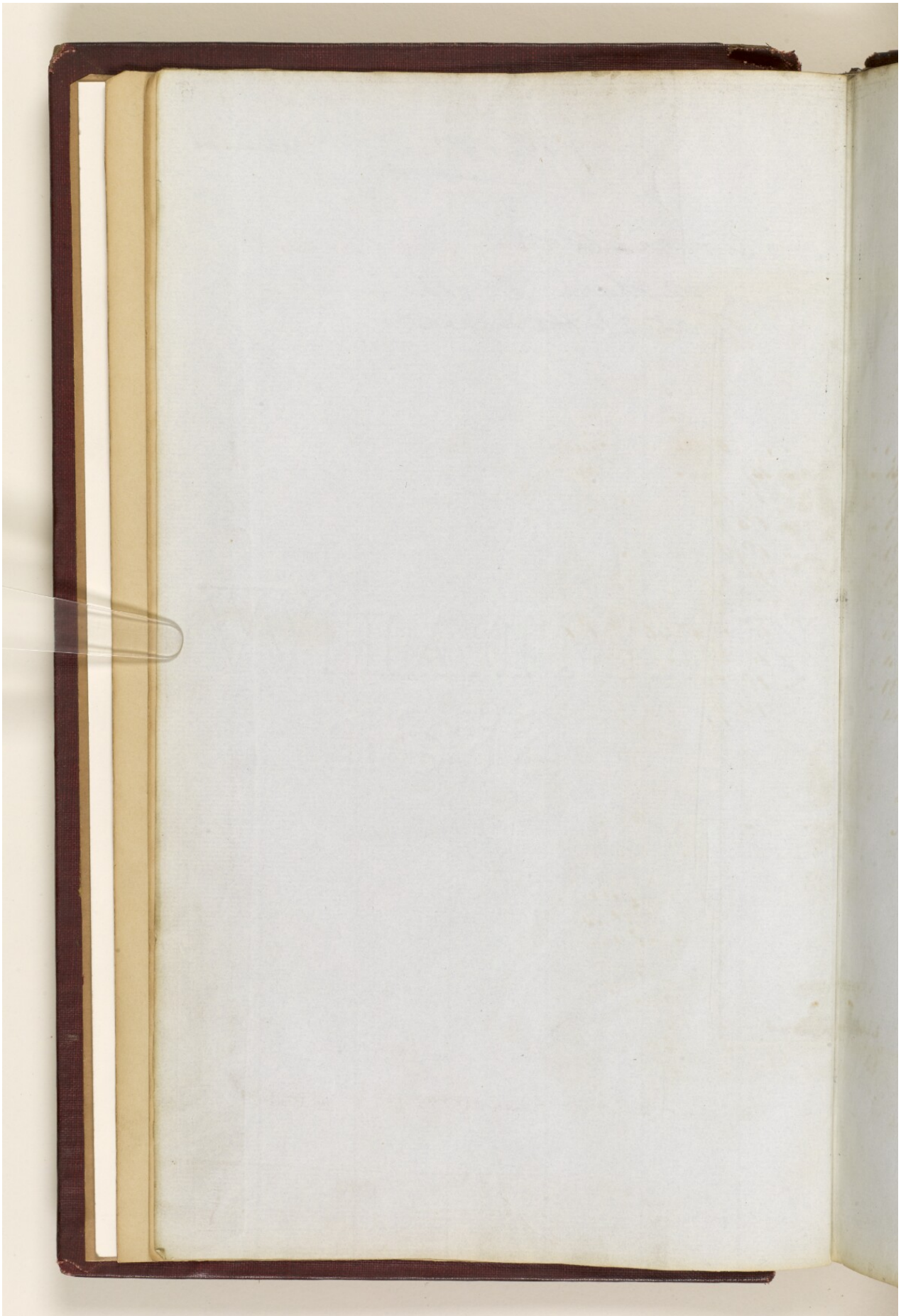


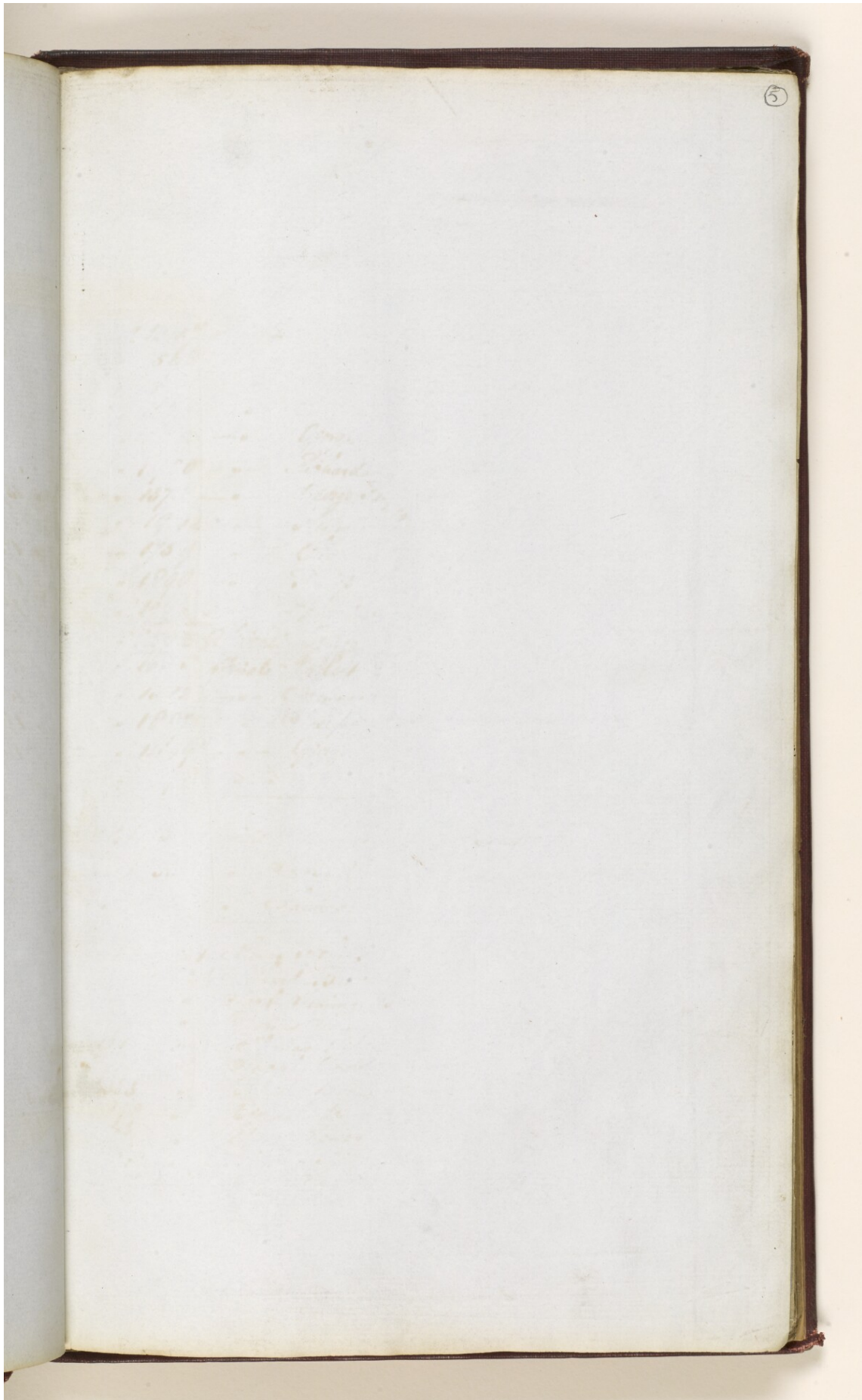


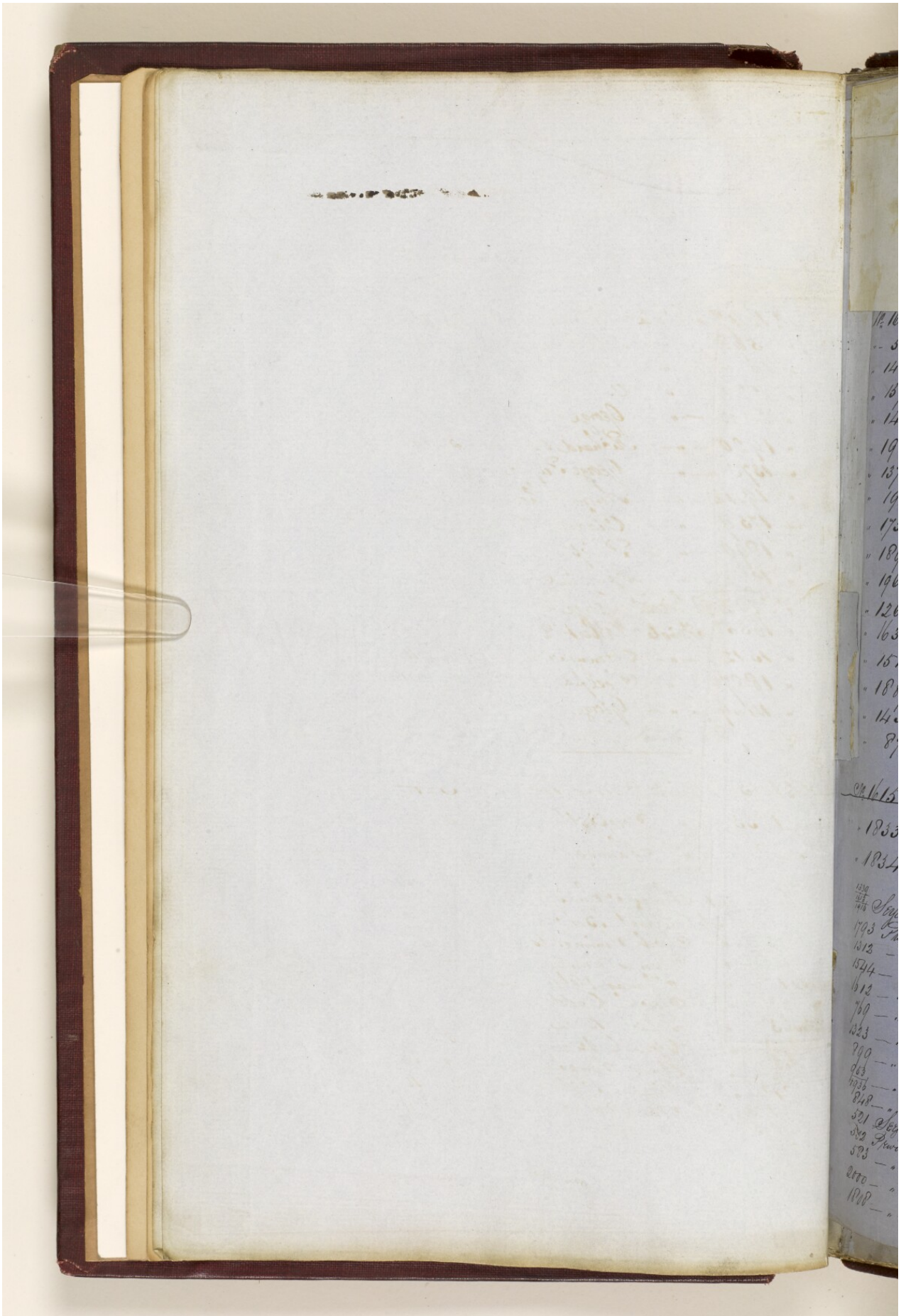

With reference to your letter of 22nd of December 1859 and the reply thereto from this Office of the 9th March, I am directed by Mr. Secretary Herbert to transmit herewith a copy of a communication dated 21st Instant conveying the acquiescence of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury to one half of the amount of donation Batta awarded to the Troops engaged in the Persian Expedition being charged against the Imperial Funds.

With reference, however, to the second paragraph of the enclosed letter, in which their Lordships raise the question of the grant of donation Batta to Troops employed on future expeditions I am to add that Mr. Herbert would be glad

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury have had under their consideration your letter of the 9th Ultimo, on the subject of the grant of donation batta to the troops engaged in the Persian Expedition, and their Lordships have directed me to acquaint you for the information of Mr. Secretary Herbert that, as the Persian Expedition was conducted under the East India Company, and as the precedents of that service clearly establish that donation batta should be given to the troops employed upon it My Lords will not object to the Imperial Government paying one half of the amount under the general arrangement of contributing half of the extraordinary expenses of the expedition.

But while their Lordships would not interfere to deprive the troops who performed such distinguished service, of any donation to which, from the rules and practice of the former East India Service, they may be considered as justly entitled, My Lords think it necessary to direct Mr. Herbert's attention to the importance of ascertaining what steps ought to be taken for the future, having regard to the change
made

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made by the substitution of the Queen's Government for that of the East India Company in India, and to the probability of troops of the Indian and Imperial Establishments serving together on distant expeditions as is indeed now the case in China.

The only precedents which my Lords can find of donation batta being given to Imperial troops, from funds other than those of the East India Company, are those of the first China War, in which the foundation for the grant of batta^{clearly} was the receipt in consequence of the war of a large sum of money which might be considered as almost tantamount to Prize money.

In the case of the Persian Expedition the value of captured property is so small, not exceeding £3,800, that the donation of batta amounting to £60,000 cannot be justified on the principle of considering it as a commutation of Prize money, and it must be considered in the simple light of a pecuniary reward for gallant and successful service.

It is obvious that a precedent for such a reward may, if not very carefully guarded, give rise to very large and difficult questions.

My Lords regret that so much delay should have already occurred in settling the claim of batta of the troops employed upon this expedition as it



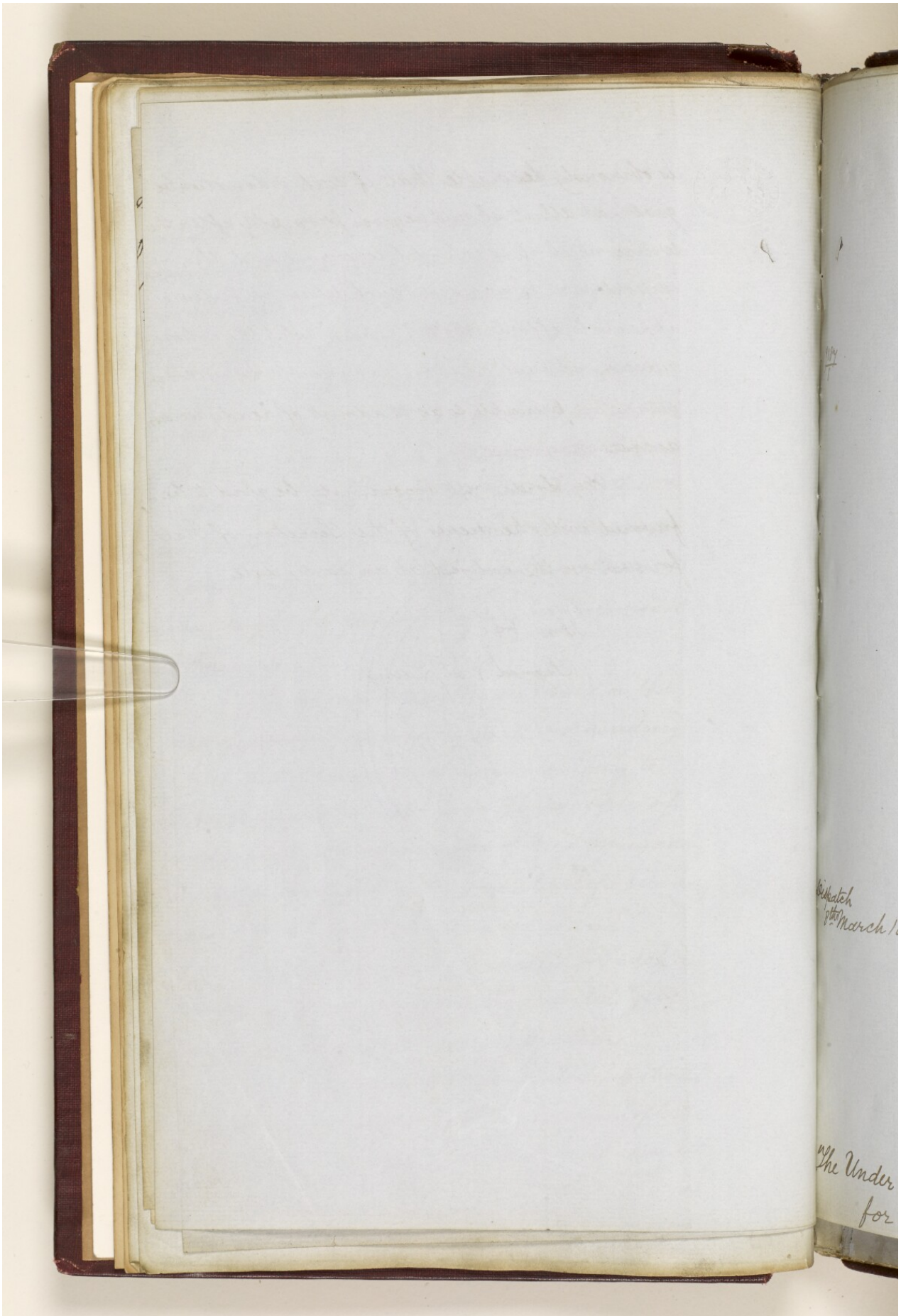
is obviously desirable that if such a donation be given at all it should be given promptly after the service which it is intended to reward, and the importance of avoiding such delays in future appears to afford another reason why the whole question should as soon as possible be settled on some clear principle so as to admit of ready decision as cases may arise.

My Lords will accordingly be glad to be favored with the views of the Secretary of State for War on the subject at an early date.

In reply I am directed to state that intimation of the grant of Donation Batta to the Persian Expeditionary Force has been conveyed to the Government of India, with instructions to expedite the transmission to this country of Rolls of the Officers and Men who have left India in order that their claims to the Batta may be settled at an early date.

Lords Commissioners of the Treasury, as to the grant of Donation Batta for future Military Operations, I am directed by Sir Chas Wood to remark that the substitution of the Government of the Queen for that of the East India Company, in India has made no alteration in the manner of meeting expenditure in India; that Donation Batta if hereafter granted for service in India would, as heretofore, have to be paid from the Indian Exchequer; that only one instance is on record, before the case of the Persian Expedition, in which Her Majesty's Home Government have been called on to contribute from its Funds towards a grant of Donation Batta; that the practice of making such grants for service in India has been sufficiently long established and sufficiently uniform to excite expectations amongst the troops of its continuance; that it has always, nevertheless, been well understood that a grant of Donation Batta is an act of Grace and could not be claimed as a right, yet that no Military achievement on a large scale has gone unrewarded in this respect for a long course of years. This will be seen from the following instances

It is further to be observed that the Govts of India have been entrusted with the power, in cases of a pressing and urgent nature, to make grants of Donation Batta to the extent of six months Donation. They have thus the power of at once rewarding, on the spot, military success; a power which they exercised during the late critical events in India promptly and judiciously, and with the very best results.

These circumstances render it in Sir Charles Wood's opinion impossible to take any step having for its object the prohibition of the grant of Donation Batta for future service in India without very careful and mature consideration having been given to the subject; but I am directed to state that he will communicate with the Government of India with the view of ascertaining their opinion

With the view to prevent such delay, the Military Accountant at Bombay recommends that after ascertaining the extent of the payments made in England to the Officers and men whose names are included in the accompanying Statement the remainder of the claims, together with those published in General Orders of the Command-in-Chief No. 213 of the 9th March 1863 minus those stated in para 3 of the Examiner's letter annexed be charged in lump to the Persian Expedition, and held in deposit until claimed. In such case, in future payments made in England would require to be intimated to this Government for communication to this Office, when the amounts would be credited to "Account Current London" and the Deposit Account reduced."

3. Under the circumstances represented the proposition of the Military Accountant at Bombay seems to me to be unobjectionable. The Statement and letter quoted in the above Extract from the Military Accountant's letter are among the papers herewith forwarded.

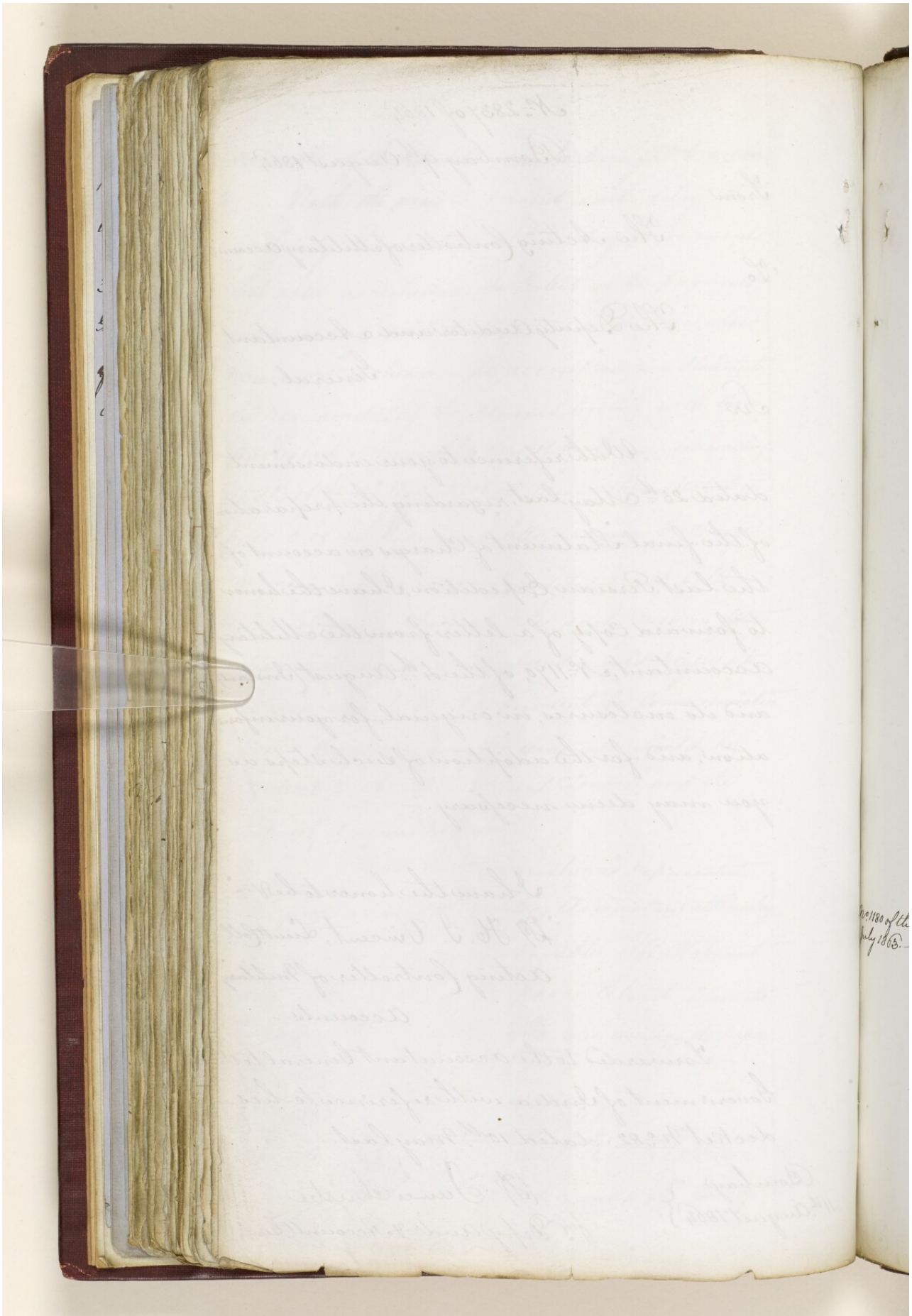

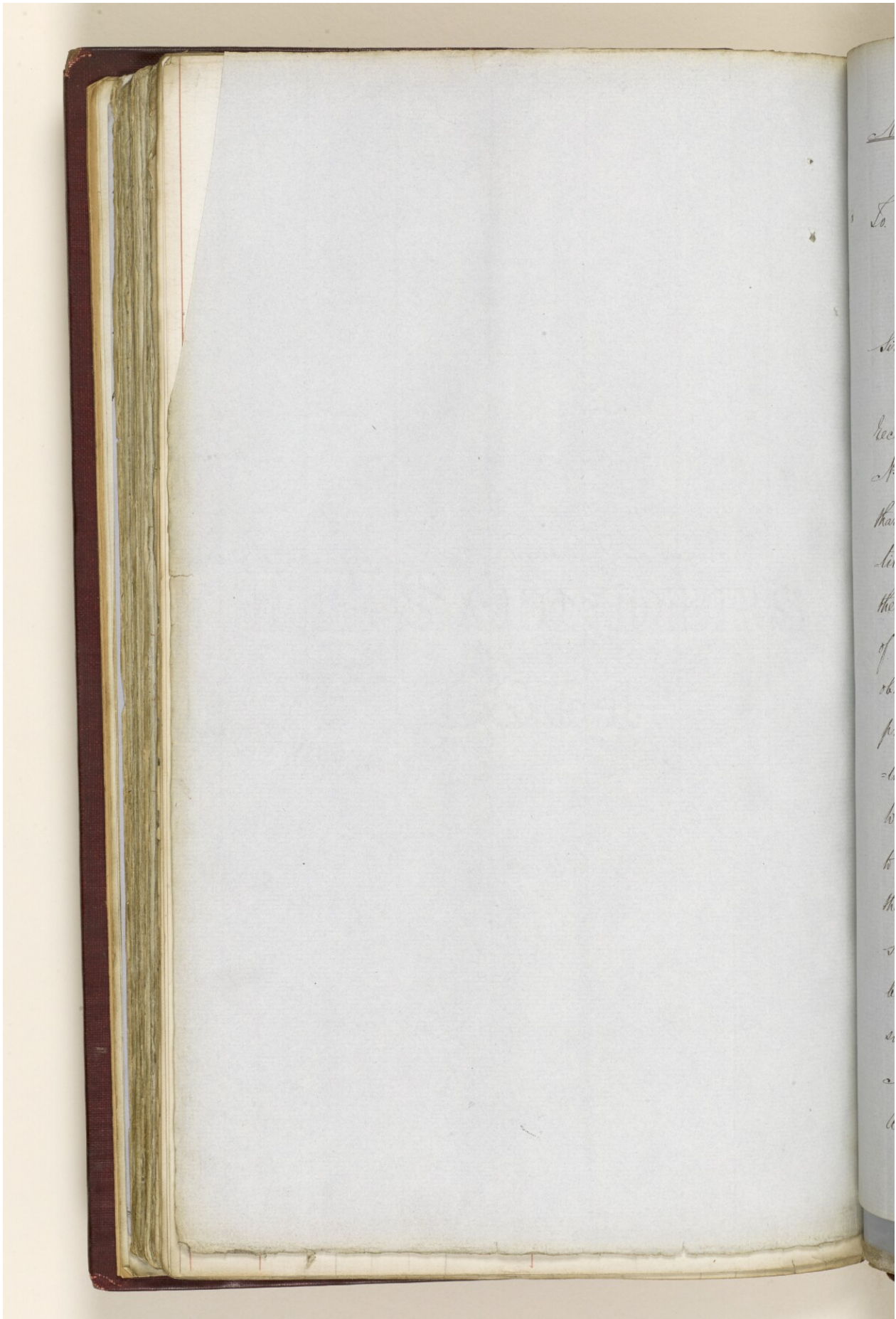

In returning herewith the documents received under cover of Military Department docket N^o 868. dated the 28th October 1864, I have the honor to state that as it appears from the list of the individuals entitled to the Persian Donation Batta furnished by the Examiner Pay Department Bombay, that many of the men entitled to Batta are either dead or have obtained their discharge, or have been invalided and proceeded to England, I beg to suggest that instructions should be issued with a view to the amount due to such men being credited to their Estates and remitted to England in the usual way on bills for payment in that Country, and the Right Honorable the Secretary of State for India might be moved to cause a notice to be published in England to the effect that claimants should apply to the War Office if belong to the British Army or to the India Office, if belonging to the Indian Army; the payment in either case being duly charged

to Her Majesty's Indian Government and ad-
-vice of the same communicated to this Country
to admit of credit being afforded to Her Majesty's
British Government.

(2) The names of the other parties, resident
in India who are entitled to the Batta might be
published in the Gazettes of the three Presidencies
with an intimation that no claims would be recog-
-nized by Government, preferred after the 30th
April next the close of the official year.

Extract from the Proceedings of the Government of India in the Financial Department under date the 28th February 1865.

Read a letter from the Accountant General to the Government of India N^o. 1233 dated the 13th September 1864, forwarding a communication from the Deputy Auditor and Accountant General, Bombay, giving cover to a Statement shewing the several claims to Donation Batta for Service in the last Persian Expedition which still remain unadjusted.

Read a communication to the Military Department N^o. 2752 dated the 20th October 1864 forwarding the above for report.

Read an Extract from the Proceedings of Government in the Military Department N^o. 534 dated the 3rd February 1865 forwarding for consideration copy of a letter from the Controller of Military Accounts, Bengal, suggesting that as many of the men entitled to the Donation Batta are either dead or have obtained their discharge or have been invalided and have proceeded to England, instructions should be issued with a view to the amount due.



to such men being credited to their Estates
and remitted to England on rolls for payment
in that Country and that the Right Honible
the Secretary of State should be moved to cause
a notice to be published in England to the
effect that claimants should apply to the
War Office if belonging to the British Army,
or to the India Office if belonging to the
Indian Army, the payment being in either case

The Governor General in Council is Resolution

the Controller of Military Finance, with the
exception that the amount of Donation Batta
to be remitted to England for payment there,
should be charged at once in the Accounts in
India to the Persian Expedition.
