The file includes a divider which gives a list of correspondence references contained in the file by year. This is placed at the back of the correspondence.



5. At this point I reminded His Excellency of his proposal, reported in my telegram No. 9 of the 14th January, that the Royal Air Force, India, should examine and report on the condition of the ineffective machines belonging to the Afghan Government, with a view to their repair, and said I should be glad of a definite reply, as the Royal Air Force wished to dispose of their D.H.9A. spares, as soon as possible, if these were not likely to be required.

6. Faiz Muhammad apologised for the long delay which had occurred and said that, as I knew, the outburst of hostile propaganda which followed the acceptance of a loan and munitions from His Majesty's Government, had made it impossible to pursue this proposal in the first instance. Later had come the discussions with the Soviet, of which he had told me, and negotiations, which were now pending, with Junkers for an air service, with Afghan participation, inside Afghanistan. Any agreement resulting from these discussions and negotiations might provide for the overhaul of Afghan machines by foreign agency, and, although he would consult the Prime Minister again, in regard to the point I had raised, he did not see how any definite expression of their wishes could, in present circumstances, be offered by the Afghan Government. He quite realised that the question could not be left open indefinitely, and, if the Royal Air Force, India, could not wait any longer, it would now have to be decided by His Majesty's Government. For the latter's willingness to help, his Government were very grateful.



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



E. It may be taken as certain that the reason why the proposal that machines of the Afghan air force should be overhauled and repaired by the Royal Air Force, India, has been temporarily dropped is to be found in the propagonds charging the Afghan Government with subservience to British influence. This propagands was accentuated by the publicity given to the grant of material assistance by the dovernment of India, and stimulated by the attacks which the Ishore press was so long allowed to make with impunity upon the present Afghan Government.

5. The probability of the request new in question being renewed scene therefore to depend largely on the constant of such propaganda. It would also be affected by the outcome of the negotiations in which the Afghan Government are new engaged, (and which have reached a very oritical stage) regarding the grant to foreign agencies of contracts for air services in Afghanistan. Clearly therefore it is quite impossible to give any definite reply to the question asked in the last centence of your memorandum, and it is probable that even the Afghan

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
Government themselves would be unable to give one. It would of course be highly inadvisable to press them on the subject.

S. I understand that the reason for your present reference is the desire of the Royal Air Force authorities to avoid the loss represented by the difference between the present scrap value of the D.N.9A spares reserved for the contingency in question and their scrap value at any future date on which these spares might have to be cold.


I should be glad to learn what the present sorap walue of these spares is. From the fact that nearly a Year ago the scrap walue of a complete D.H.94 was only Rs.250 (wide your memorandum No.D.5255-F/20, dated August 5, 1950) I imagine that the sum now involved is not very large, and 15 this presumption is correct, consider that it would be well worth while, in view of the political importance of the repair of the Afghan machines by the Royal Air Force, for the Severment of India to guarantee the latter against such loss, and to dobit the sum required for this purpose to the *255,000 reserve'.
