- 1) All travellers, except Kuwait subjects, coming to or leaving Kuwait should register their names at the Travelling and Residence Office within 48 hours of their arrival or departure.
- 2) Foreigners who have not registered their names at the Travelling and Residence Office yet, should do so now.
- 3) Foreigners who desire to stay more than 15 days or who desire to stay more than the period allowed, should call at the Travelling and Residence Office to obtain a Residential Book.
- 4) Members of religious, education, medical and other missions who are commissioned to work in Kuwait or who come on contract to work in Government offices, are requested to hand over their passports to the heads of the departments concerned in order to facilitate the issue of Residential Books.
- 5) Within a month of the issue of this notice, whoever disobeys these instructions will be liable for a penalty of six months imprisonment or a fine of Rs.600/- or both, in accordance with Article 17 of Residence Rules of 1948.

2. I have been going into the administration of the passport section of this office in connection with the registration of British Subjects under Part VI of the Order in Council and other matters.

3. The number of British Protected Persons in Kuwait has risen from a mere 100 in 1944 to some 4400 odd today. In addition to the passport work which the presence of these persons involves (which includes the issue of new passports and making the necessary enquiries before they are issued in doubtful cases), we have a good deal to do in connection with the passports of foreigners and of Kuwait Subjects. To do all of this there is one locally recruited Arab clerk. He has done his best and is, I consider, to be congratulated on what he has managed to do; but he is clearly not fitted by education or background to run a passport office at the standard of efficiency expected by the Foreign Office. And, indeed, I find that he has not fully digested or understood all the circulars that are received, and the necessary files have not been properly maintained. Nor is he qualified to receive in the way that they have a right to expect the Europeans and Americans that frequent the passport office; and as long as the Political Agent is the only officer here clearly he cannot receive them all himself, or, indeed, invariably be in the office when they call. I understand that complaints were made by the British residents to Major Tufton Beamish, M.P., when he came here in Galloway's time about their reception by clerks in the Agency, and twice recently the Consul-General at Basra has taken it upon himself to draw our attention to mistakes made in the issue of British passports.

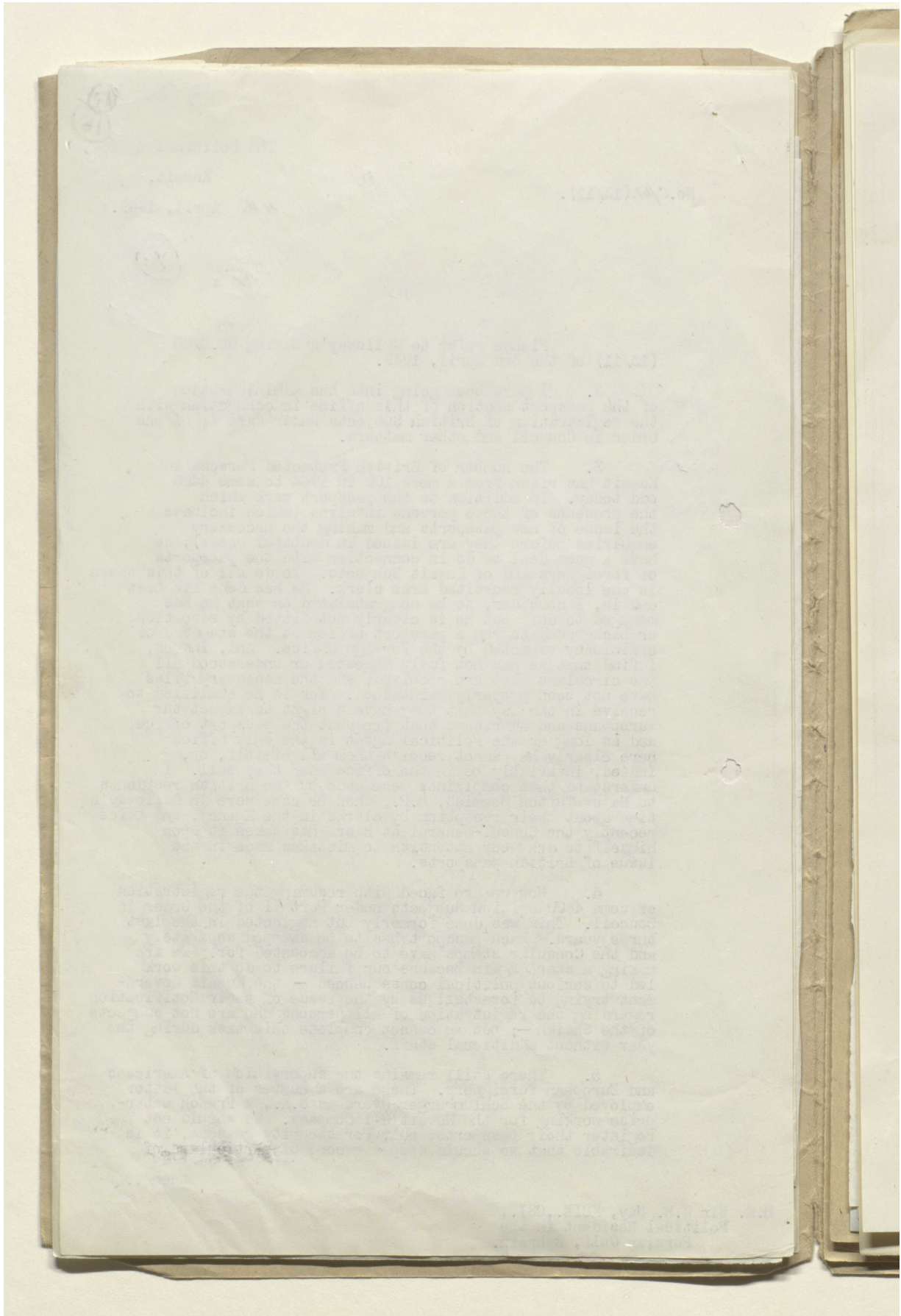
4. Now we are faced with resuming the registration of some 4400 British Subjects under Part VI of the Order in Council. This was done formerly but neglected in the last three years. Each passport has to be stamped separately and the Consular stamps have to be accounted for. We are making a start again because our failure to do this work led to serious political consequences - the Kuwait Government trying to forestall us by the issue of their Notification regarding the registration of all persons who are not subjects of the Shaikh -; but we cannot complete this task during the year without additional staff.

5. There still remains the supervision of Americans and European foreigners. There are a number of the latter employed by the Schlumberger Overseas S.A., a French enterprise working for the Kuwait Oil Company. We should not register their passports; but, for security reasons, it is desirable that we should keep a record of particulars of

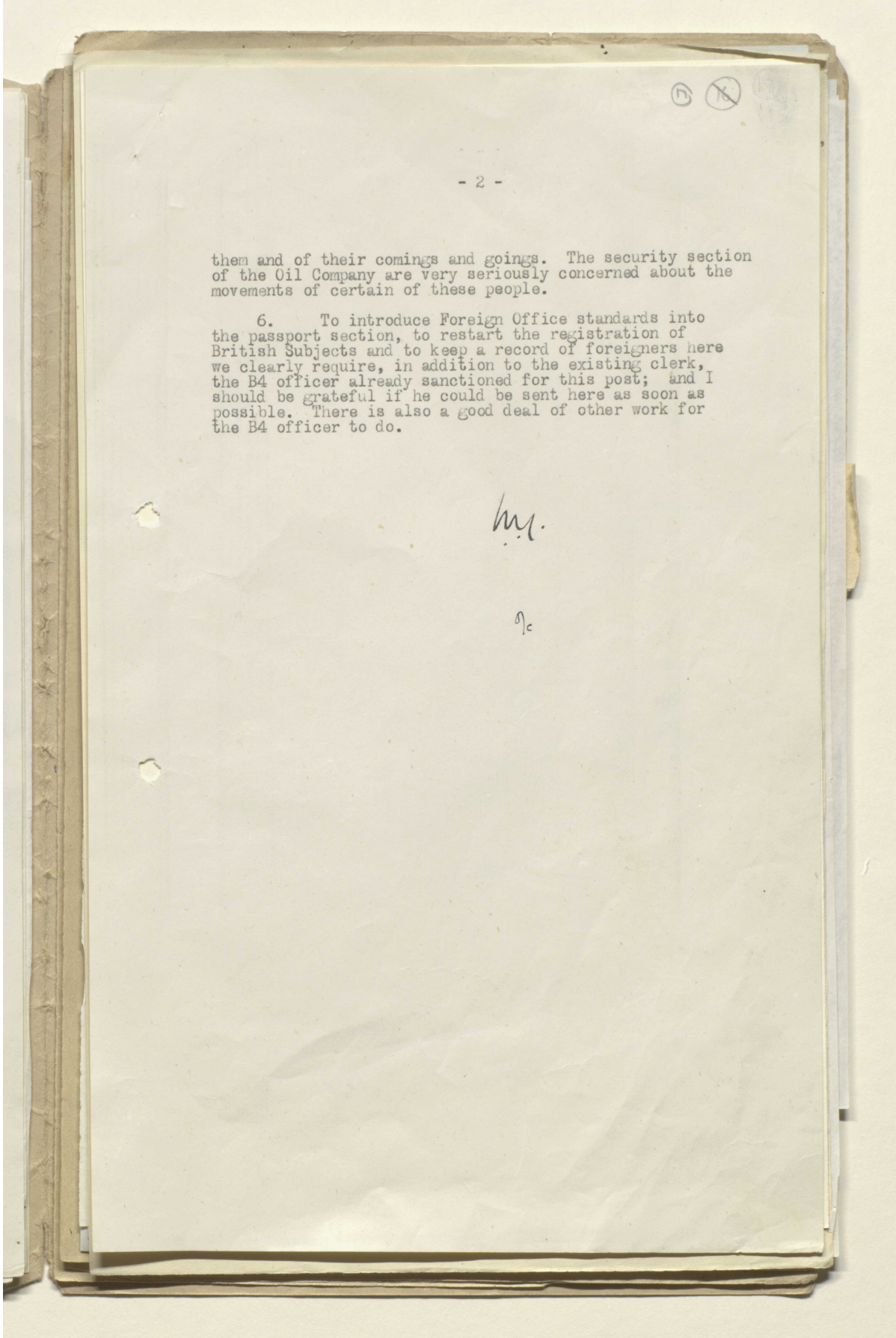

In addition he tries to maintain lists of suspects to whom travel facilities should not be given; to study F.O. circulars about passports; to keep records and make reports about the loss of passports, (losses have to be reported to 36 addressees); do the telegrams and correspondence involved in making reference before giving visas, N.O.C's, or issuing new passports; and account for the issue of Consular stamps on all documents - which include Customs declarations, attestations of signature etc. in addition to passports. He has to account for about Rs.100/- a day for stamps.

Please refer to our conversations about Abdulla Mubarak's demand that all employees of your Company other than subjects of His Highness the Sheikh (i.e. Kuwaitis proper) should register at the Kuwait Government's Passport and Nationality Office and obtain residence books.

2. Sheikh Abdulla Mubarak explained to me that he wished to introduce this to help him to maintain and to improve security in Kuwait which had deteriorated through the large influx of foreigners, many without travel or identity papers, seeking employment with the Kuwait Oil Company.

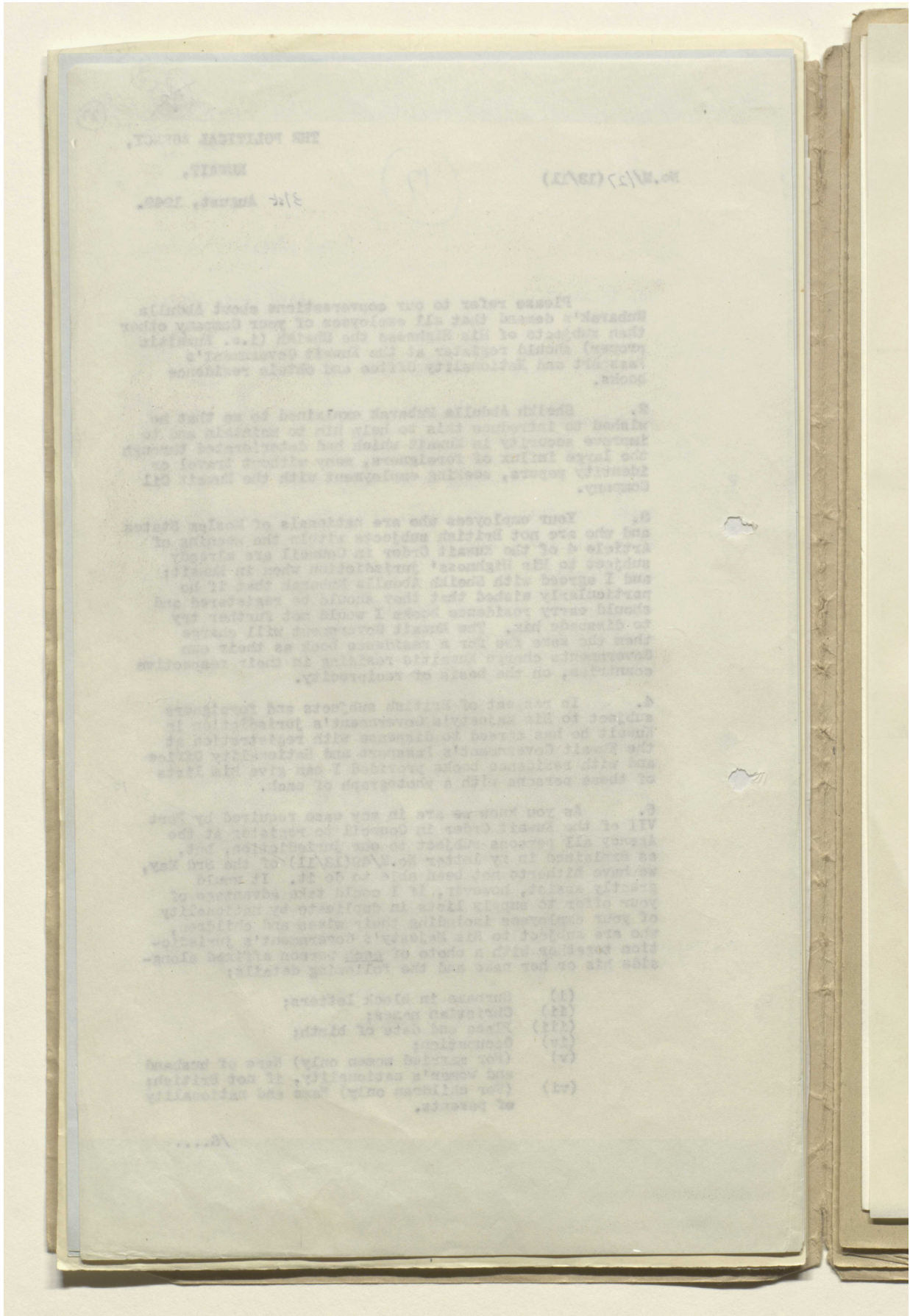
3. Your employees who are nationals of Moslem States and who are not British subjects within the meaning of Article 4 of the Kuwait Order in Council are already subject to His Highness' jurisdiction when in Kuwait; and I agreed with Sheikh Abdulla Mubarak that if he particularly wished that they should be registered and should carry residence books I would not further try to dissuade him. The Kuwait Government will charge them the same fee for a residence book as their own Governments charge Kuwaitis residing in their respective countries, on the basis of reciprocity.

4. In respect of British subjects and foreigners subject to His Majesty's Government's jurisdiction in Kuwait he has agreed to dispense with registration at the Kuwait Government's Passport and Nationality Office and with residence books provided I can give him lists of these persons with a photograph of each.

5. As you know we are in any case required by Part VII of the Kuwait Order in Council to register at the Agency all persons subject to our jurisdiction, but, as explained in my letter No.M/49(13/11) of the 3rd May, we have hitherto not been able to do it. It would greatly assist, however, if I could take advantage of your offer to supply lists in duplicate by nationality of your employees including their wives and children, who are subject to His Majesty's Government's jurisdiction together with a photo of each person affixed alongside his or her name and the following details:

- (i) Surname in block letters;
- (ii) Christian names;
- (iii) Place and date of birth;
- (iv) Occupation;
- (v) (For married women only) Name of husband and woman's nationality, if not British;
- (vi) (For children only) Name and nationality of parents.

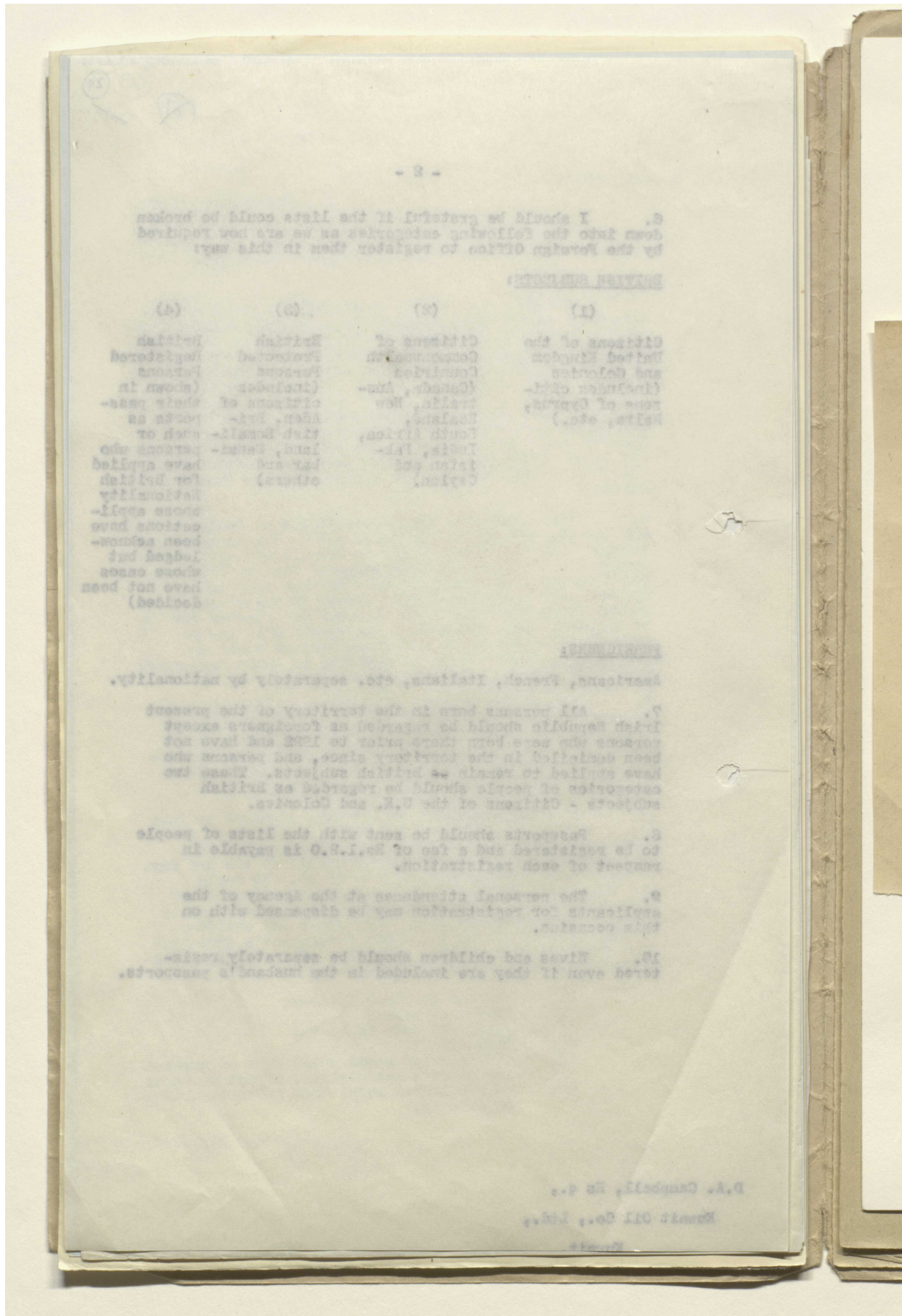

9. The personal attendance at the Agency of the applicants for registration may be dispensed with on this occasion.
