About this record

This item contains strength returns from units of the Indian Army, the British Army, and the Royal Air Force in British India, as well as forces deployed in Persia [Iran], the Persian Gulf ports, and Aden, issued by the Adjutant-General in India.

The strength returns detail the number of personnel serving with military branches and individual units as of 1 August 1921, grouped under the following categories:

- ‘Regular Forces’
- ‘Auxiliary Force – India’
- ‘Military Police and Levies’
- ‘Imperial Service Troops’
- ‘Miscellaneous Units’

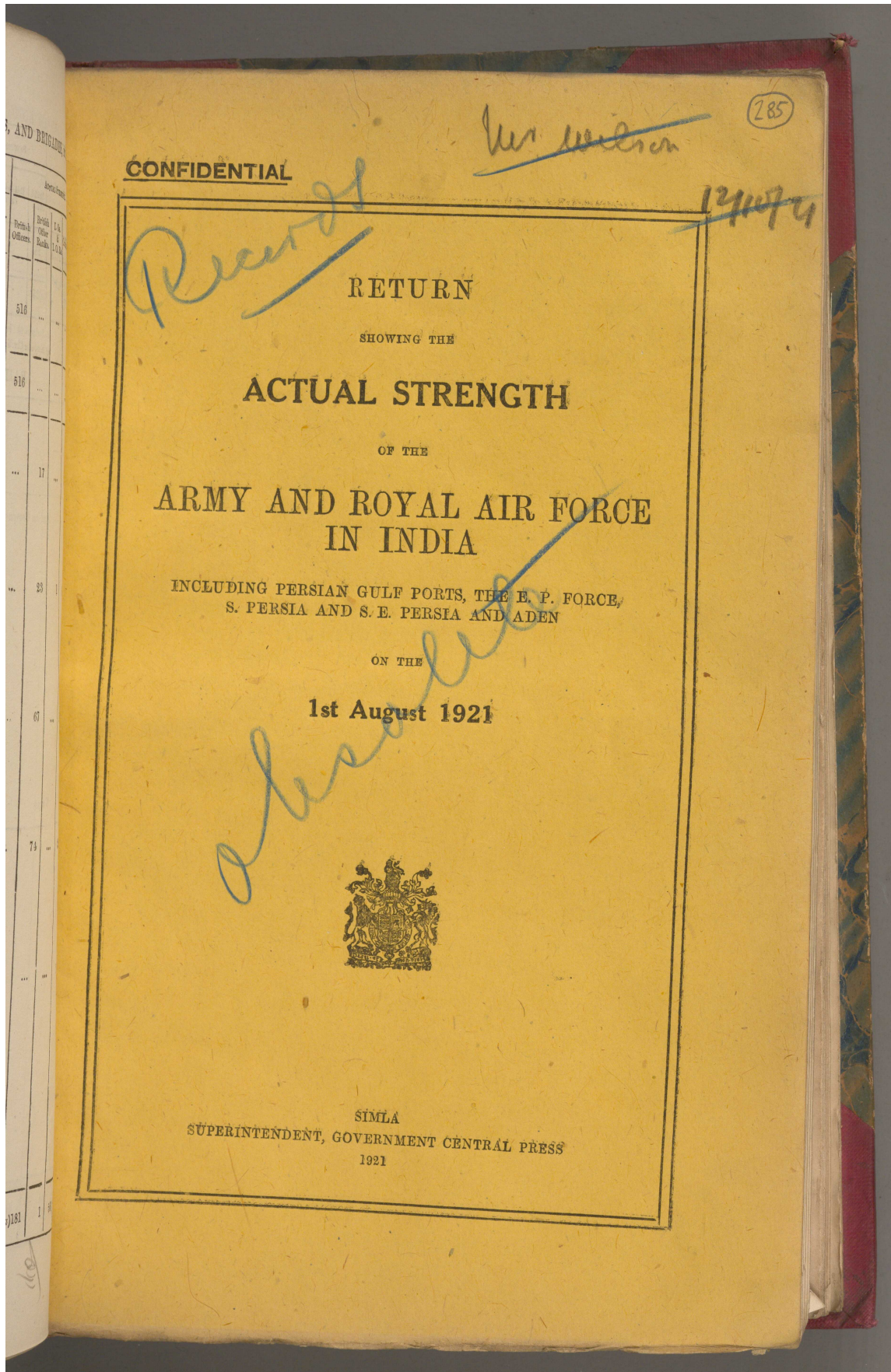
- 'Departmental and Administrative Services'.

The returns are further divided into sub-categories such as: sanctioned and actual strength; British and Indian officers, other ranks, and followers; 'Class I' and 'Class II' personnel; 'Active', 'Reserve', and 'Cadet' personnel; and 'Mounted' and 'Foot' personnel.

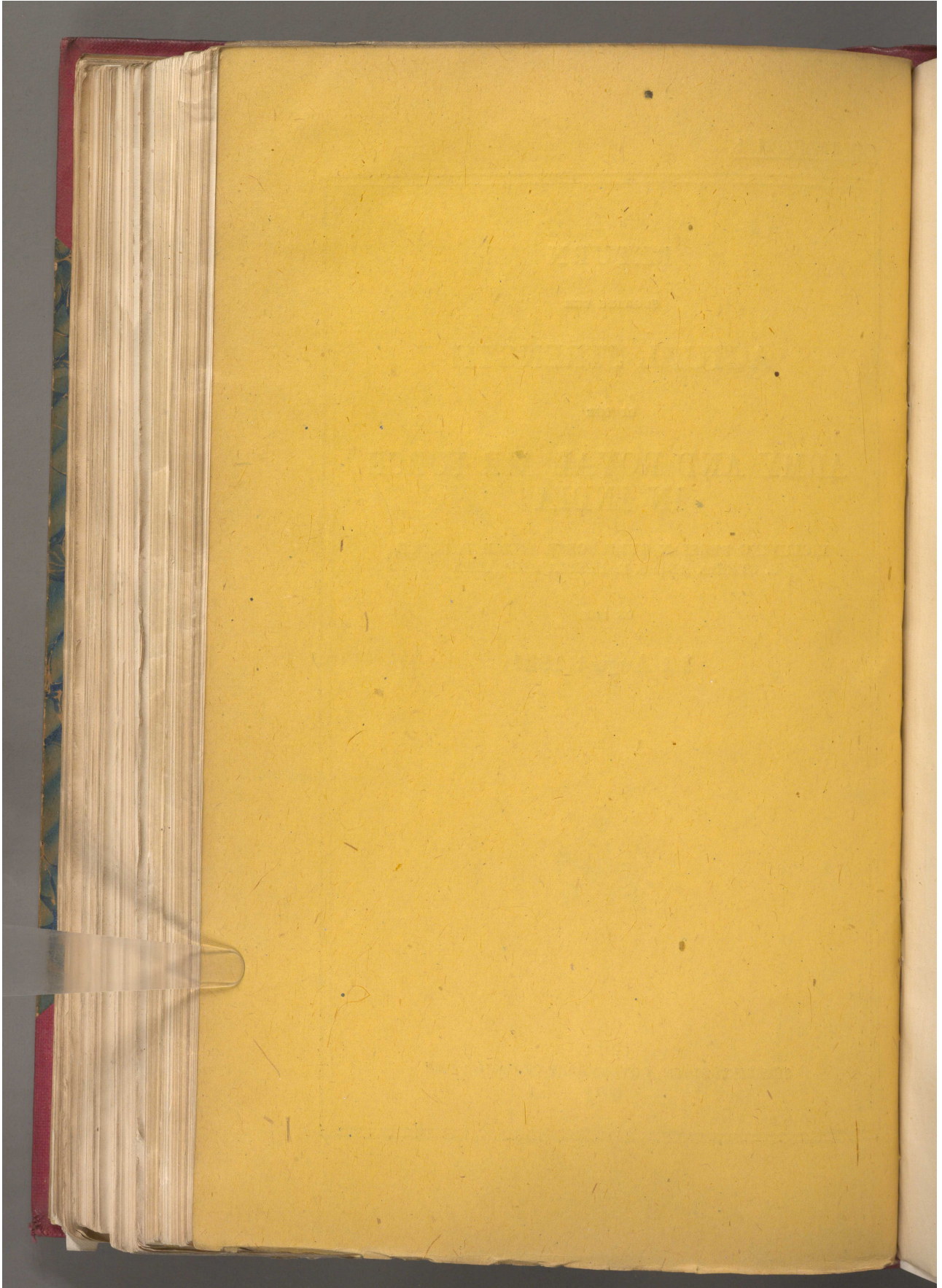
