

والبحث عن سكن أنسب هناك.



Extract Political Letter from Bombay

Dated 29th October 1811.

135- In the 140th to 144th paragraphs
of our letter dated the 14th of April 1810, We
had the honor to advise of the arrangements
adopted under the sanction of the Supreme
Government, for consolidating the Residencies
of Bushire and Muscat, in the person of
Mr. N. H. Smith, of your Civil Establishment
at this Presidency. -

135- But Mr. Smith having written
to us from Muscat, that the baneful climate
of that place would not admit of his
residing there even for a short period, -
without injury to his health; We complied
with his request to be relieved from all

further charge of the duties of the Muscat
Residency: and we also revoked the appointment
announced in the ^{1st} paragraph of our Advices

no European constitution can reside in
that deleterious climate with impunity. -







to these Para's unnecessary.





Extract Bombay Political Consultations
9th May 1810

In consequence of Mr. Smith's
relinquishment of the station of Consul,
the appointment of Messrs. Babington &
Williams as assistants to the latter in the
Political Department at Bushire & Muscat
must of course be dissolved, and as Mr.
Bruce who has so long acted as assistant
to the Commercial Resident at Bushire
(from which he cannot be removed
without undue hardship or some fault
on his part) constitutes an Establishment
quite equal to all the purposes of the
existing or even the prospective views of
the Honble Company, as to any extent of
trade that can be carried on in the Gulf
on their account, it appears under these
circumstances necessary to revert to that
part


part of the original Instructions to Capt.
Mainwight and to Capt. Smith, which
had for their object to provide a more
healthy station for the residence of the

& Mr. Bruce till further orders —







the 9th March 1811.

Chief Secretary to Government,
Bombay.

Sir,

I am directed to signify to you, for the
information of the Honble the Governor in Council,
that Mr. N. H. Smith has received the permission
of the Right Honble the Governor General to
resign his political functions, as Resident at
Abusheher, for the purpose of proceeding to Europe
in the ensuing Month, and that he is permitted to
draw his Allowances until the period of his embarkation.
