About this record

A copy of a letter from Sir Harford Jones, HM Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary to Persia [Iran] to Lord Minto, Governor-General of Bengal, sent from Tauris [Tabrīz] and dated 30 January 1810. The letter forwards correspondence relating to the Napoleonic Wars in Europe (not included in this item).

The letter was enclosed in Jones's letter No. 5 to the Secret Committee of the Court of Directors of the East India Company dated 26 March 1810.

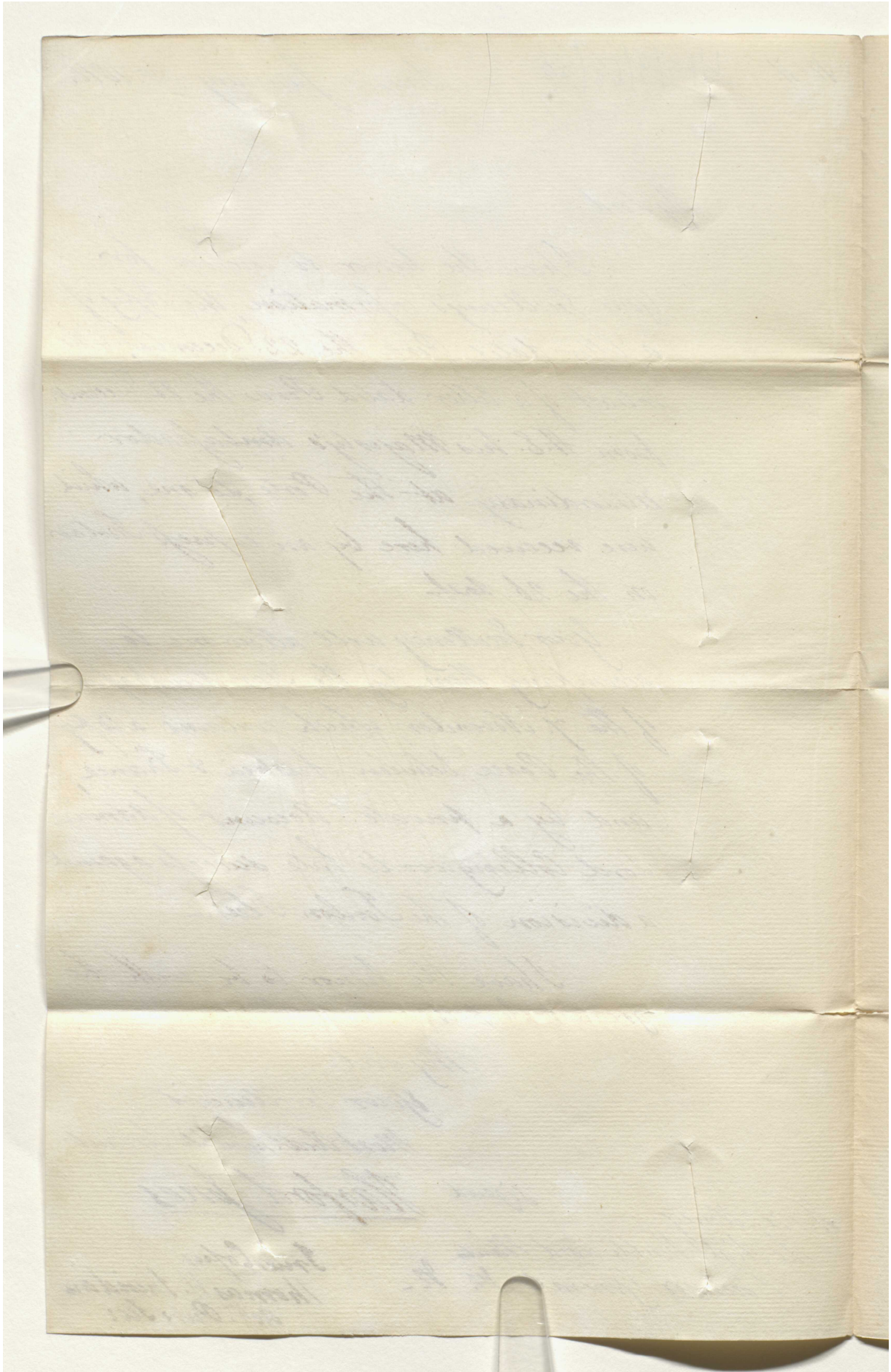

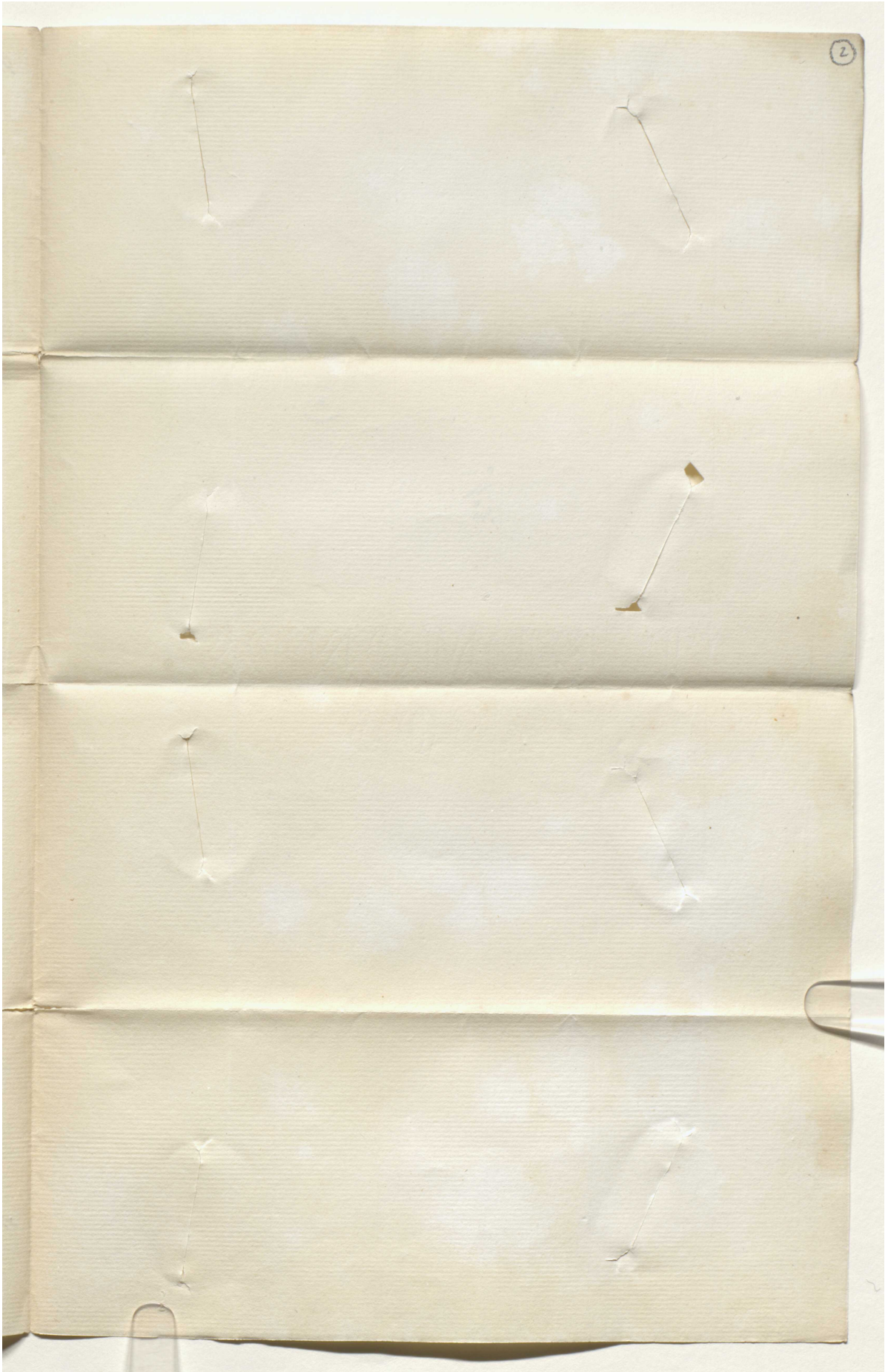
