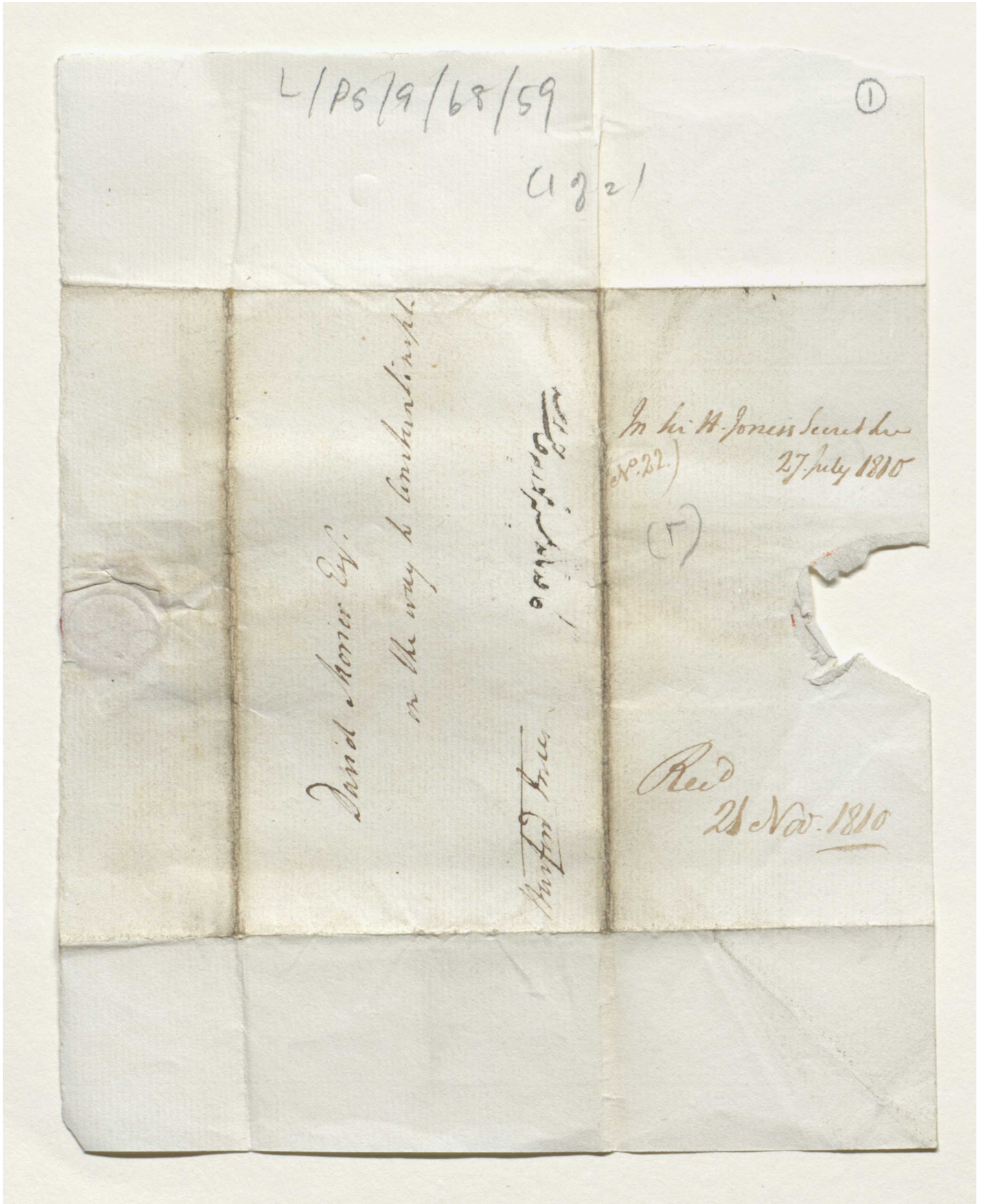


About this record

Letter from HM Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary to Persia [Iran], Sir Harford Jones, to his secretary David Morier, of 9 June 1810. In the letter Jones requests that Morier remove a dispatch concerning 'the affair of the Chintz and Tobacco' from a packet addressed to the Secret Committee of the East India Company.

The letter was enclosed in Jones's secret letter of 27 July 1810, which was received on 21 November 1810.

My dear David

I am here on ^{my} way to the King's Camp
and have just recollected, that at the time
I wrote you to take out Adair's Packet, the
Packet N^o. 14. to Earl Bathurst - about the
Affair of the Chirk and Tabaco, I forgot
to mention to you that the copy of this
dispatch was also sent to the Secret
Committee; and that it would be
therefore necessary to suppress that also.
Ruston having left ^{behind} the Key of the
Trunk containing my Papers I cannot
tell you the exact Number of the Packet
to the Secret Committee which contains
them.

either 10. 11 or 12. and most likely
11. at all Events open the Packet
to the Lord Committee until you
find the right one & return it to me.

It may serve to guide you in guessing

taken to Earl Bulmer & your letter.

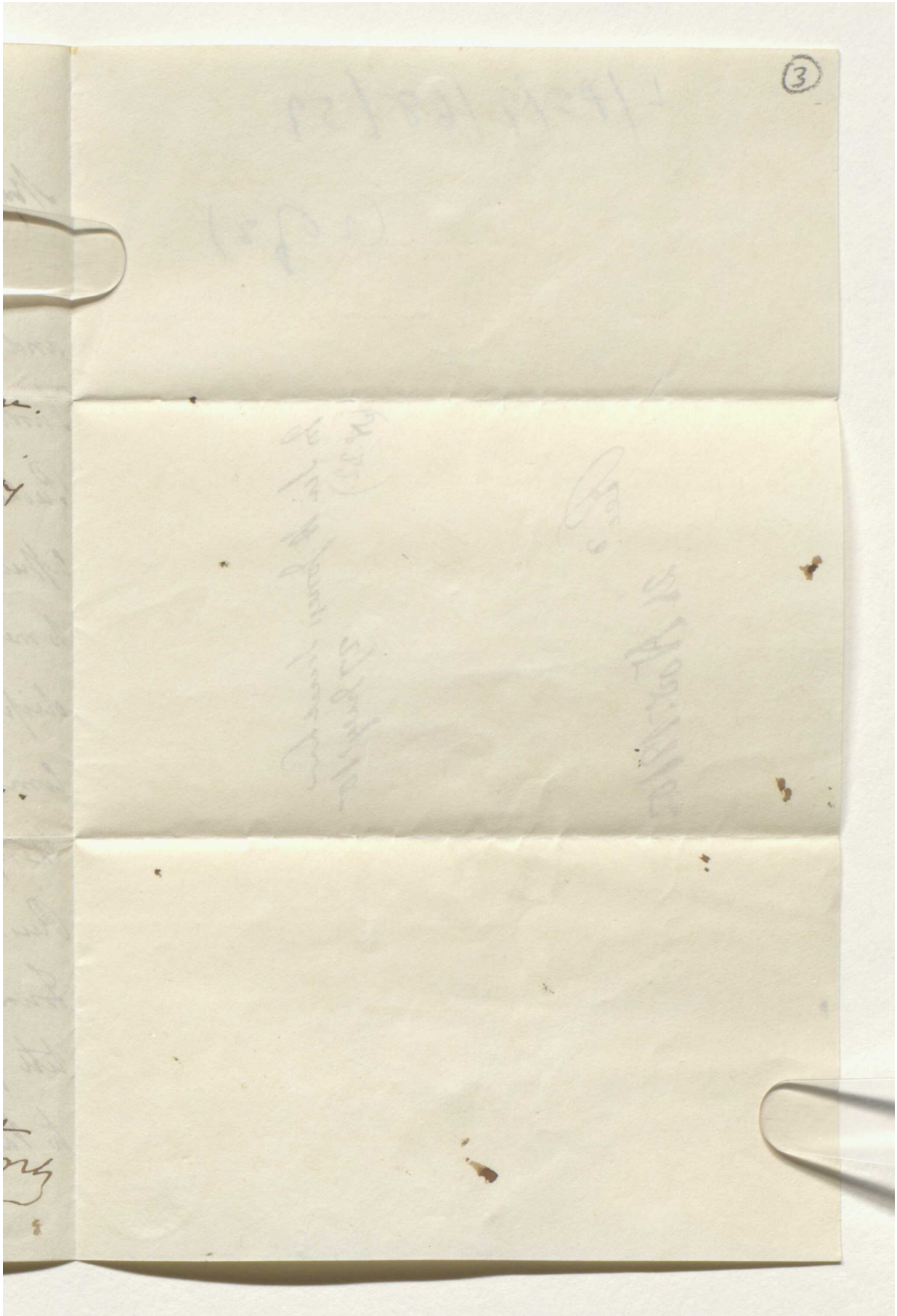
