Copy of a letter, numbered 2, from HM Ambassador Extraordinary to Persia [Iran], in Tabriz, to the Secret Committee of the East India Company, of 16 July 1813, which was received on 24 January 1814. The letter congratulates the Secret Committee on the prospect of peace between Persia and Russia, and encloses a copy of Ouseley's dispatch No. 9 to the Governor-General of the Presidency of Fort William, Lord Minto (not included in this item, see IOR/L/PS/9/68/136).

Tabriz - July 16th 1813

My Lord & Honorable Sir,

My dispatches for His Majesty's
Minister for Foreign Affairs will
apprize you of the state of affairs
in this quarter, and I beg leave to
offer my congratulations to your
Honorable Committee on the progress
now before us of speedily concluding
a Peace between Russia and Persia,
and thus putting an end to the
payment of a Subsidy, the results of
which I am sorry to say are not
so beneficial to this Country, as the
continuance of it must be burthensome
to the Honorable Company.

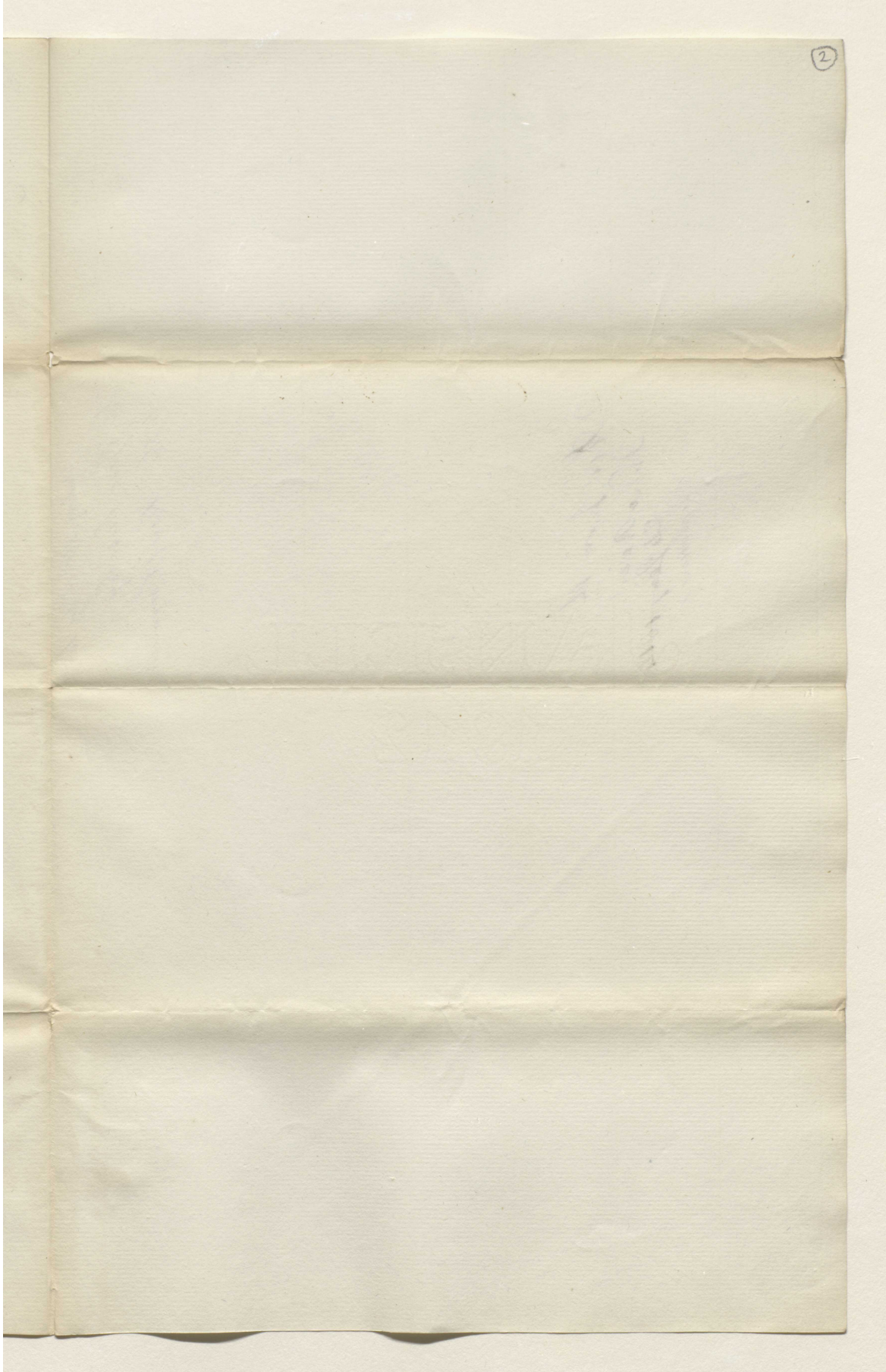
