Copy of a letter from HM Ambassador to Persia [Iran], Sir Gore Ouseley, in Tabriz, to the Chairman, Deputy Chairman and the Court of Directors of the East India Company, of 16 July 1813, which was received on 11 January 1814. The letter reports the raise of the rate of exchange between Persia and India by five percent, and the result of this upon the subsidy paid by the Company to Persia.

5 per cent since the middle of April last

Calcutta Siva Rupees 100 -	146 - 2 - 40	151 - 2 - 40
Arcot Rupees — 100 -	142 - - 20	147 - 0 - 20
Bombay Rupees 100 -	137 - 2 -	142 - 2 - -

So that at present the subsidy of 200,000 Tumans
is only a fraction more than thirteen Lacs of
Siva Rupees.

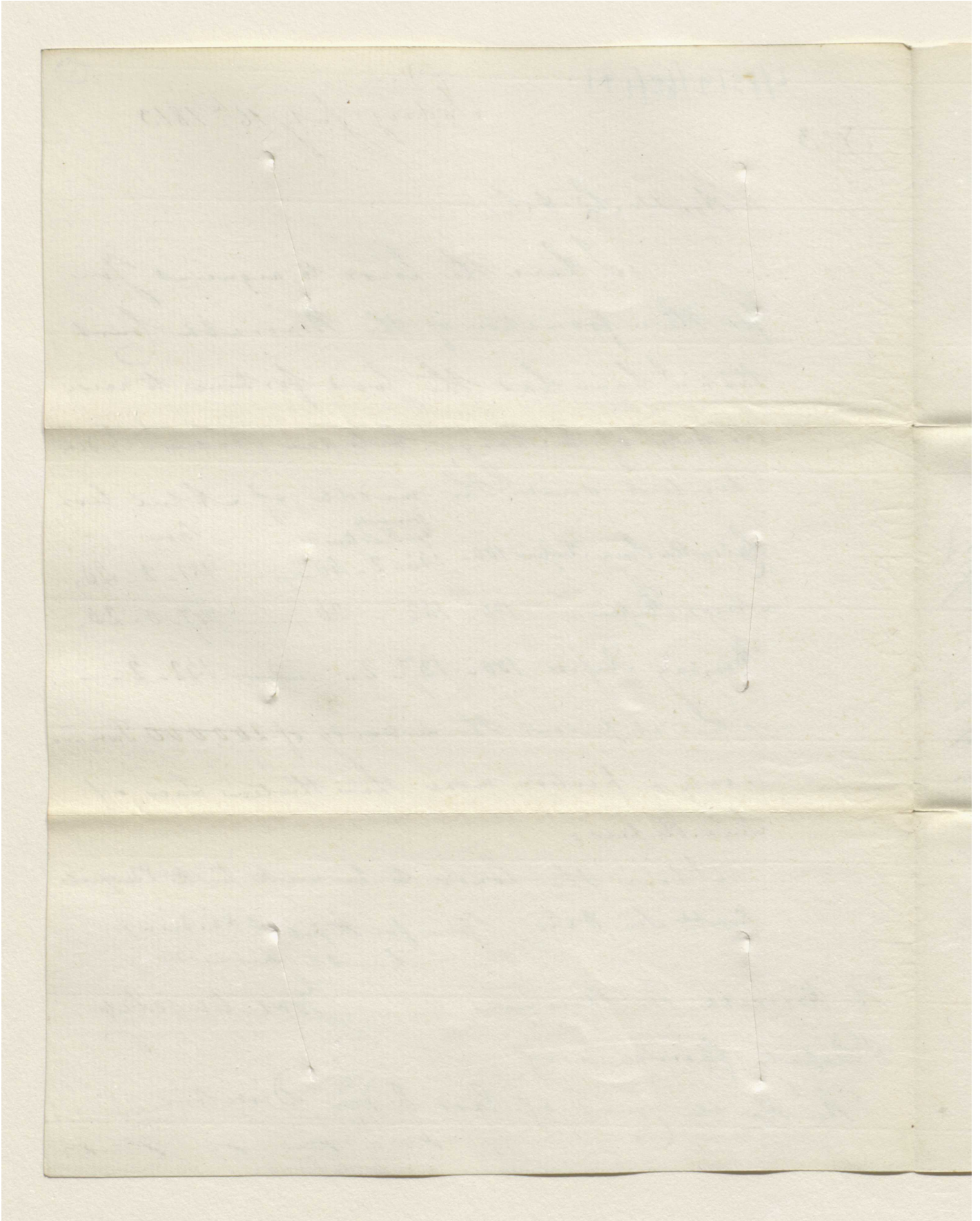

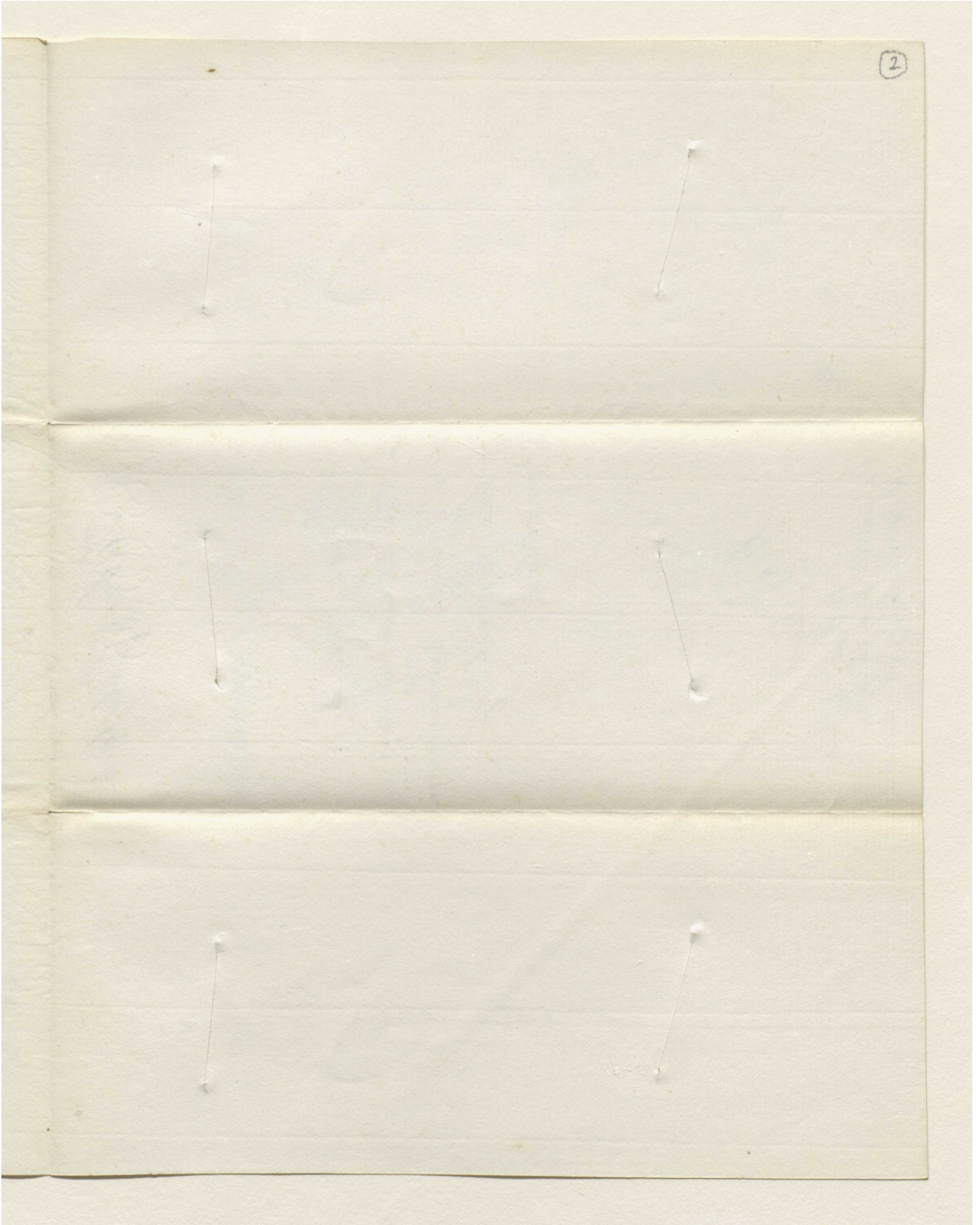

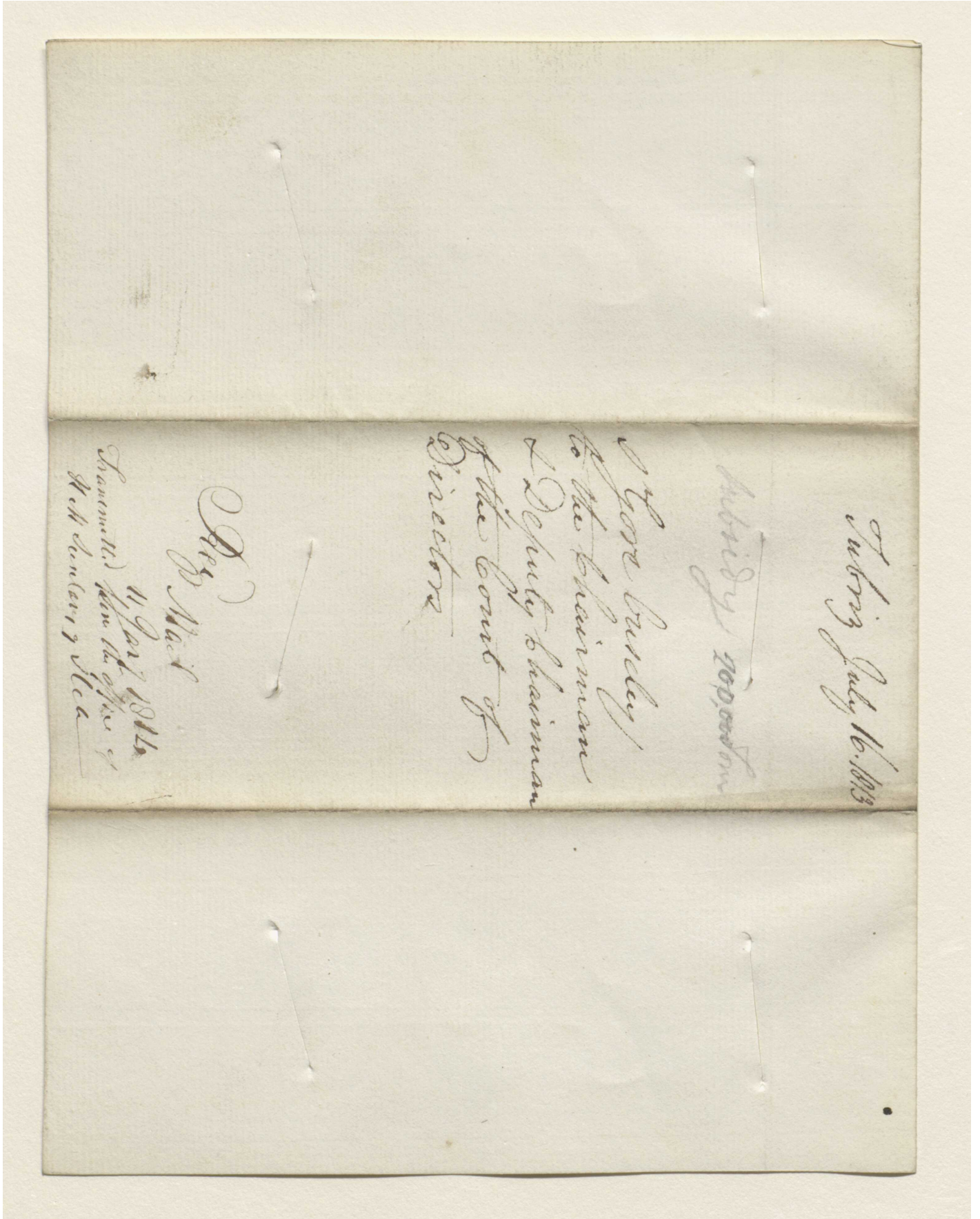
