About this record

Translation of the Preliminary Treaty between Major-General Sir William Grant Keir, on behalf of Great Britain, and Hassan bin Ali [Shaikh Hasan bin Ali al-Qasimi?], the Shaikh of Al-Rams, signed at Ras il Khyma [Ra's al-Khaymah] on 15 January 1820.

The treaty was enclosed in Keir's letter to HM Chargé d'Affaires to Persia [Iran], Henry Willock, of January 1820 (see IOR/L/PS/9/68/232).

Translation of the Preliminary Treaty with Hassan
bin Ali -

In the name of God, the merciful, the compassionate.

Know all men that Hassan bin Ali
has been in the presence of General Sir
William Grant Scin, and there have
passed between them the following
stipulations -

Article 1. If any of the rebels of Hassan
bin Ali are in Shagah, or Umm, or Gyrya
or Sman, or Wun, or Hyabee, or any other
of the places to which the General shall
go with the Force, such rebels shall
be surrendered to the General, and the
General will leave those which are for the
pearl fishing and fishing boats -

Article 2. Hassan bin Ali shall give
up all the Indian prisoners, if any
such.

such are in his possession. -

Art: 3. After this, Hassan bin Ali
shall be admitted to the terms of the
general Treaty with the friendly Arab.
End of the Article. -

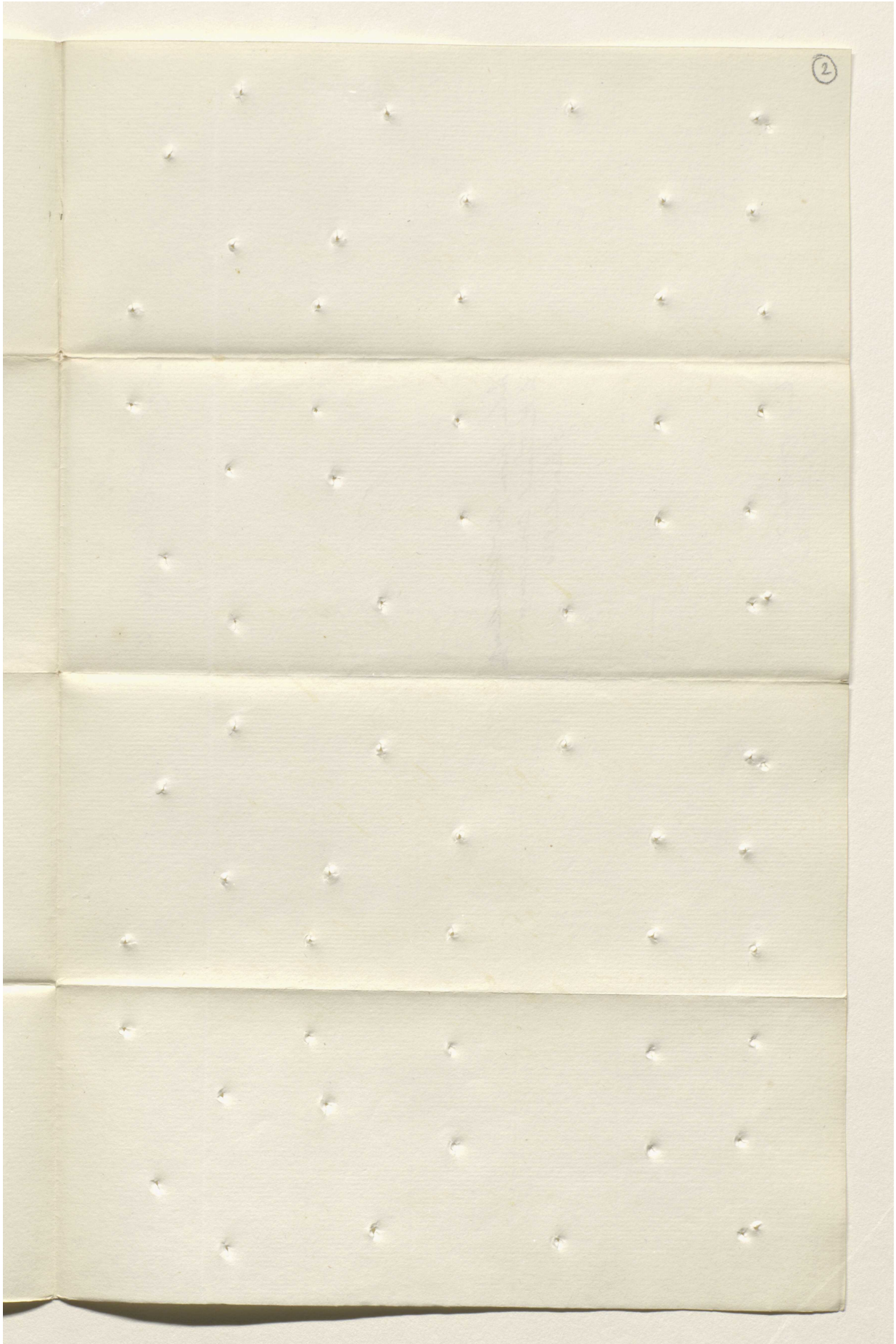
