About this record

A copy of a letter from James Parish, Secretary to the Government of Bombay [Mumbai], to Major George Willock, Acting Chargé d'Affaires in Persia [Iran], sent from Bombay Castle and dated 1 December 1822.

The letter forwards correspondence relating to the agreement between William Bruce, Resident in Bushire [Būshehr], and the Government of Fars at Shiraz.

The letter was enclosed in Willock's letter to the Secret Committee of the Court of Directors of the East India Company dated 25 January 1823 (IOR/L/PS/9/69/126).

Sir,

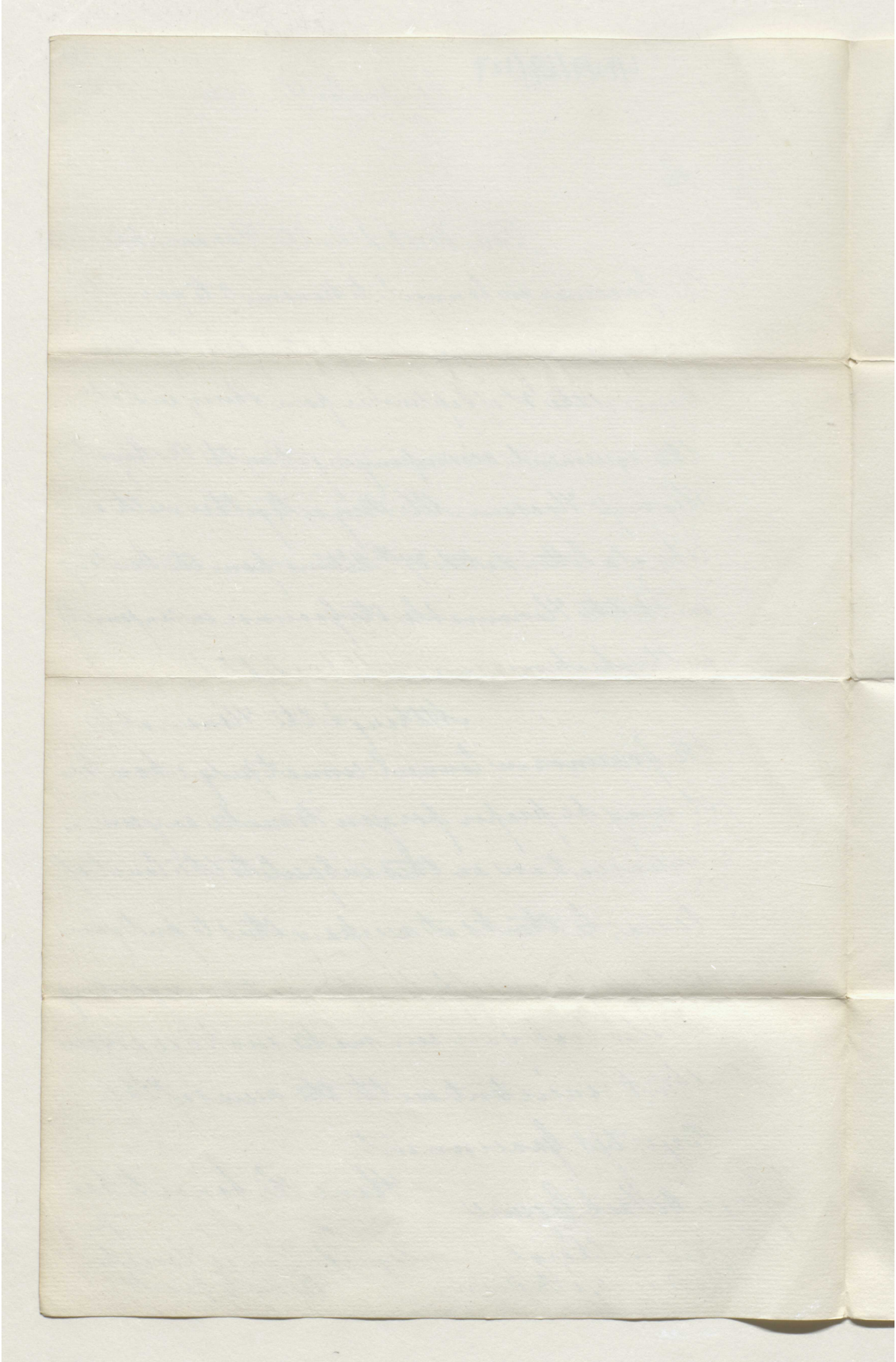
I am directed by the Honorable
the Governor in Council to transmit to you the
accompanying copy of a despatch from Captain
Bruce of the 2^d of September from Shering and of
the agreement accompanying it with His Royal
Highness Hoosain Allie Muza, together with a
copy of a letter dated 27th Ultimo from the Secretary
with the Honorable the Governor in conformity
with which measures will be adopted.

Although the Honorable
the Governor in Council cannot judge how far
it may be proper for you to make any com-
-munication on this subject to the Court of
Peesa, he thinks it necessary thus to put you
in possession of full information regarding
it, in which you can make such a return as you
think consistent with the views of His
Majesty's Government.

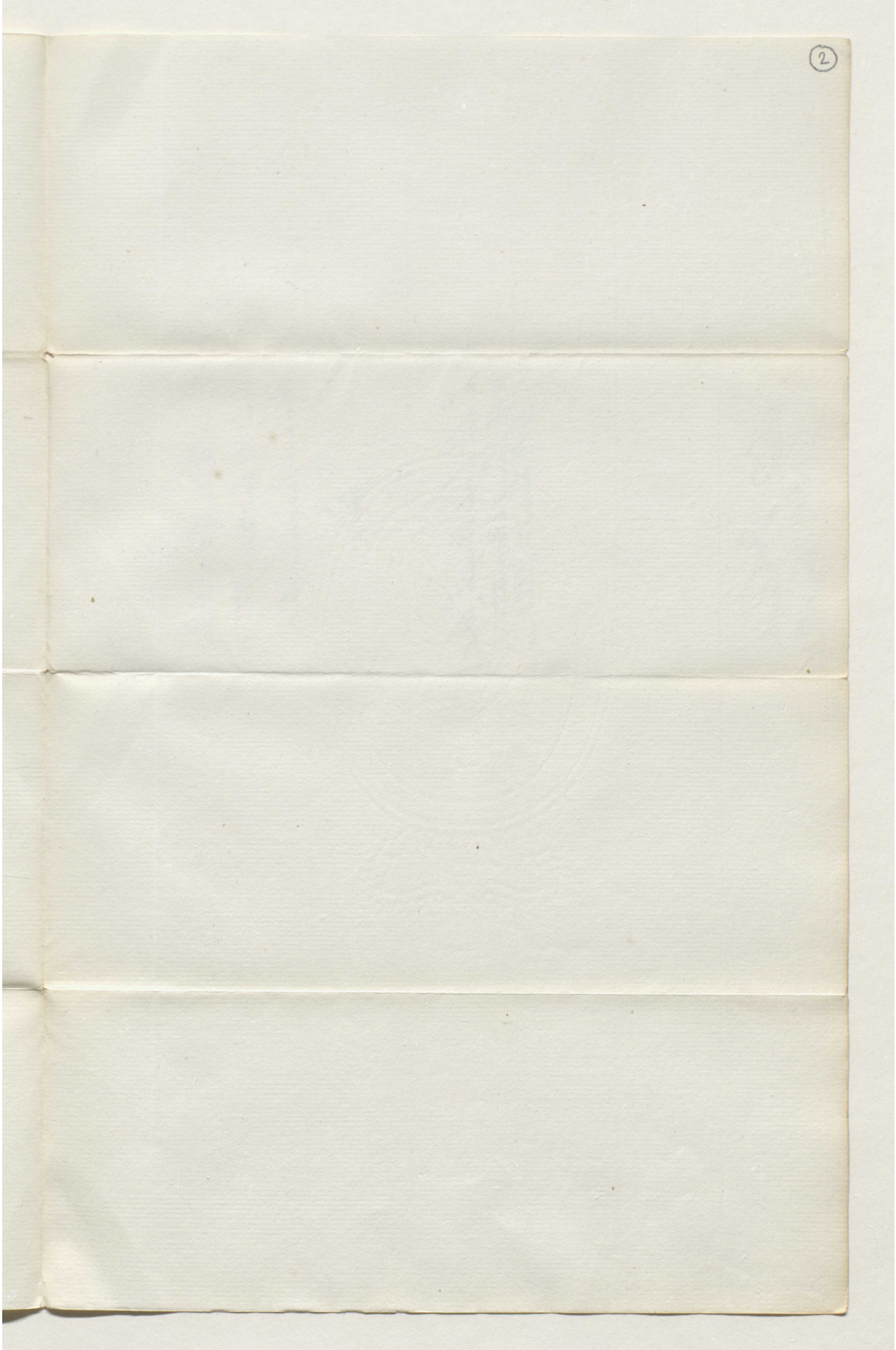
