### About this record

Tables displaying imports to and exports from Bushire [Būshehr] on British-flagged ships in the year 1819 in old and new Persian rupees, drawn from ships' manifests.

The tables were sent by Ephraim Stannus, Political Resident in the Persian Gulf, to Henry Willock, HM Chargé d'Affaires in Persia [Iran], as part of a report on trade in the Gulf (IOR/L/PS/9/69/191).

The report was enclosed in Willock's letter to the Secret Committee of the Court of Directors of the East India Company dated 14 July 1824 (IOR/L/PS/9/69/186).

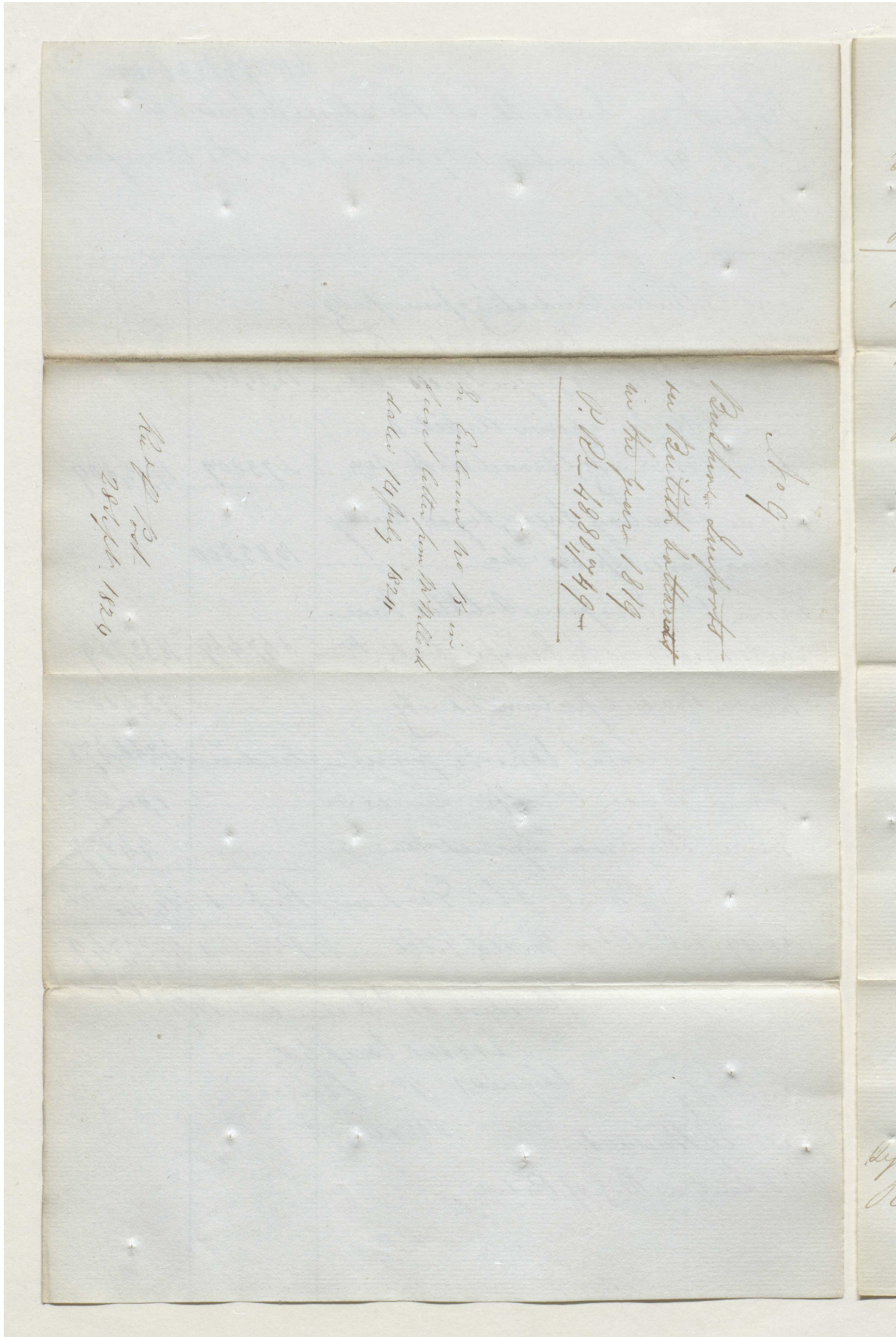
