Tables displaying imports to and exports from Bushire [Būshehr] in the year 1823 in new Persian rupees, drawn from Customs House records of ships belonging to the Shaikh of Bushire and other local vessels.

The tables were sent by Ephraim Stannus, Political Resident in the Persian Gulf, to Henry Willock, HM Chargé d'Affaires in Persia [Iran], as part of a report on trade in the Gulf (IOR/L/PS/9/69/191).

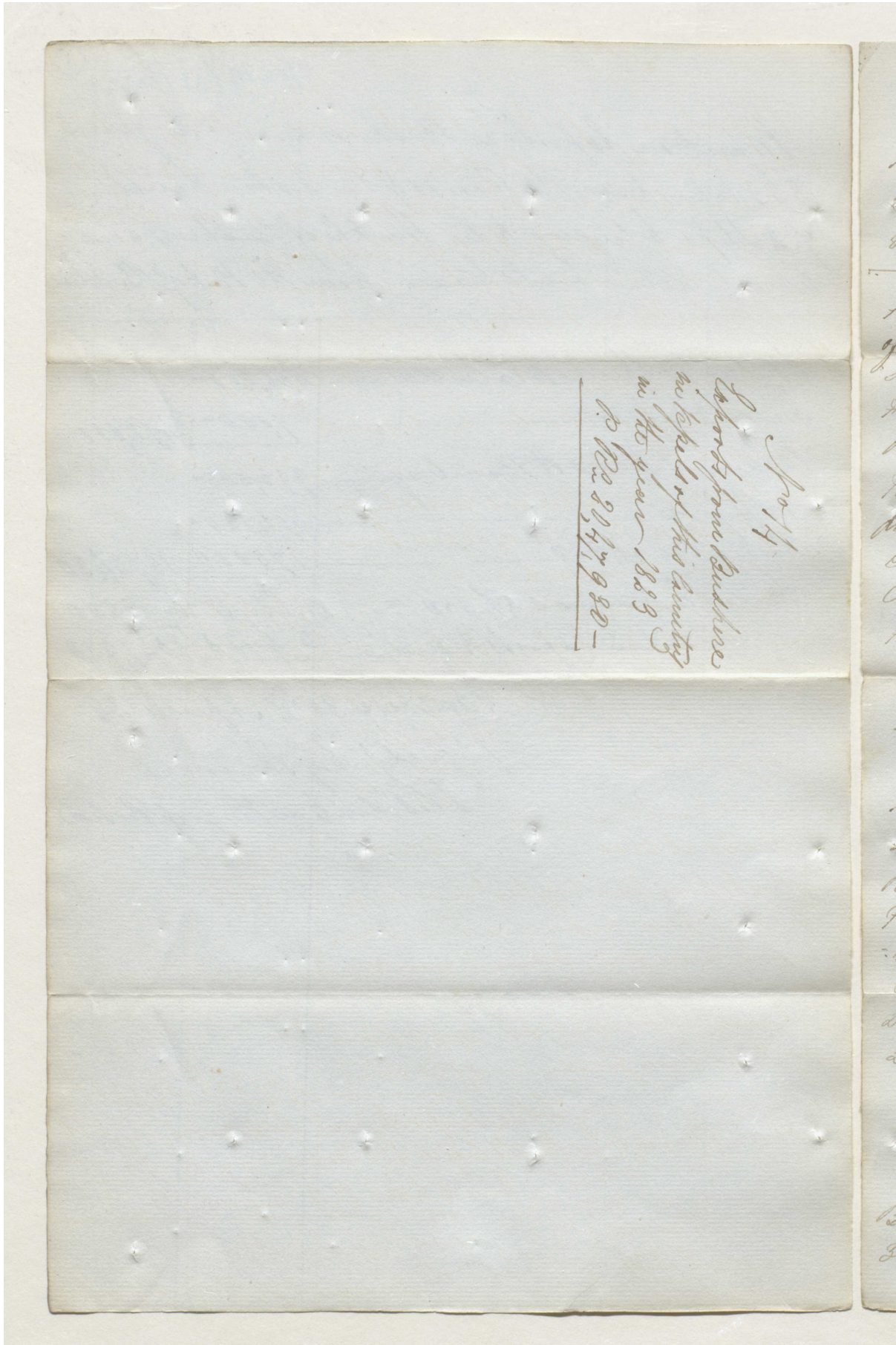

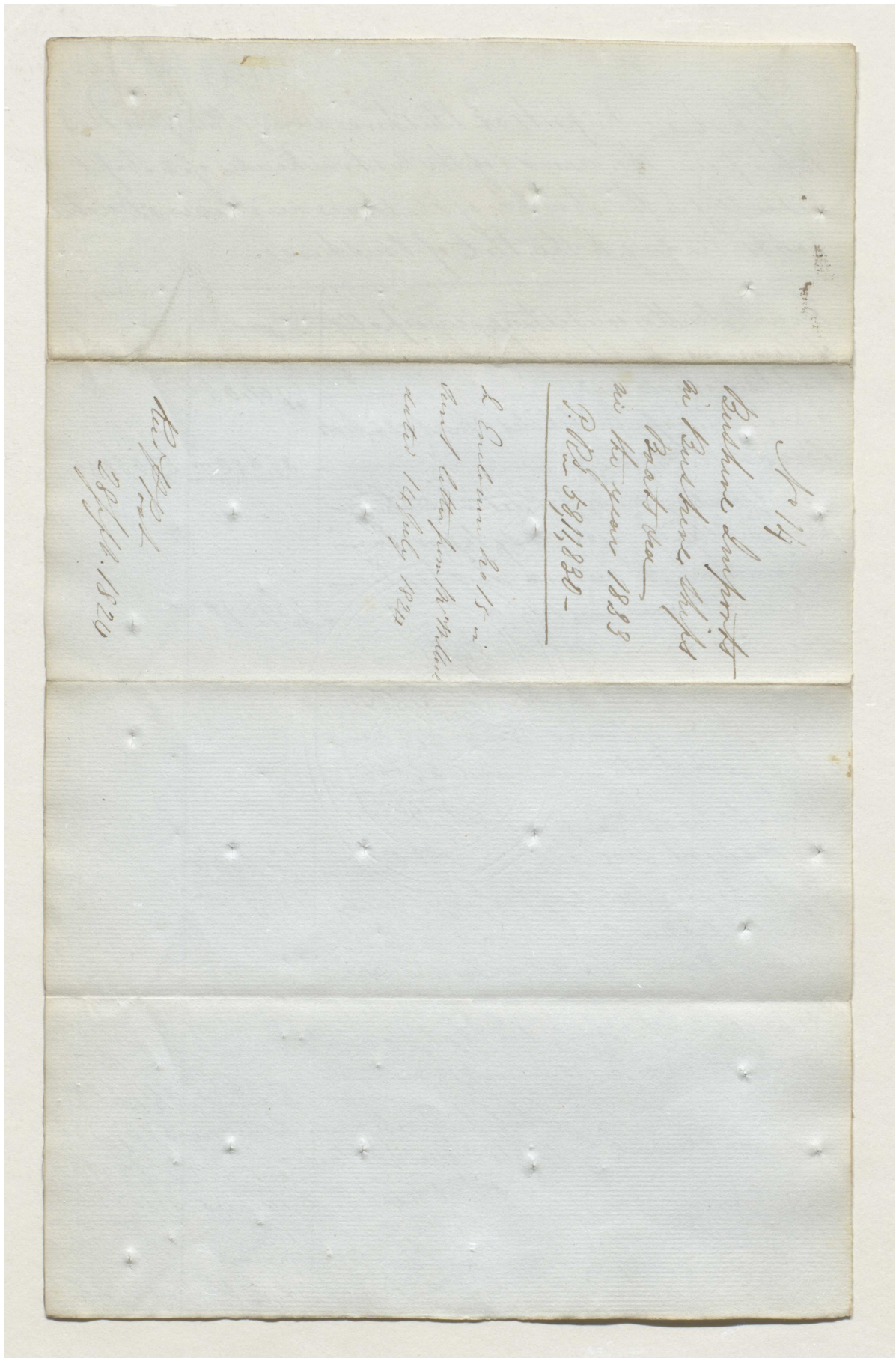
