About this record

Dispatch No. 101 from the East India Company Envoy to Persia [Iran], Lieutenant-Colonel John Macdonald Kinneir, to George Swinton, Chief Secretary of the Government of Bengal, sent from camp near Aleabad [Aliabad] and dated 29 May 1828.

Macdonald Kinneir forwards a letter from the Count of Erivan [Yerevan] [General Ivan Fyodorovich Paskevich-Erivansky, Governor-General of Georgia] for the attention of the Governor-General of Bengal.

This document was originally enclosed in Macdonald Kinneir's dispatch No. 36 to the Secret Committee of the Court of Directors of the East India Company of 5 October 1828 (IOR/L/PS/9/71/262).
