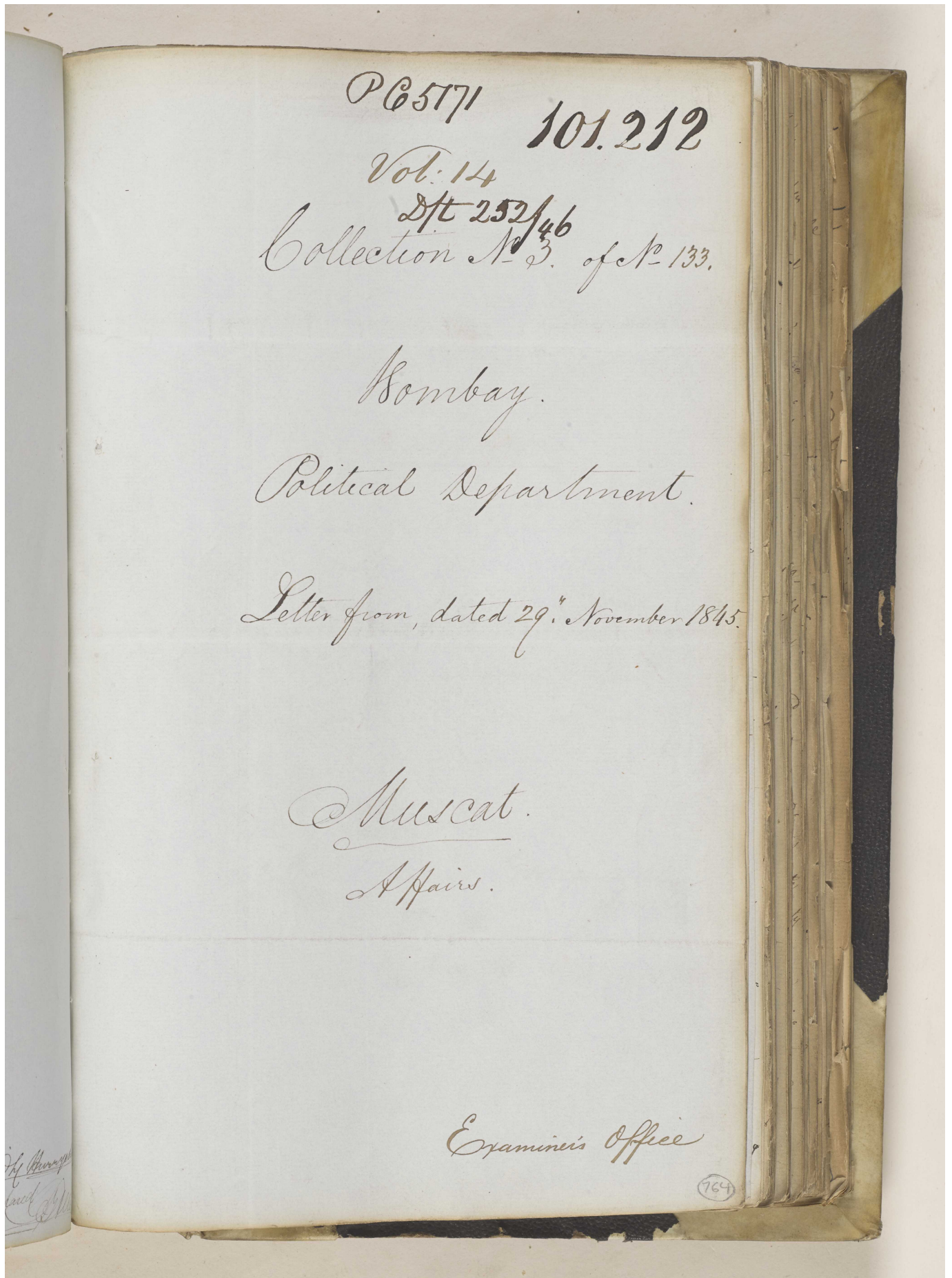


About this record

This item consists of a copy of a letter cited in political letters from the Government of Bombay [Mumbai]. The correspondent is Heskeal Yusoof [Ḥizqīl bin Yūsuf], Acting British Agent at Muscat. 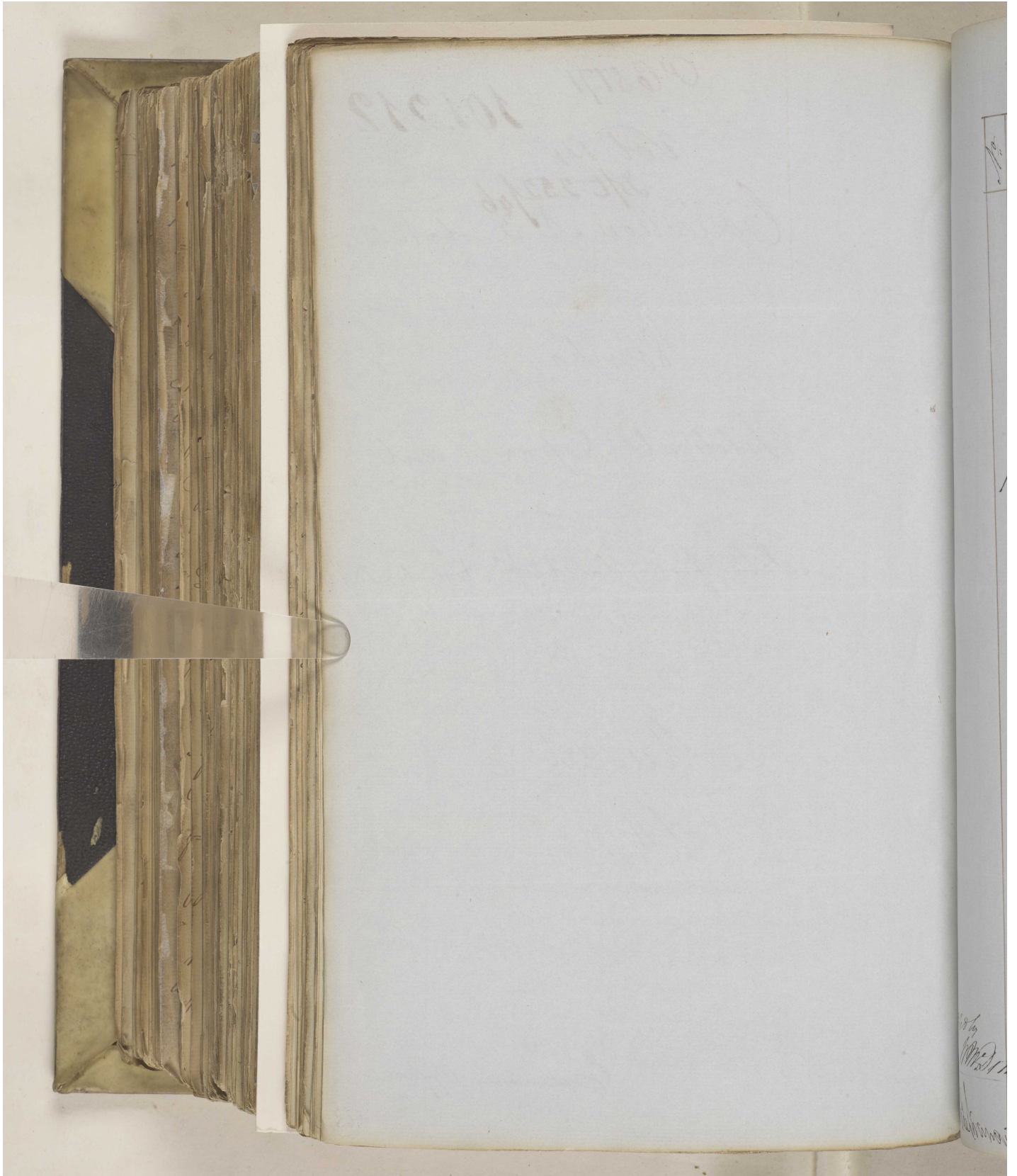

Substance of a letter from Akmal Yusoff, acting Native Agent at Muscat, to the Persian Secretary to Government dated 25th October and received 11th November 1845.

On the 7th instant Hild bin Mahomed Chief of Suk and Khatan Borsydec came to Muscat and on the 9th instant they were deputed to the people of the Banyabur tribe to ask them to go to Burka to have an interview with Syud Thoenec there. On the 13th inst. Syud Thoenec went to Burka and on the 21st returned to Muscat.

A Bugla belonging to Syud Thoenec which arrived here on the 13th instant, has brought news that every thing was quiet at Zanzibar and that two hundred troops had arrived there.

On the 23rd instant a Bugla arrived here from Bander Abbas bringing intelligence that Shaikh Saif bin Kubhan intended to throw up intrenchments around the fort & demanded some thousands of Tomans from his subjects for the purpose, as the Chief of Shiraz was about to visit the Persian coast.
