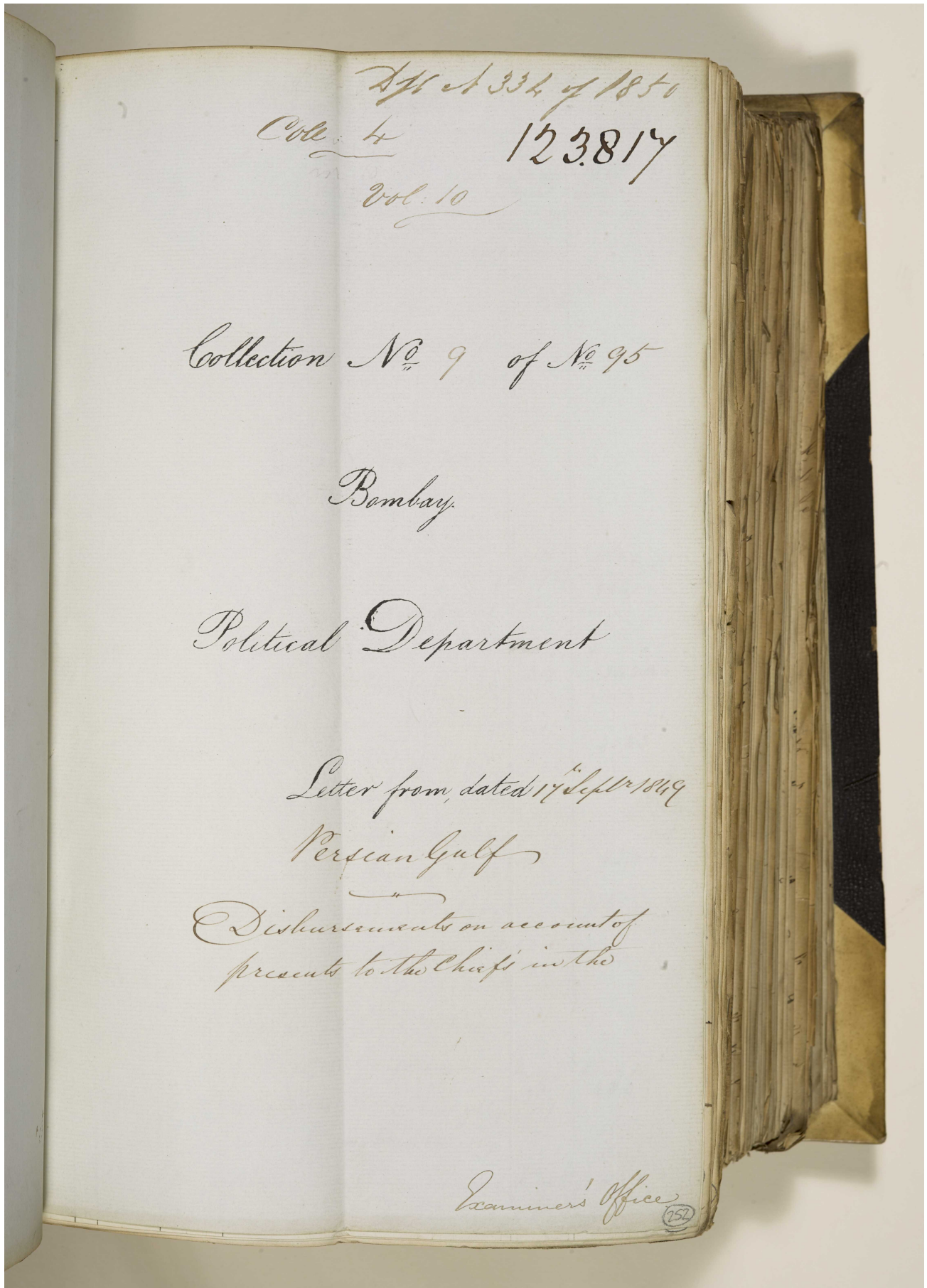
About this record

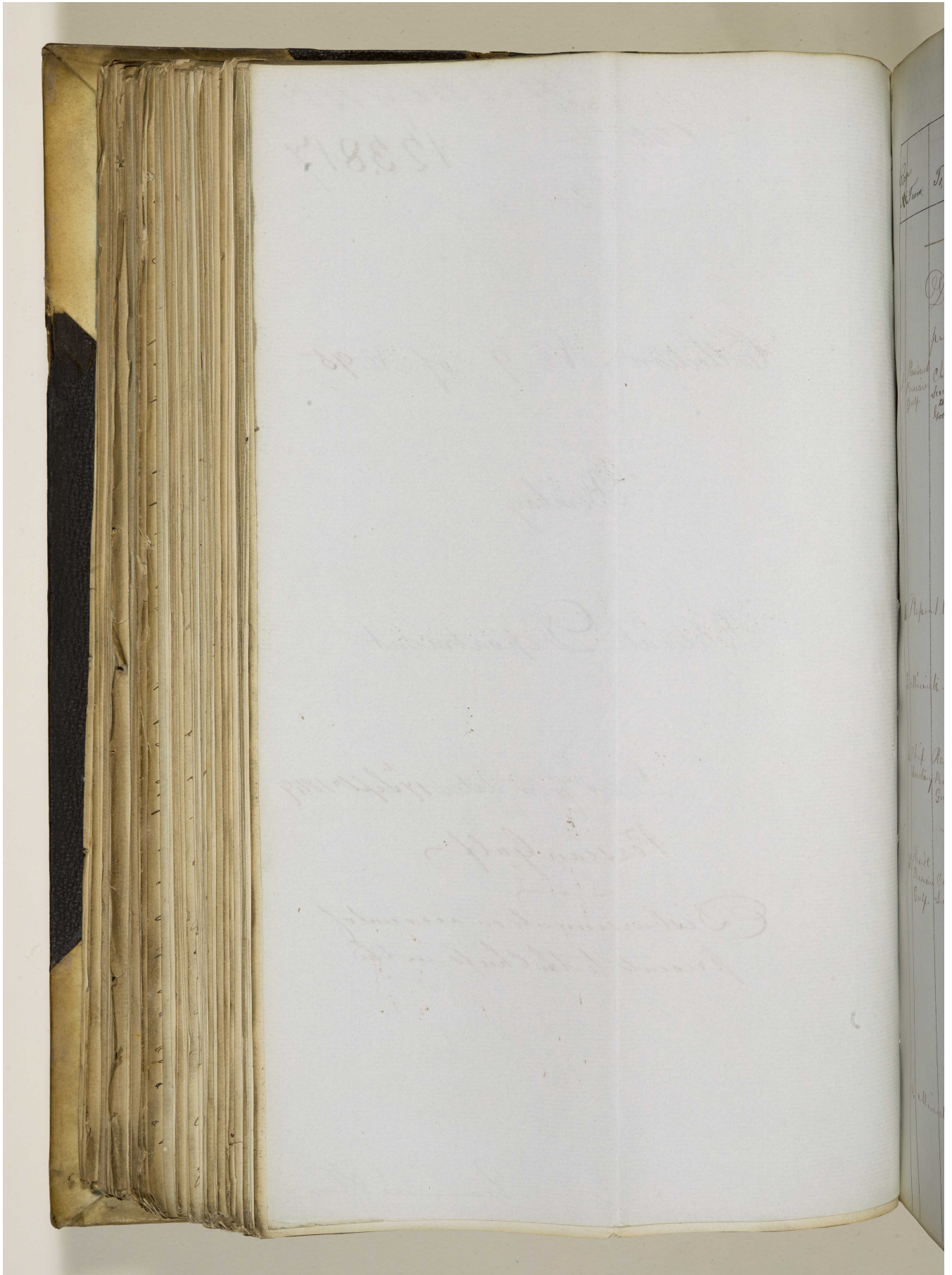

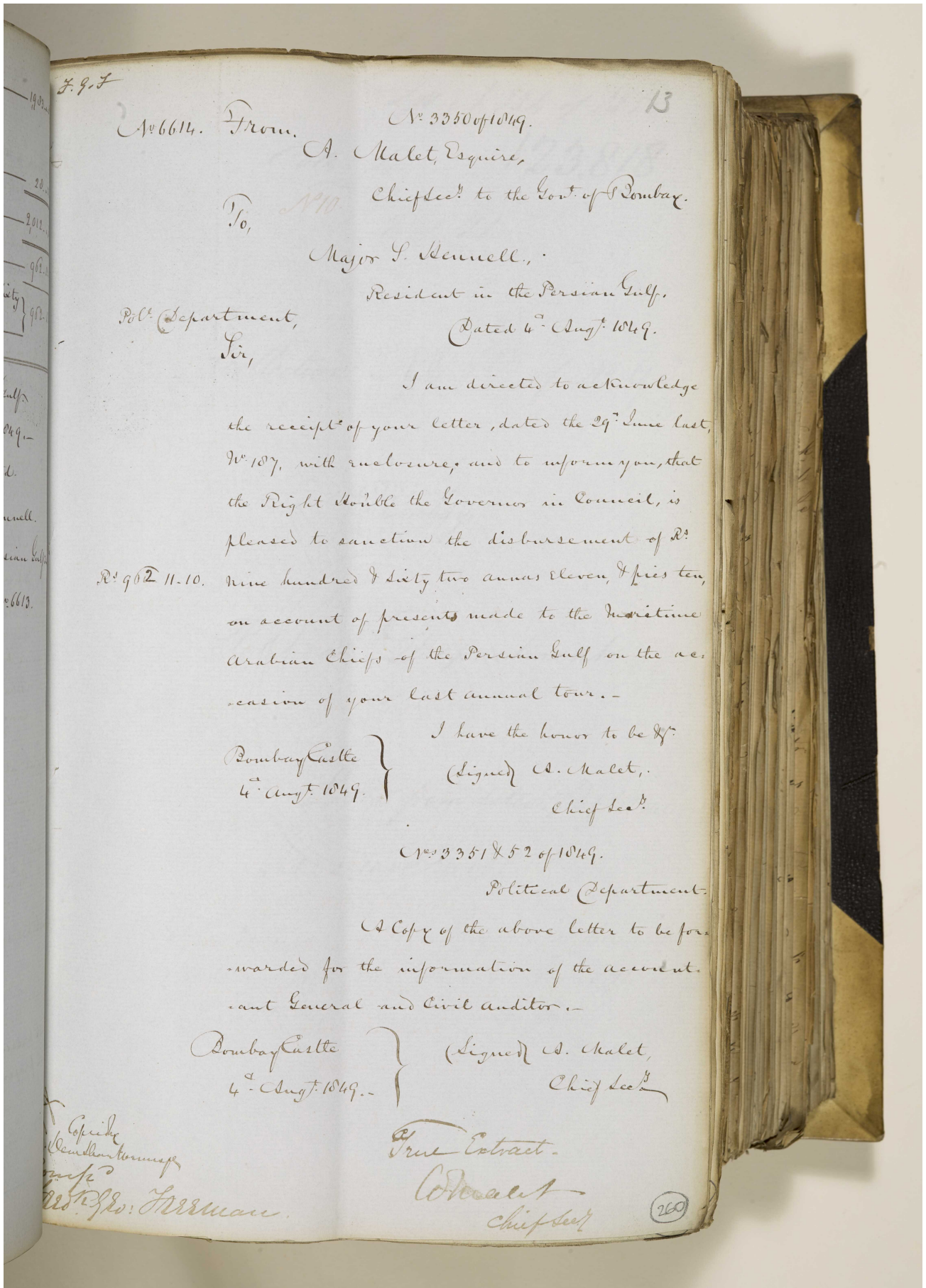
This expenditure, amounting
 to Rupees 962-11-10., is less by rupees 157-15-2. than
 for the year 1848., and by rupees 355-11-5. than for
 1847, but is considerably in excess of that for
 1844/5/6.; under the circumstances however,
 mentioned in Major Hennell's letter N^o 75 of the
 3^d October last, showing the advantages resulting
 from the distribution of these presents during
 the Resident's annual tour, I think this bill
 may be passed without comment. —
