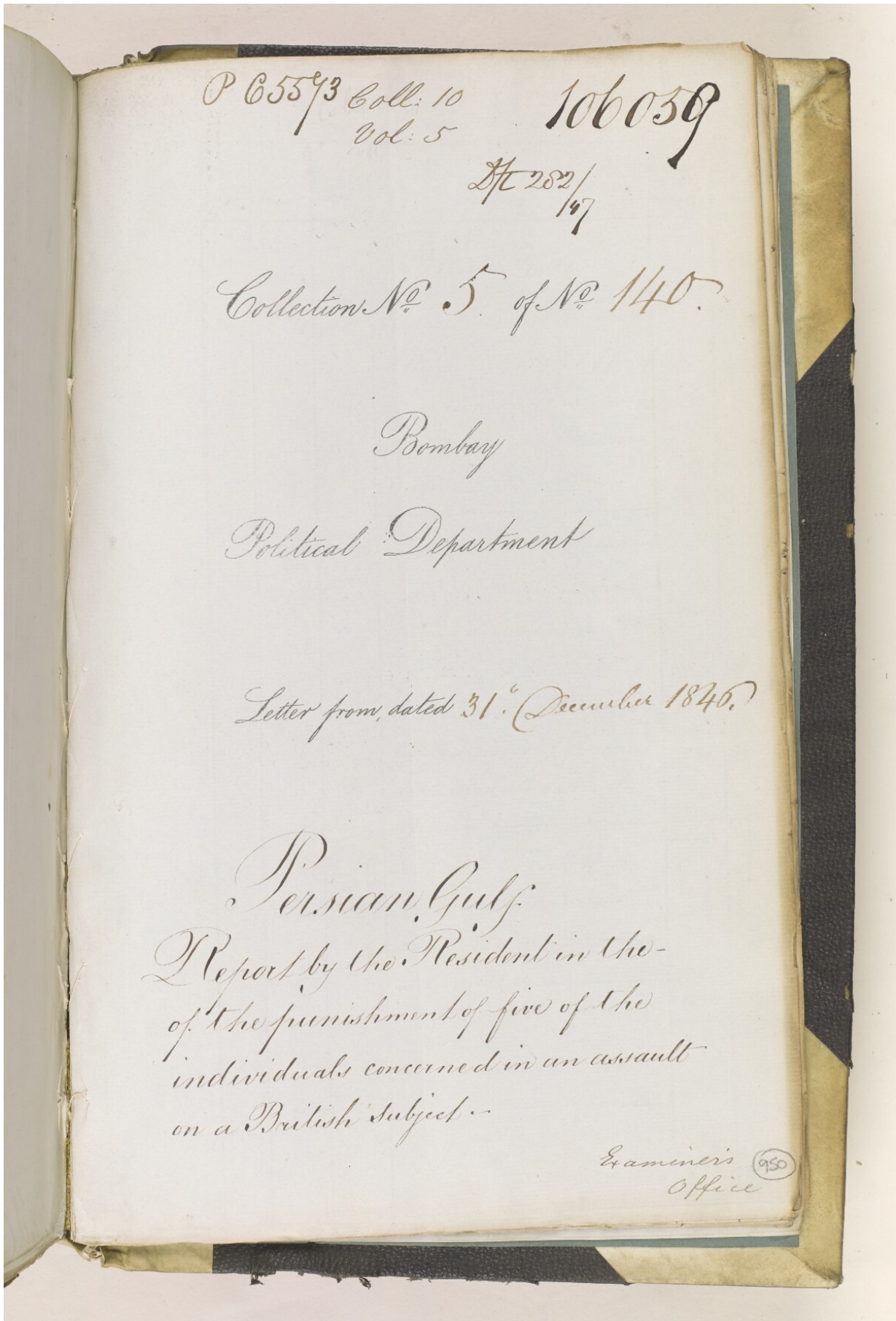

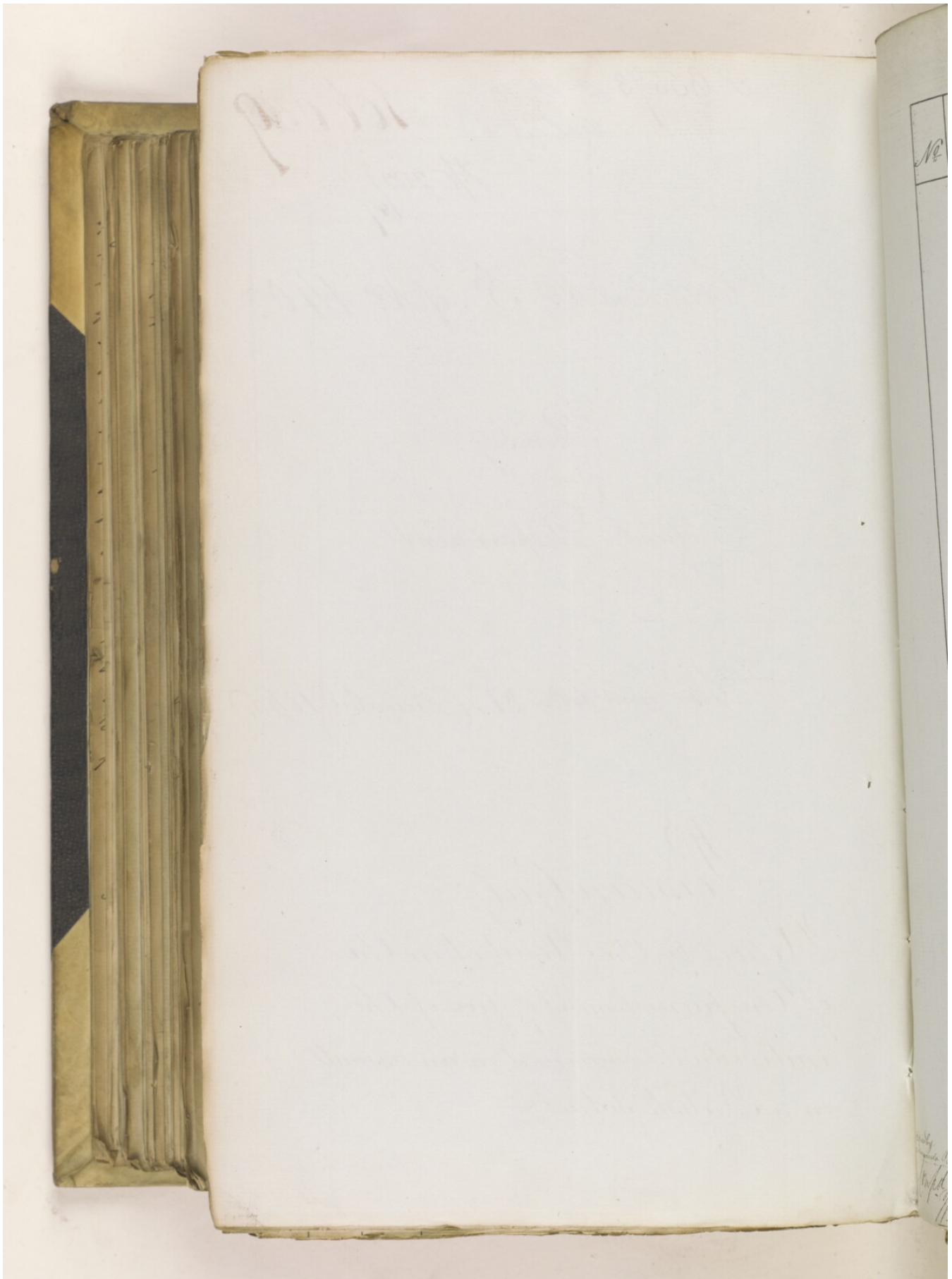

Sir,  
I have the honor to transmit for the information of the Honorable the Governor in Council, the accompanying copy of a despatch dated the 8<sup>th</sup> Instant, addressed by me to Her Majesty's Minister at the Court of Tehran, reporting the corporal punishment of five of the individuals concerned in the assault upon Shaikh Yousuf bin Suggur, and the little prospect existing of the arrest of Shaikh Hossain and those of his followers who were the principals in this affair. Sir,  
With reference to my despatch to the address





address of your Excellency, under date the 1<sup>st</sup> of  
Ullinô, N. 207, on the subject of the outrageous  
assault upon Shaikh Yoosef bin Suggur by the  
followers of Shaikh Houssein, I have the honor to  
acquaint you, that Houssein Ally Khan, the Moolhissit  
sent down by the Governor of Fars, for the purpose  
of conveying the offending Parties to Shiraz, has  
now been in Bushire for some time. As I  
anticipated his Mission has failed entirely, so  
far as relates to the arrest of Shaikh Houssein  
and the five Individuals, principally concerned  
in the attack upon the Commander of the Fyzool  
Barricade. Having made their escape into the Dashedistan,  
they are of course beyond the reach of any efforts  
on the part of Shaikh Nasir to apprehend them.

2. In the course of a visit the  
Governor of Bushire paid me yesterday, he  
introduced the subject of the five Individuals  
who had been arrested as having participated  
in the assault upon Yoosef. As they were only  
inferior Subordinates in the affair, the Shaikh  
suggested, that it was not worth while sending  
them to Shiraz, as he had received full authority  
from Houssein Khan to punish them on the spot,  
in any way I might think proper. Seeing no imme-  
diate prospect of the apprehension of Shaikh Houssein,  
and the other principals, and considering that the  
five Prisoners had been kept in chains for forty  
days during this hot season, I concurred in the  
suggestion.

suggestion made by the Durcya Begew. Agreeably  
 therefore to the arrangement then made, the five  
 culprits specified in the margin, were brought  
 up to the Residency yesterday afternoon, and  
 having been severely bastinadoed by the Shaik's  
 Turashes, were liberated from confinement.

I have informed the Governor  
 of Fars of the punishment of these individuals,  
 and at the same time pointed out the useless-  
 ness of Boussein Ally Khan remaining in Bushire,  
 unless some more effectual measures are taken  
 for the arrest of Shaik Boussein and his Myrmi-  
 dons. Such however is the present temper and  
 attitude exhibited by the Chiefs of the Dashtistan  
 towards the Ruler of Fars, that I am inclined  
 to think the only prospect of the apprehension  
 and punishment of the fugitives, lies in Koupin  
 Khan carrying into execution his threat of  
 visiting the Quarmaeer in person with a Body  
 of Regular Troops on the termination of the  
 Ramzan.
