About this record

This item consists of copies of correspondence, consultations, and minutes cited in, or enclosed with, political letters from the Government of Bombay [Mumbai]. These political letters appear in IOR/F/4/2203/108134. The correspondents are the Government of Bombay and Major Samuel Hennell, Political Resident in the Persian Gulf. It is the fifth in a series of thirty items.

The item concerns the shooting of Sheik Mahomed ben Yoosoof, Chief of Nukheeloo [Shaikh Muḥammad bin Yūsuf, Shaikh of Nakhilu], by Sheik Houssein ben Jabarra, Chief of Congoon [Shaikh Ḥusayn bin Jubārah, Shaikh of Kangan], and Hennell’s intention to consequently make Sheik Houssein liable for the compensation due from Sheik Mahomed to the British on account of seizing money from the agent of a British merchant.

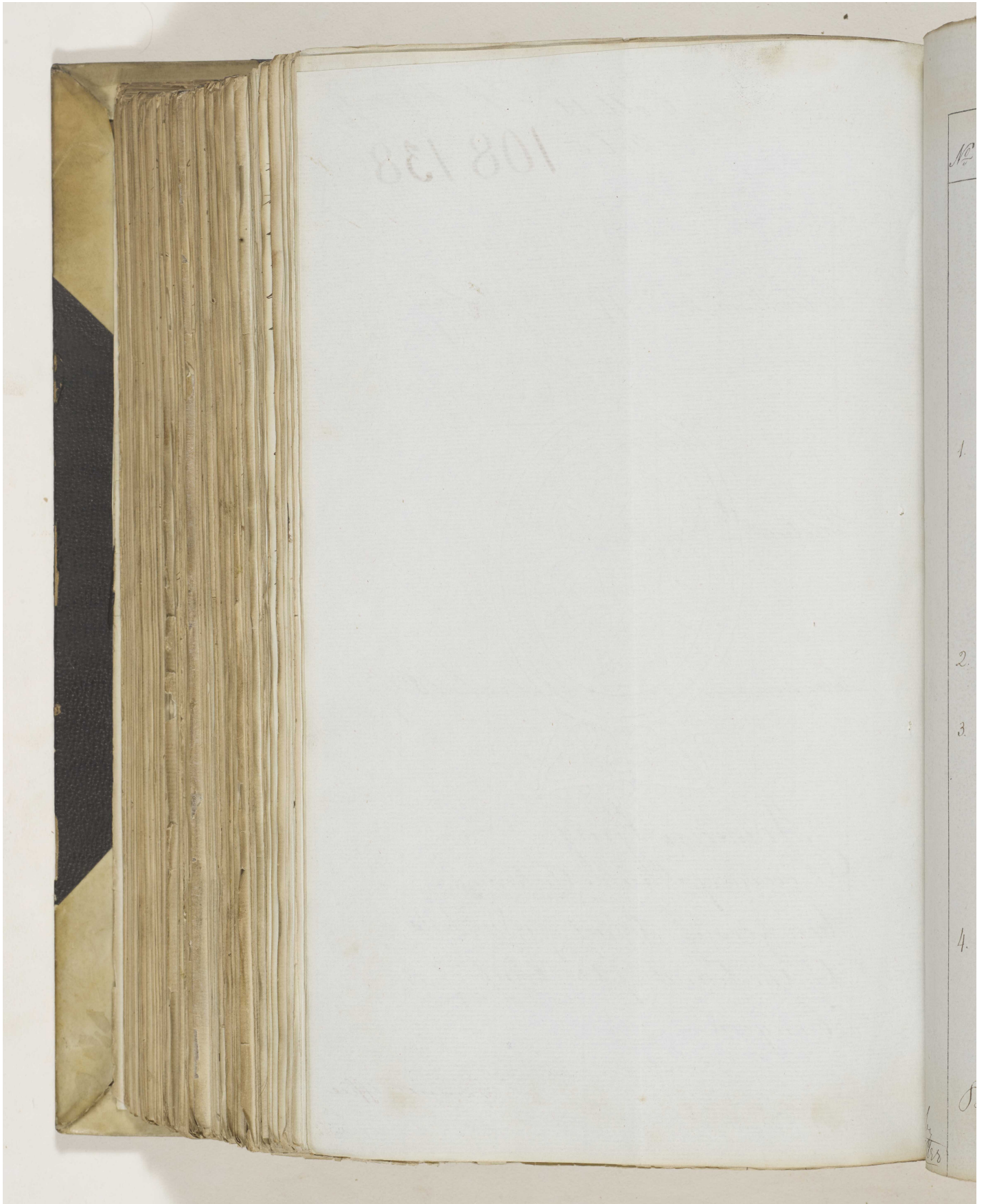

 I have the honor to report for
 the information of the Honorable the
 Governor in Council, the death of
 Sheik Mahomed ben Yoosof, the
 Chief of Nukheeloo who was shot
 by Sheik Houssain ben Jabarrak, the
 Chief of Congoon, while en route from
 Lar to the coast. The immediate cause
 of quarrel, I am informed was the
 refusal of Sheik Yoosof to carry into
 effect the orders of the Beyler Beg of
 Lar, for the transfer to the Congoon
 Sheik, of a strong Fortrefs called
 Behdah, in the neighbourhood of
 Gawbunde, which had formerly been
 in the possession of his father. On the

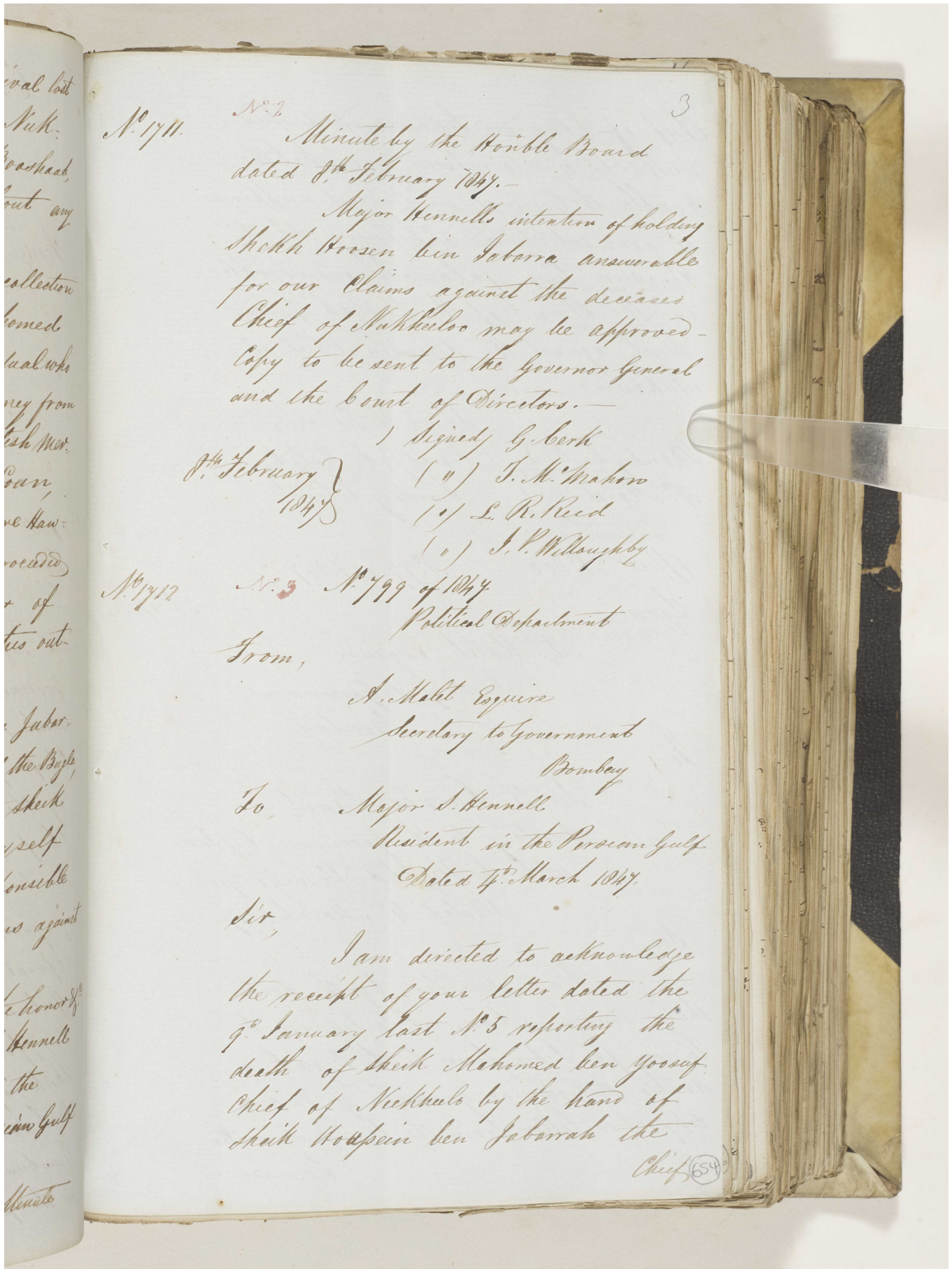
death of sheik yoosoof, his rival lost no time in taking possession of Nukheeloo, and the Island of Boashah, which he was able to do without any serious resistance.

2^d It will be in the recollection of Government, that sheik Mahomed ben yoosoof was the individual who forcibly seized a sum of money from the Hindoo Agent of a British Merchant under the pretext of a Loan, and against whom Commodore Hawkins with the Gulf Squadron proceeded, under sanction of the Governor of Fars, to enforce redress for this outrage.

3^d As sheik Koupsin ben Jabar-roh has taken possession of the Bugla, and other property belonging to sheik yoosoof, I shall consider myself justified, in holding him responsible for the amount of our claims against the deceased chief.
