
#### About this record



The item contains a contents page, and the title page of the item contains the following references: 'Draft 700/47, Coll[ection]: 18, Collection No 7 of No 37'.


































## 'Persian Gulf – Claim advanced by a Persian Merchant to be considered a British subject – Vol: 8' [675v] (8/12)




