#### About this record

This item consists of copies of correspondence and consultations cited in, or enclosed with, political letters from the Government of Bombay. These political letters appear in IOR/F/4/2174/105546. It is the twenty-fourth in a series of forty-five items on the Persian Gulf.

The item contains a letter from the Government of India to the Government of Bombay acknowledging receipt of a despatch reporting the actions of the Resident in the Persian Gulf in response to the reception afforded by the Shiek of Koweit [Shaikh Jābir I bin 'Abdullāh Āl Şabāḥ of Kuwait] to the Ex-Chief of Bahrein [Shaikh 'Abdullāh bin Aḥmad Āl Khalīfah, former Ruler of Bahrain].

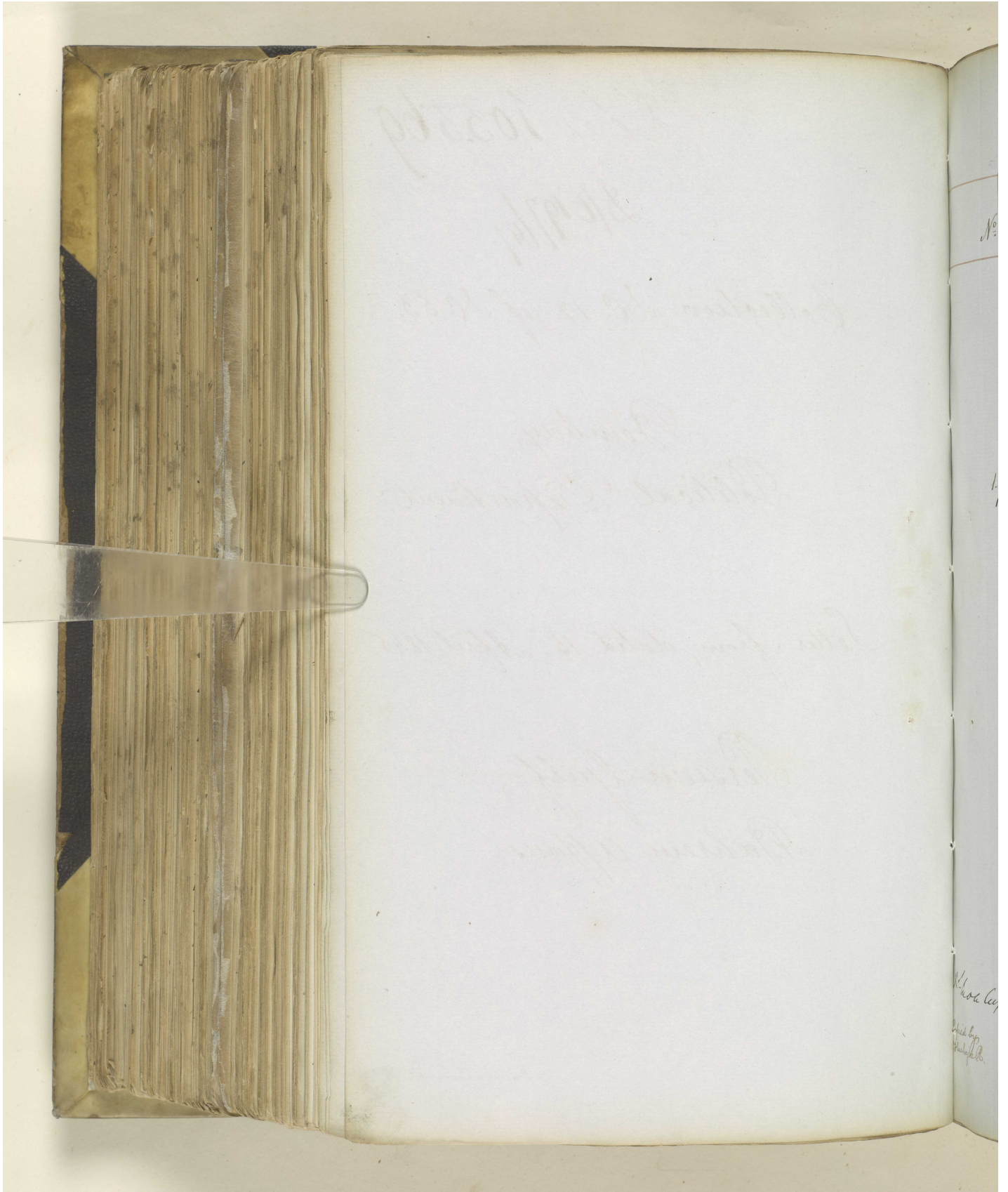
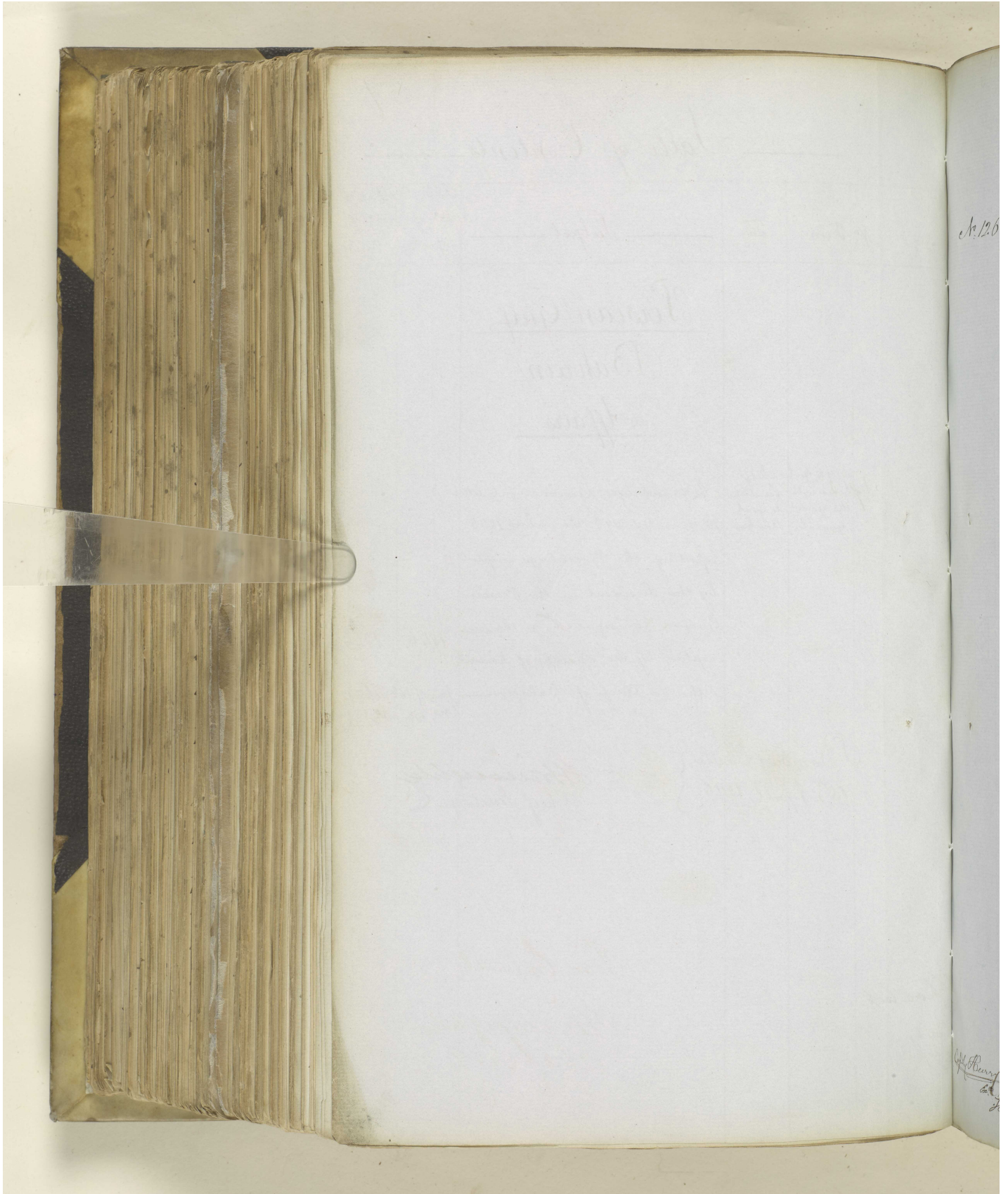
