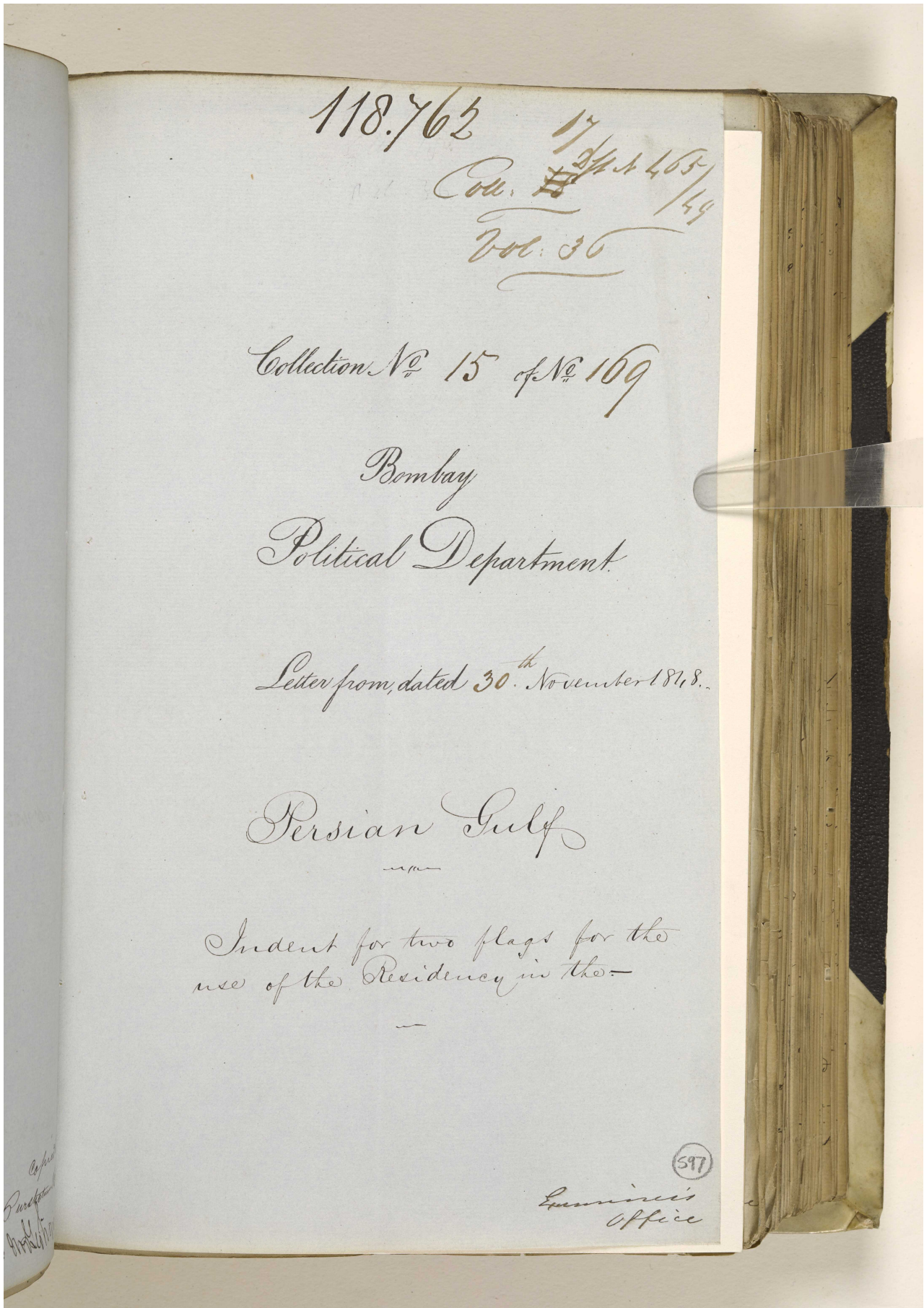
About this record

These political letters appear in IOR/F/4/2302/118727. The correspondents are the Government of Bombay and Major Samuel Hennell, Political Resident in the Persian Gulf. It is the thirty-sixth in a series of fifty-one items on the Persian Gulf.

The item concerns a request by Hennell for payment for two flags bought for the use of the Political Residency at Bushire [Bushehr].

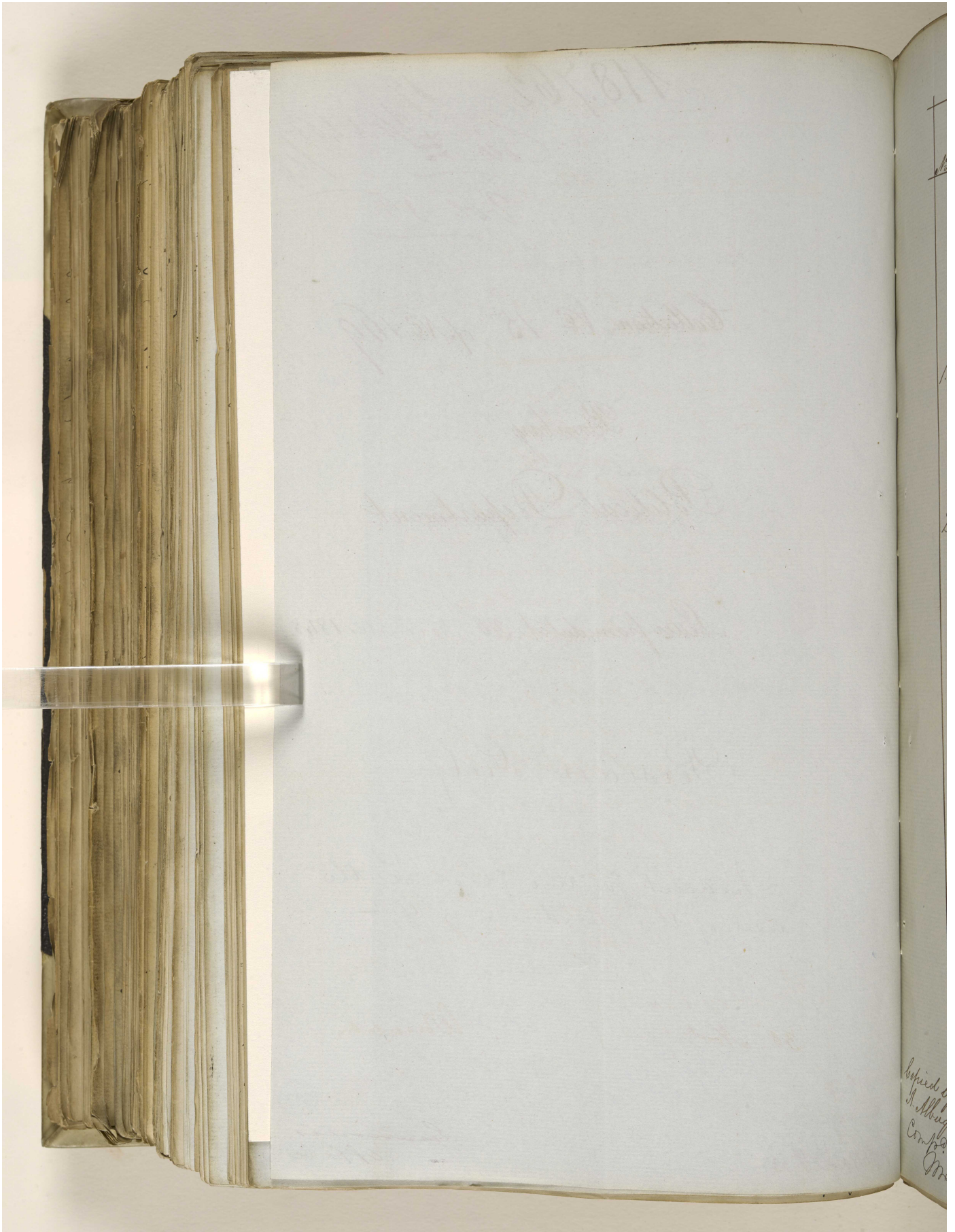


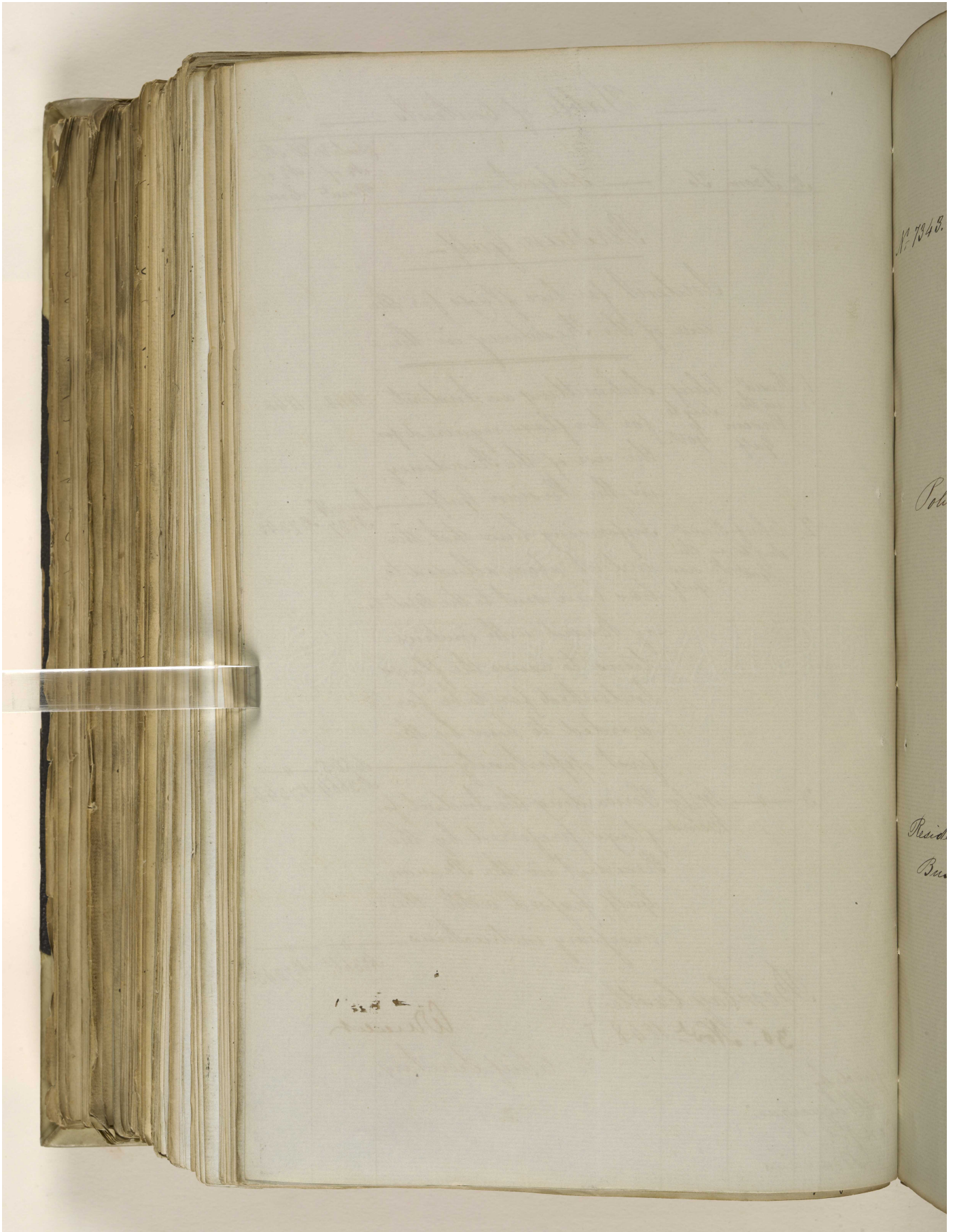

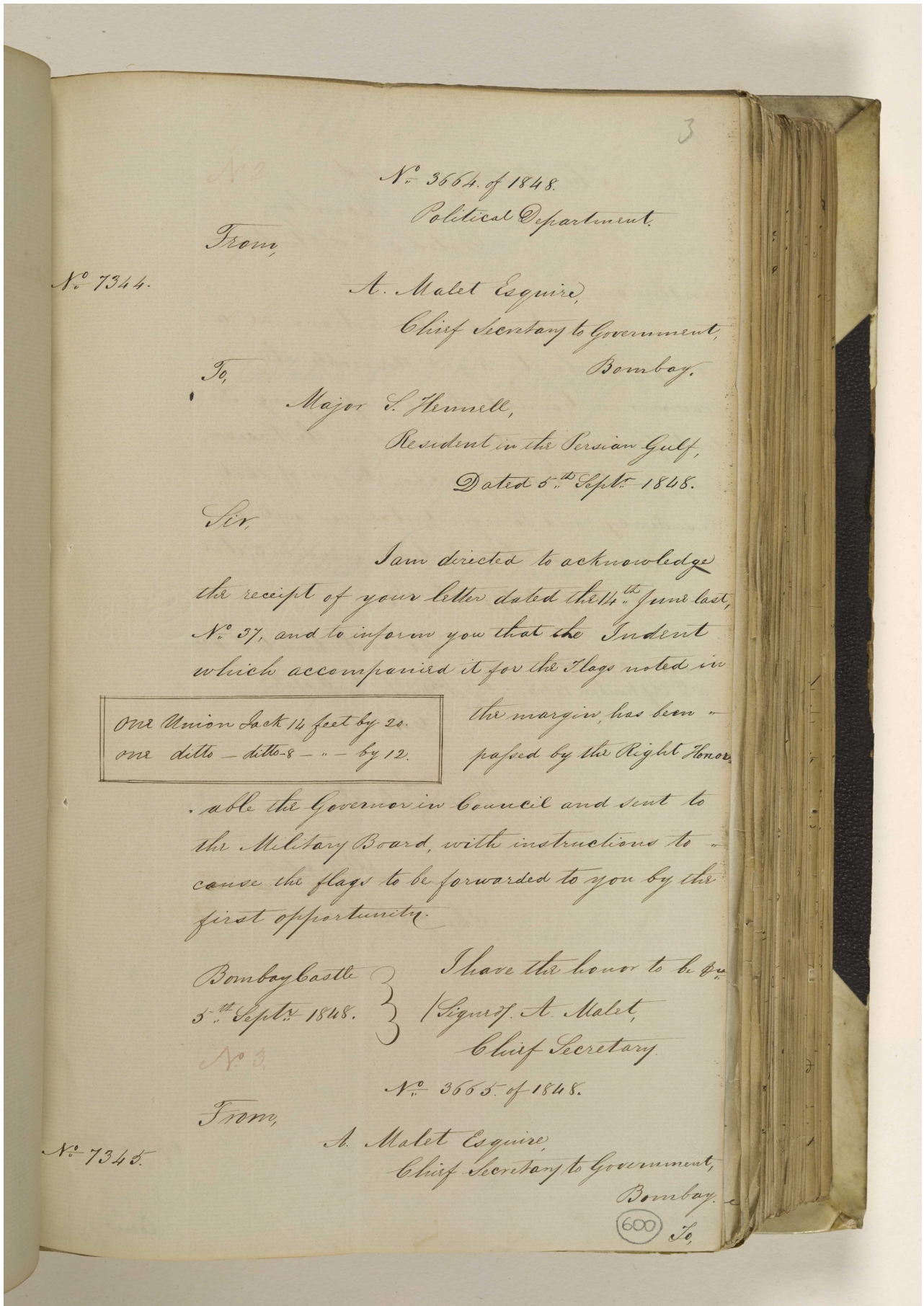
