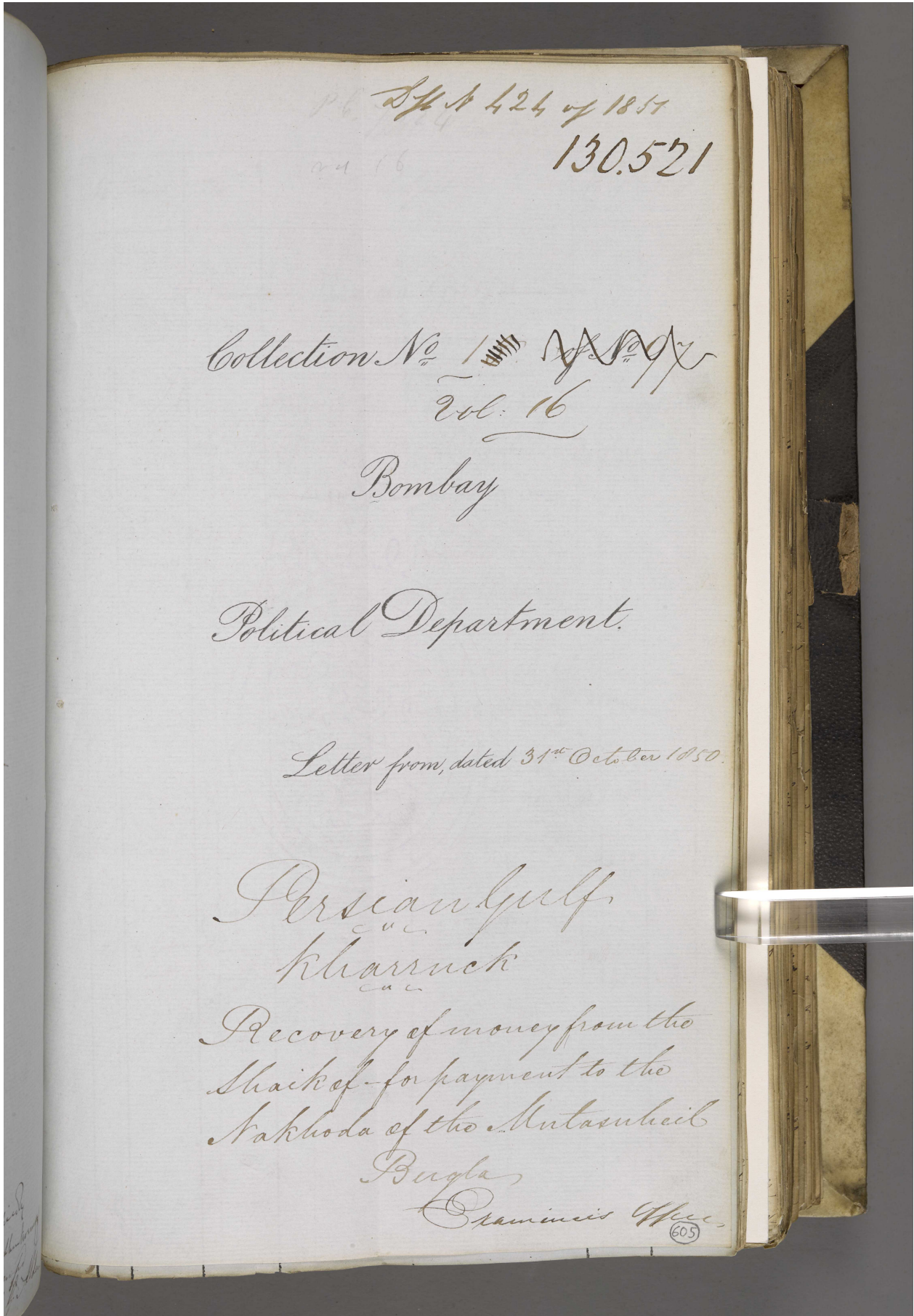
About this record

This item consists of copies of correspondence and consultations cited in, or enclosed with, political letters from the Government of Bombay. These political letters appear in IOR/F/4/2416/130506. It is the sixteenth in a series of twenty-eight items on the Persian Gulf. The correspondents are: the Government of Bombay and Lieutenant-Colonel Samuel Hennell, Resident in the Persian Gulf.

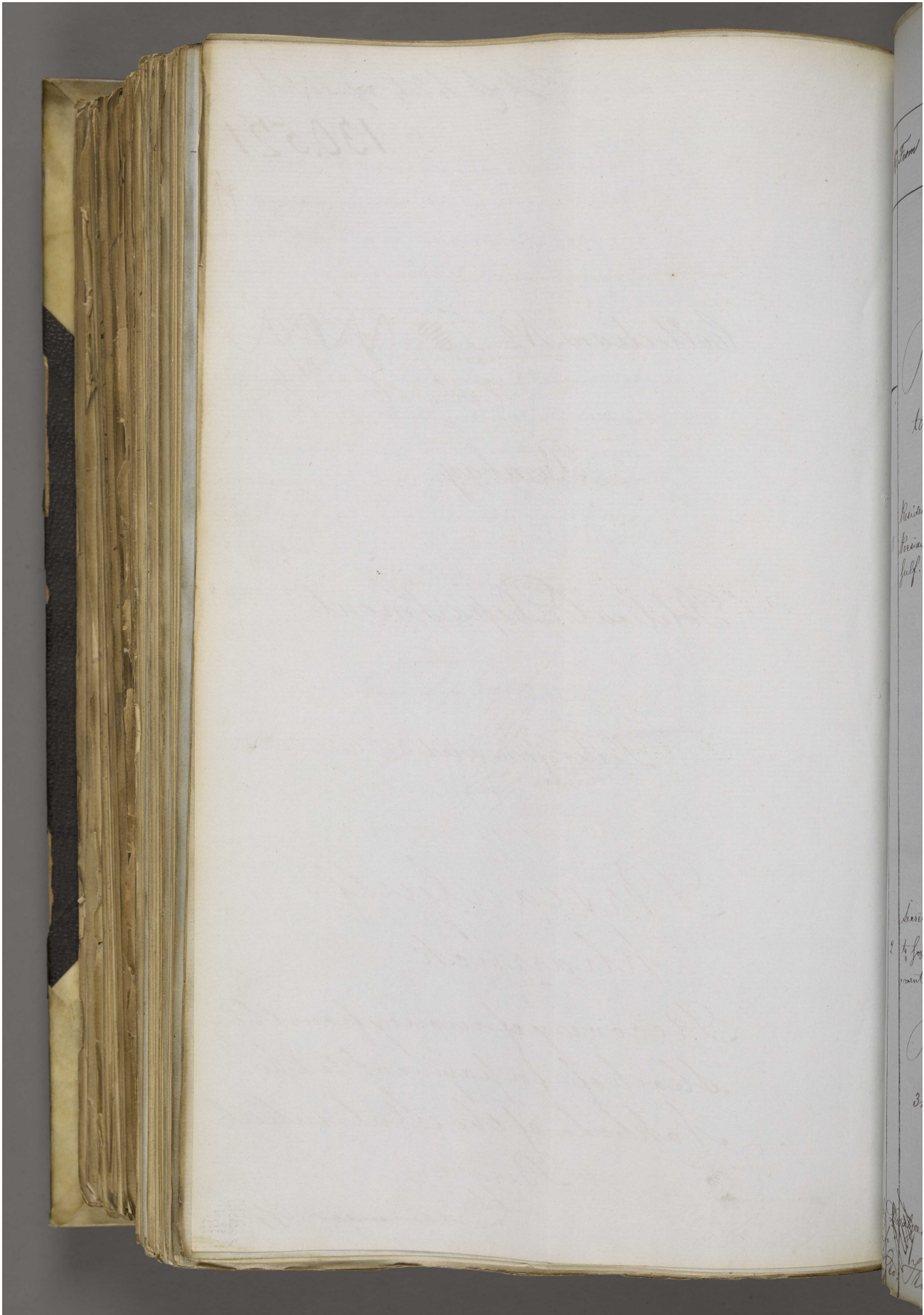
The item concerns a sum of money paid by the Sheik [Shaikh] of Charrack [Bandar-e Charak] for the value of some dates which were taken from the vessel *Mutasuheil* [*Mutasahhil*] when on shore off Charrack. Hennell asks for the sanction of the Government of Bombay for the amount to be paid to Mollah Mahomed [Mullā Muḥammad], the nakhoda [nakhuda] of the vessel.

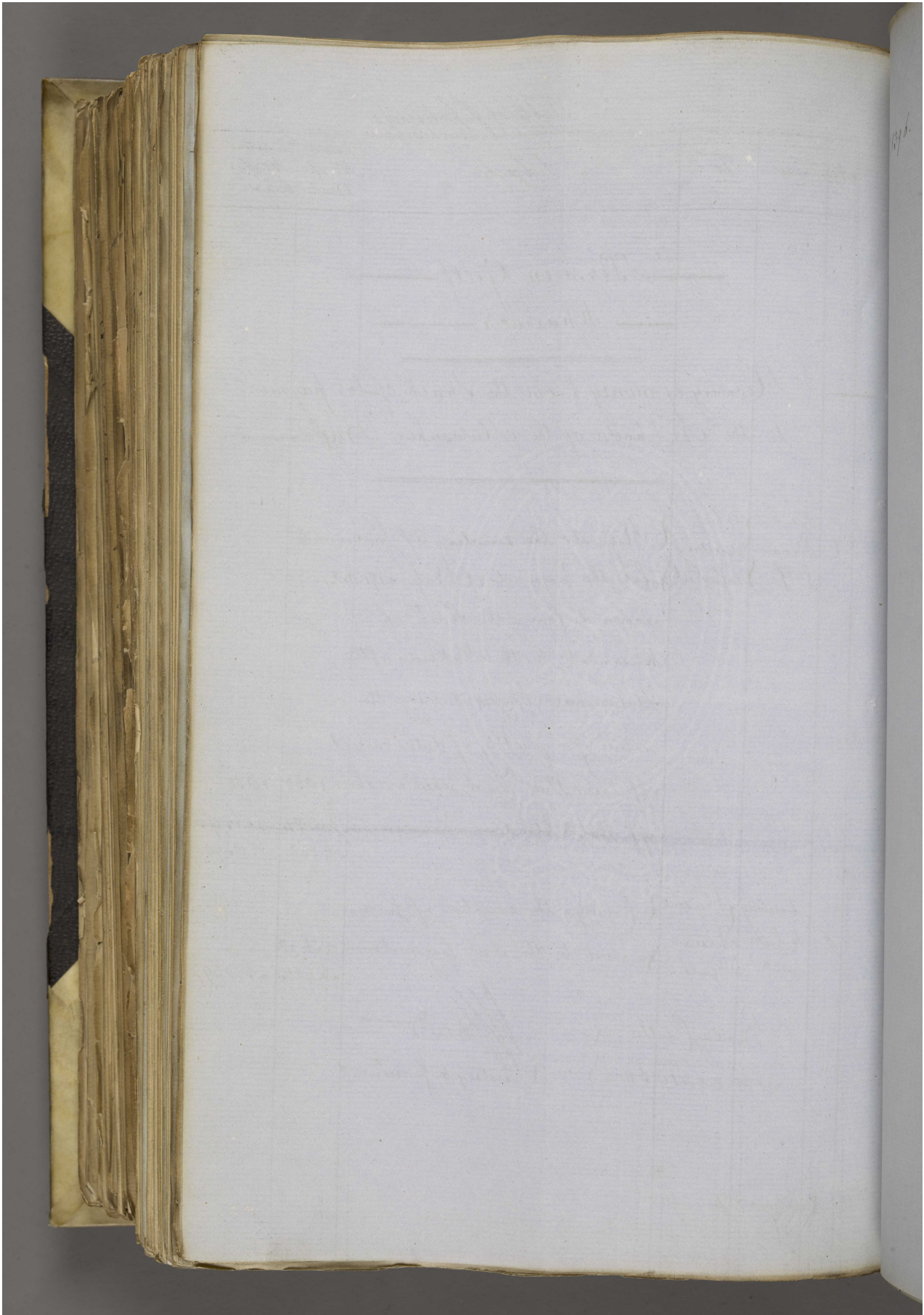

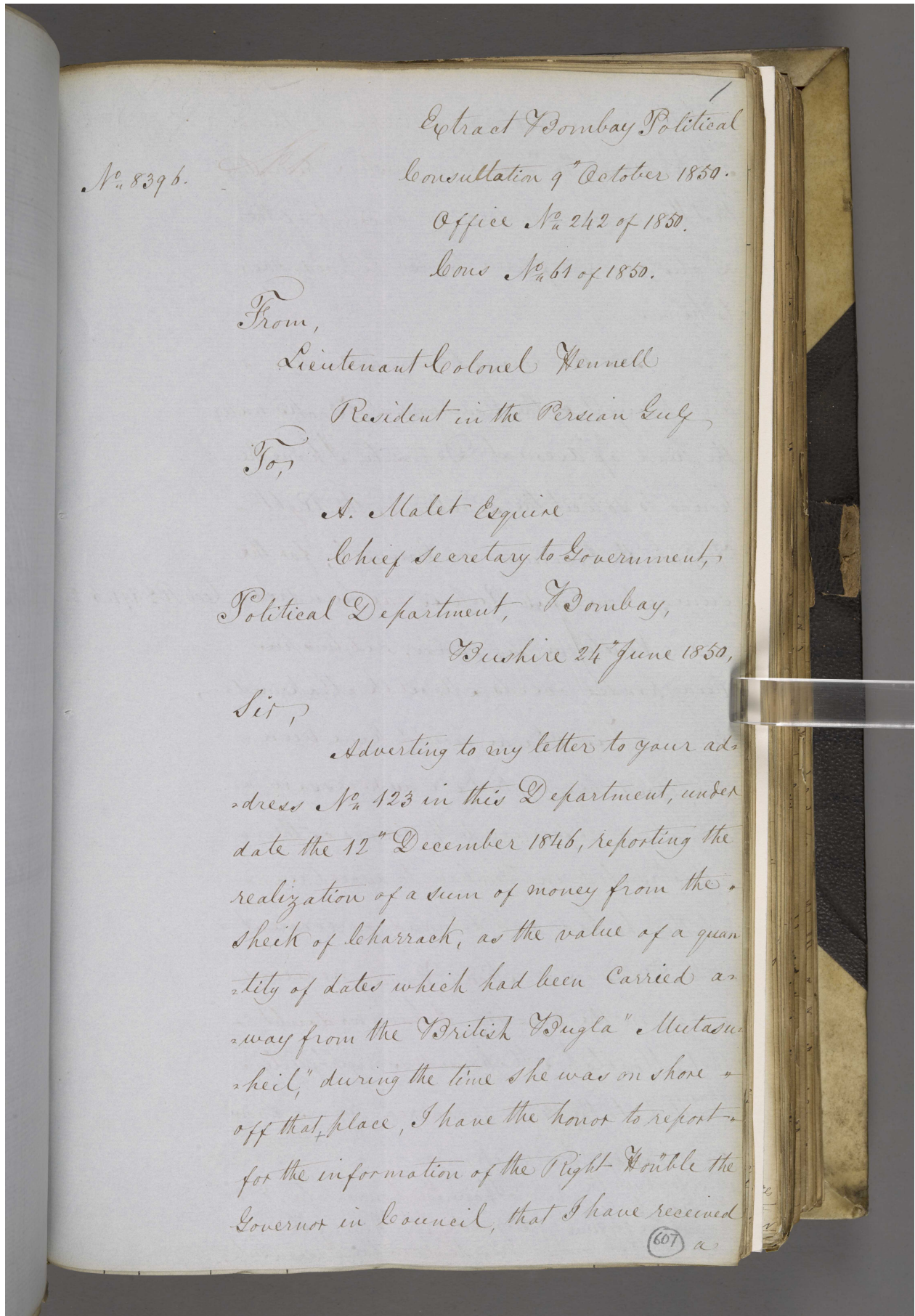

Adverting to my letter to your ad-
dress N^o 423 in this Department, under
date the 12th December 1846, reporting the
realization of a sum of money from the
Sheik of Kharrack, as the value of a quan-
tity of dates which had been carried a-
way from the British Bugla "Mutasu-
heil," during the time she was on shore
off that place, I have the honor to report
for the information of the Right Honourable the
Governor in Council, that I have received

a letter from Moola Mahomed, the Nakhoda of the Vessel in question, requesting that the value recovered on account of the Dates above referred to may be paid over to him.

2. As the amount in question has been brought in the Government Books under the head of "Account Deposits," I have the honor to solicit the sanction of the Right Hon'ble the Governor in Council, for the sum of Company's Rupees one hundred *Rs. 100. 6. 2.* and Ninety one, six annas, and two pies being handed over to Moollah Mahomed.

3 This claim would have been preferred before, but it was necessary to make a reference to the owner of the Mootasueh in Bombay, to ascertain whether he had any demand on account of the Dates in question; Having received a reply in the negative, I have no doubt that Moollah Mahomed is rightfully entitled to the sum recovered by us from the Chief of Charrack.


