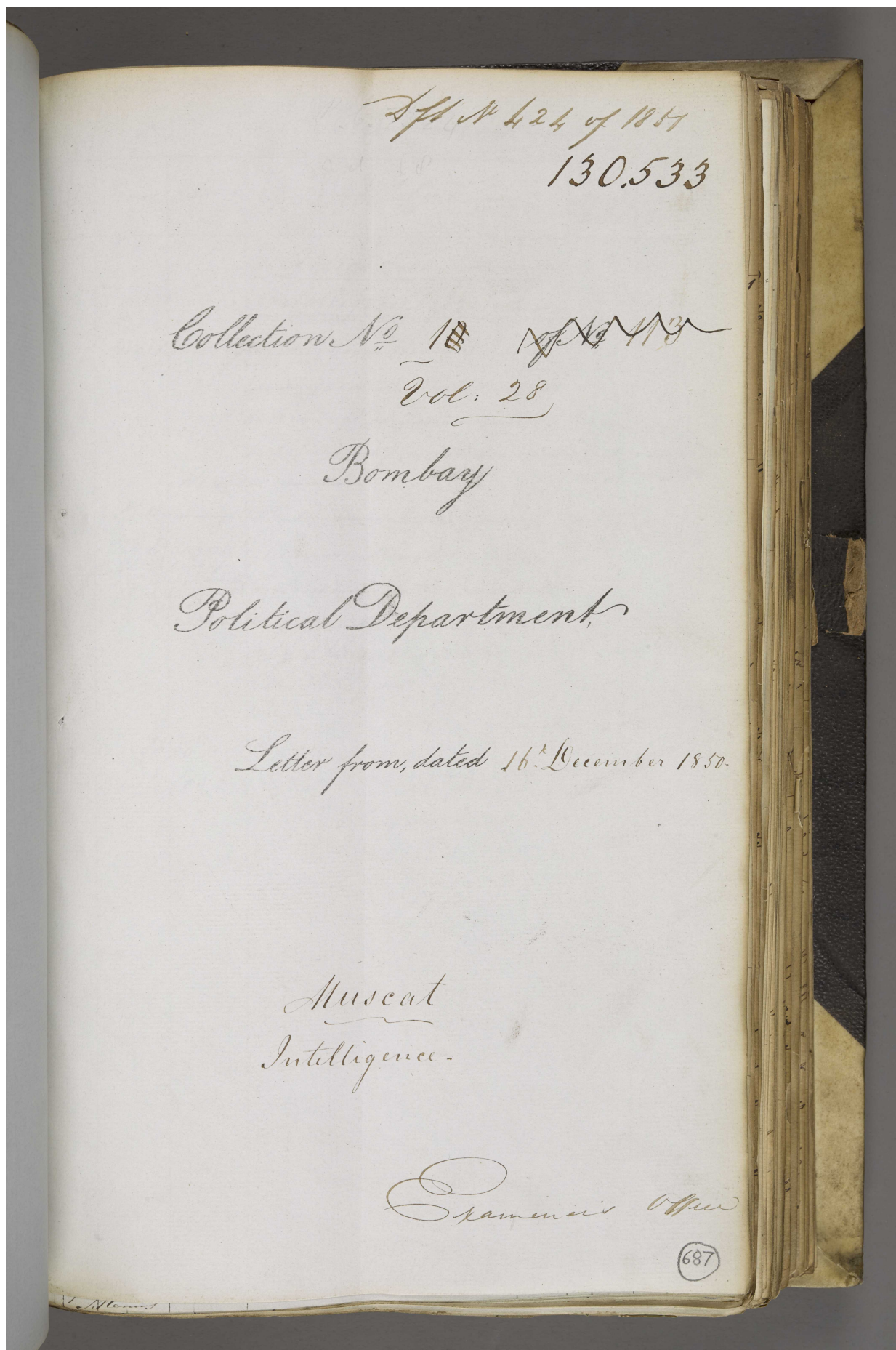
About this record

This item consists of copies of correspondence and consultations cited in, or enclosed with, political letters from the Government of Bombay. These political letters appear in IOR/F/4/2416/130506. It is the twenty-eighth in a series of twenty-eight items on the Persian Gulf.

The item contains two letters from Heskeal bin Yusoof [Khawājah Hizqīl bin Yūsuf], Acting Native Agent at Muscat, providing intelligence from Muscat. Topics covered include:

- The arrival and departure of various vessels
- The decision by Syud Thooeneē [Sayyid Thuwaynī bin Sa'īd Āl Bū Sa'īd] to send two hundred men to garrison Birka [Barka].

The item contains a table of contents (f 688), and the title page (f 687) contains the following references: 'Dft. No. 424 of 1851', Collection No. 1, Vol. 28', and 'Examiner's Office'.



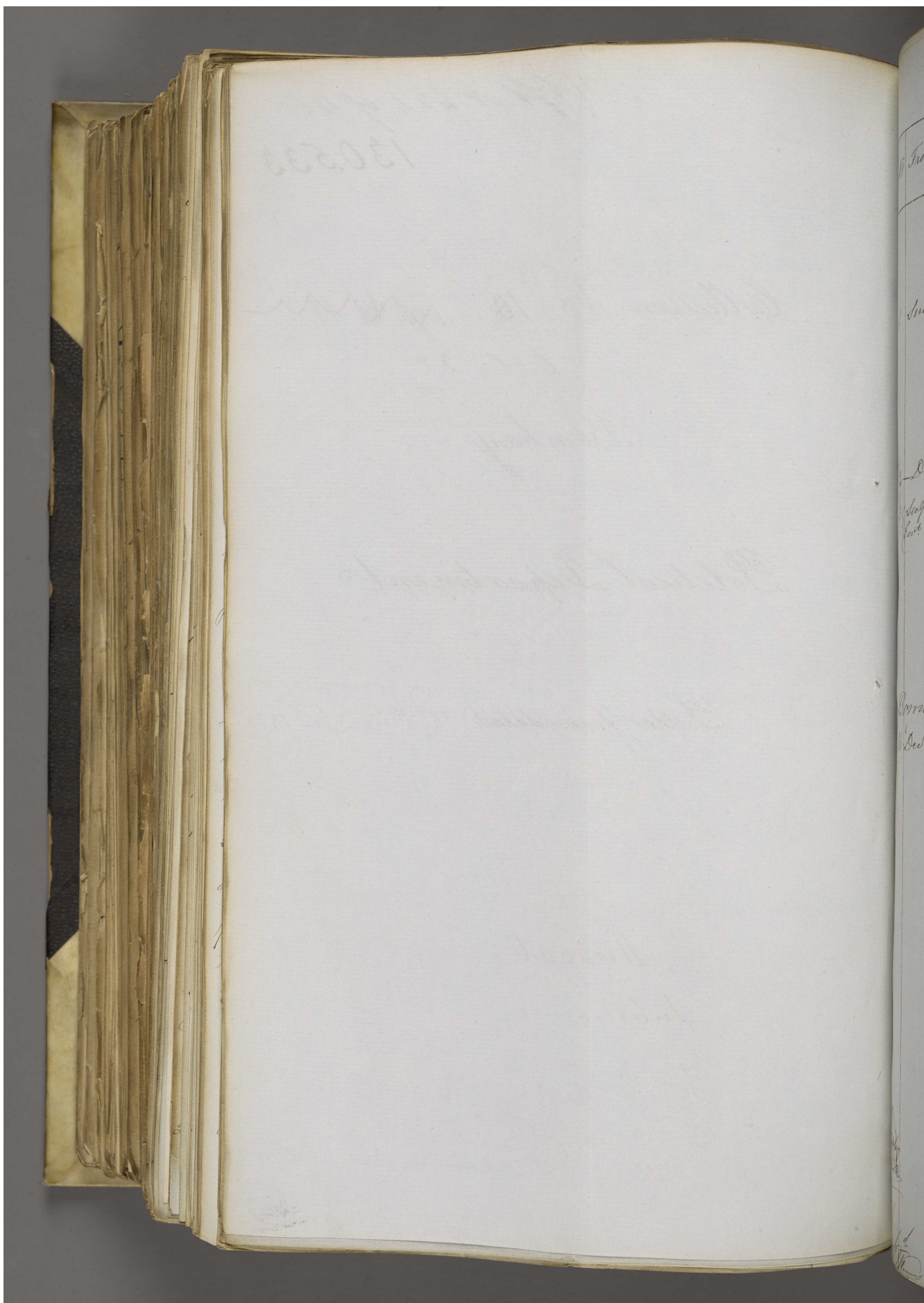

Substance of a letter from Heshial bin Yusoff acting Native agent at Muscat, to the Persian Secretary to Government dated 22^d September and received 25th October 1850.

On the 25th instant the "Caroline" belonging to His Highness the Imam of Muscat & commanded by Natkhooda Mahomed Malcolah left this for Calcutta.

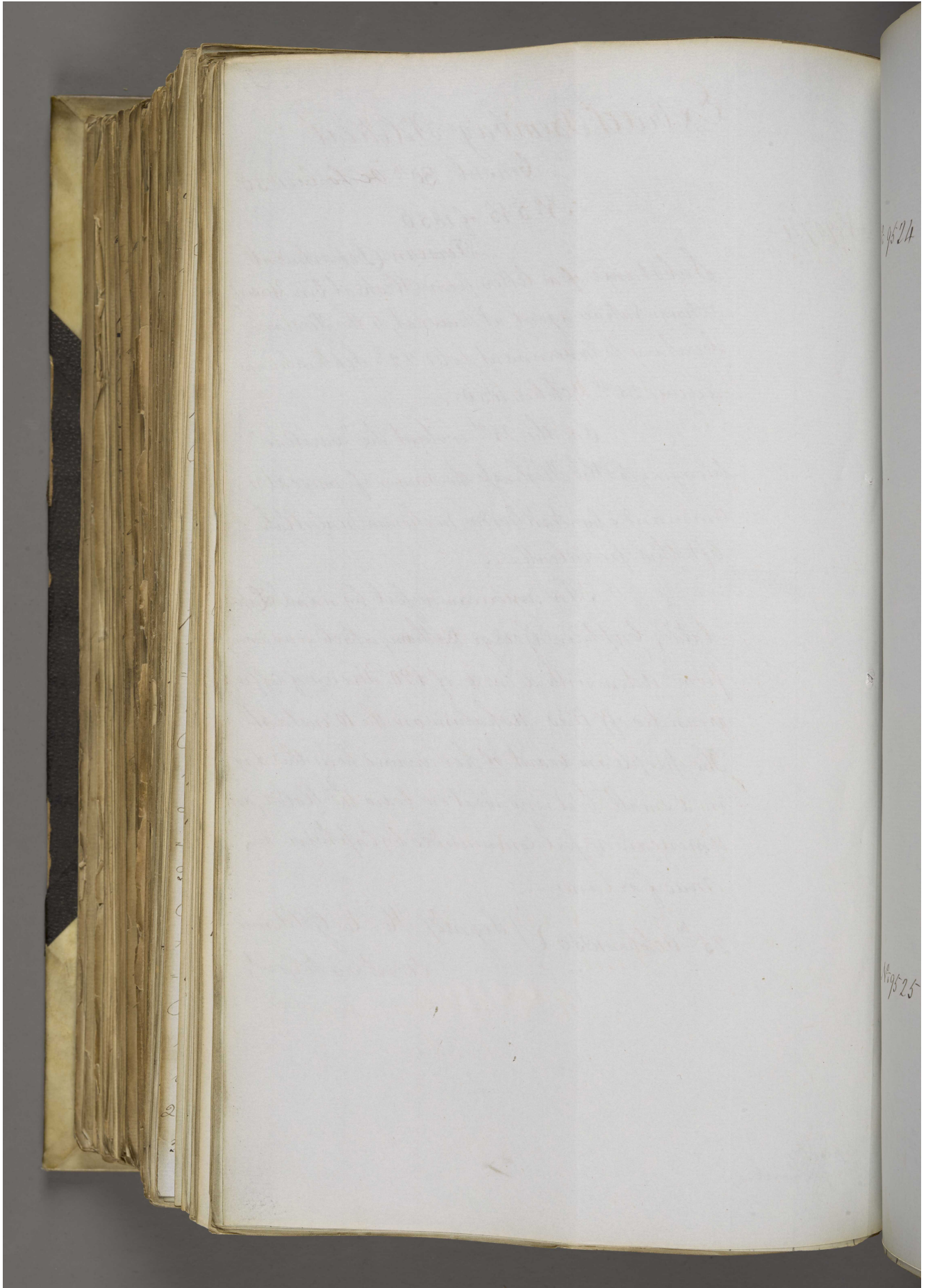
An American vessel by name "Lap-lata", Captain George Batham, which was coming from Aden with a cargo of 120 Firces of coffee grounded off Ras Meshalim on the 10 instant. The people on board of her arrived here this day in a small boat and went on board the Kalda, an American vessel commanded by Captain Macfarlane.
