About this record

A copy of a letter from Lord Elgin, HM Ambassador to the Ottoman Empire, to Harford Jones, Resident in Bagdad [Baghdad], sent from Constantinople [Istanbul] and dated 21 December 1799.

Elgin notifies Jones that he is dispensing with the use of cyphers in his communications with India.

Private.

Constantinople. The 21. Dec. 1799.

Sir

I have nothing to add, to Mr. Tooke's communication, of this date - and merely add the enclosed, that I may be enabled, to carry on my Correspondence, with India, without the great trouble, of copying. With the Assurance I request from you, and a similar one I demand from other persons similarly situated I shall be able to proceed in Business without Inconvenience.

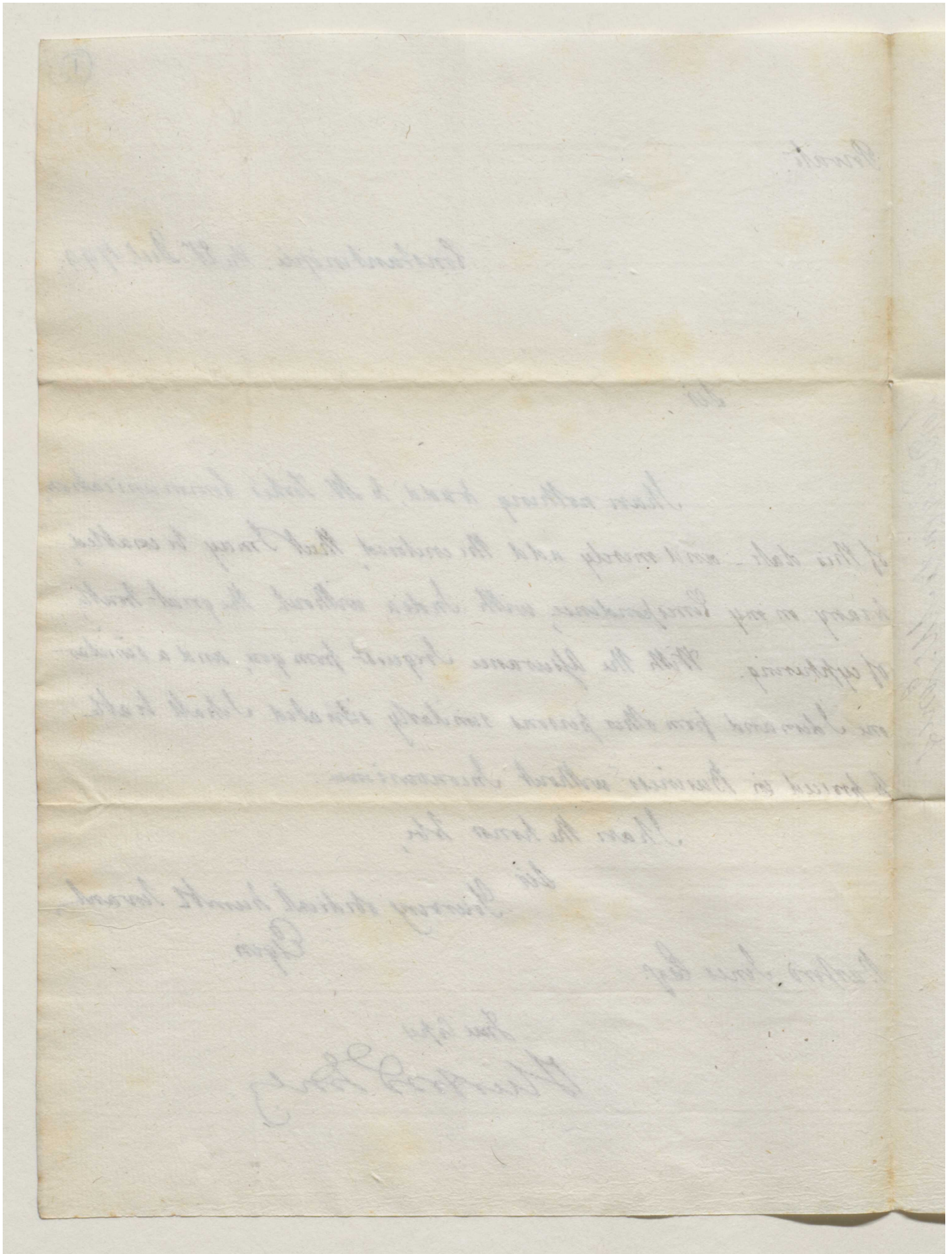

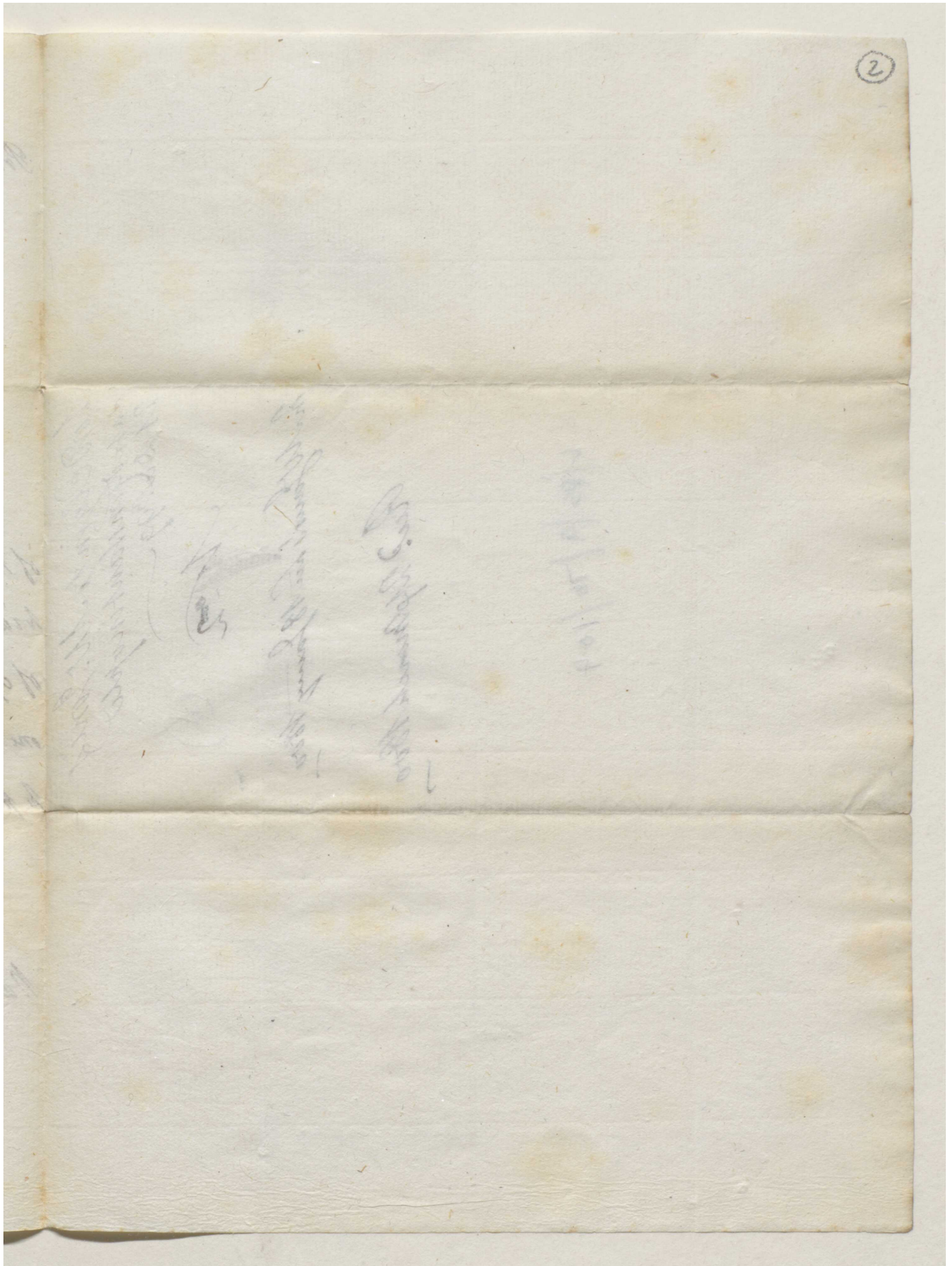

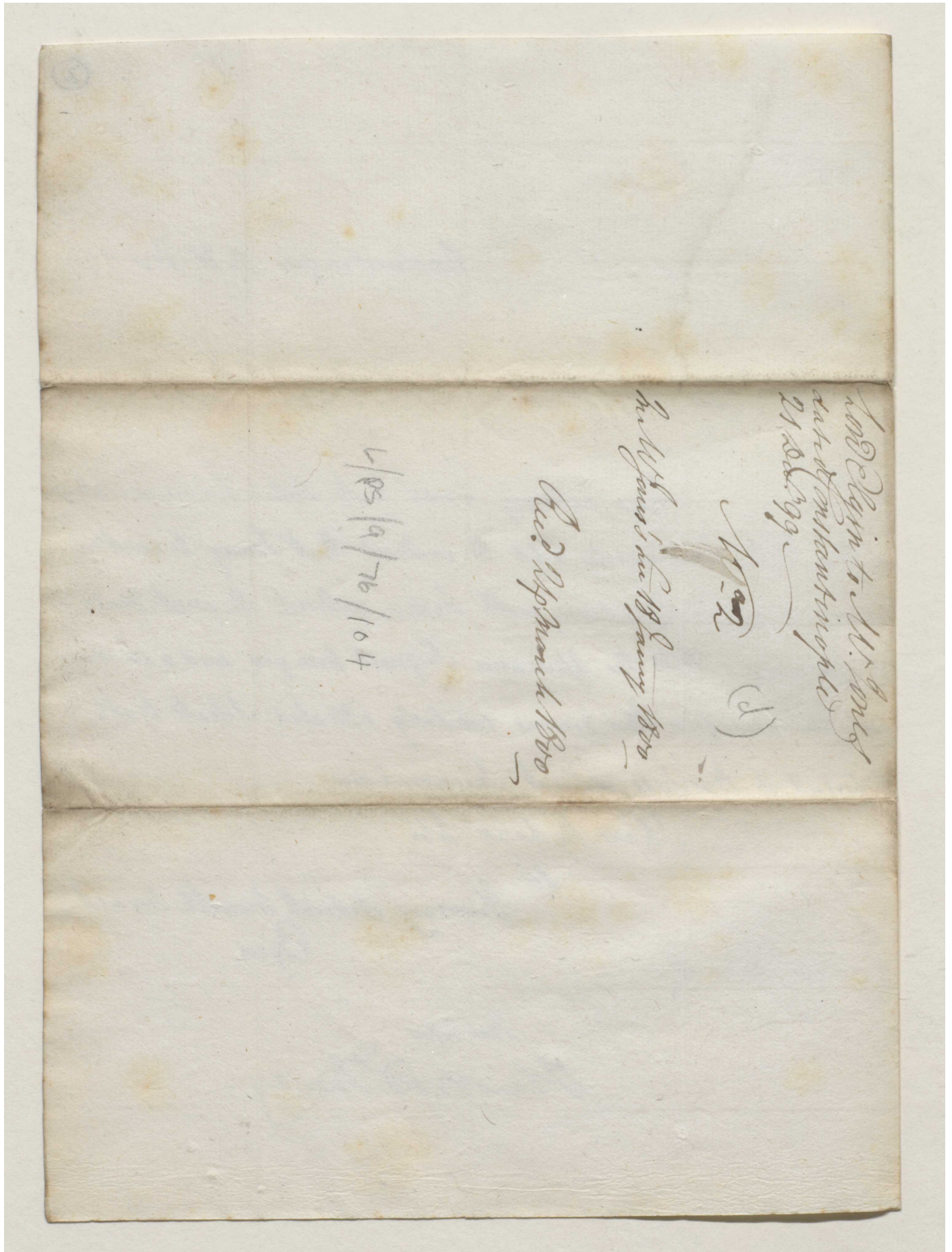
Letter from Lord Elgin to Harford Jones [1v] (2/4)
