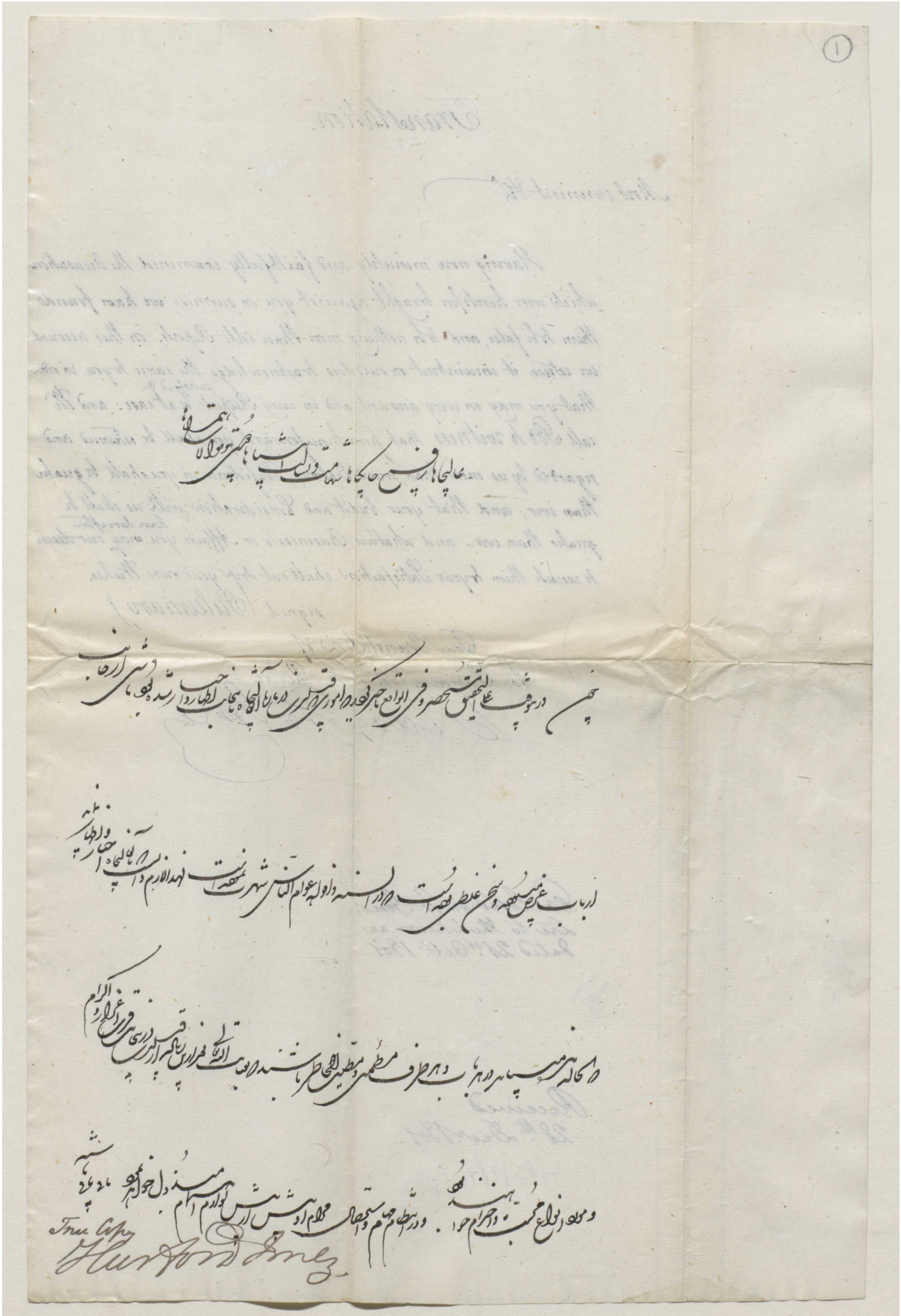

About this record

English and Farsi copies of a note from Suleiman Pashaw [Büyük Sulaymān Pāshā, Governor of Baghdad] to Harford Jones, Resident in Bagdad [Baghdad], received by Jones on 20 October 1801.

The Pashaw dismisses accusations against Jones (see IOR/L/PS/9/76/163) as groundless and affirms renewed trust in and esteem for Jones.



Letter from Sulayman Pasha to Harford Jones [1v] (2/2)

Translation.

Most eminent Sir

Having now minutely and faithfully examined the Accusations which were heretofore brought against you on surmise, we have found them to be false, and to be nothing more than idle Reports: on this account we return it incumbent on ourselves to acknowledge the same to you in order that you may on every account and in every Respect ^{be} at ease: and We call God to witness that from henceforward you shall be esteemed and regarded by us more than ever - that our Confidence in you shall be greater than ever; and that your Credit and Consideration with us shall be greater than ever - and whatever Business or Affairs you may ^{hereafter} have to transact shall out-strip your own Wishes.
