About this record

A copy of a letter from James Short, Surgeon at the Bagdad [Baghdad] Residency, to Harford Jones, Resident in Bagdad, sent from Bagdad and dated 29 December 1801.

In response to Jones's letter of 25 December (catalogued as IOR/L/PS/9/76/209), Short agrees to inform any member of the Government of Bagdad requesting medical treatment that such requests must be made via Jones.

Sir,

I have this moment the honor of receiving your official Letter of the 25th Instant, enclosing a Copy of the Orders to you of the Honble the President in Council at Bombay, dated the 1st August 1800, and although I am of opinion, both from the Letter and Spirit of these Instructions, that my appointment to the Medical Duties of the Durbier of the Pashaw of Bagdad, and that of acting under your Instructions, in affording you all necessary assistance, are of a distinct nature; Yet as you judge it politically necessary that all applications for Medical aid, from any person belonging to this Government, should be made through you; I shall in consequence thereof signify such, to all Persons of the above description, who may apply for my Assistance.

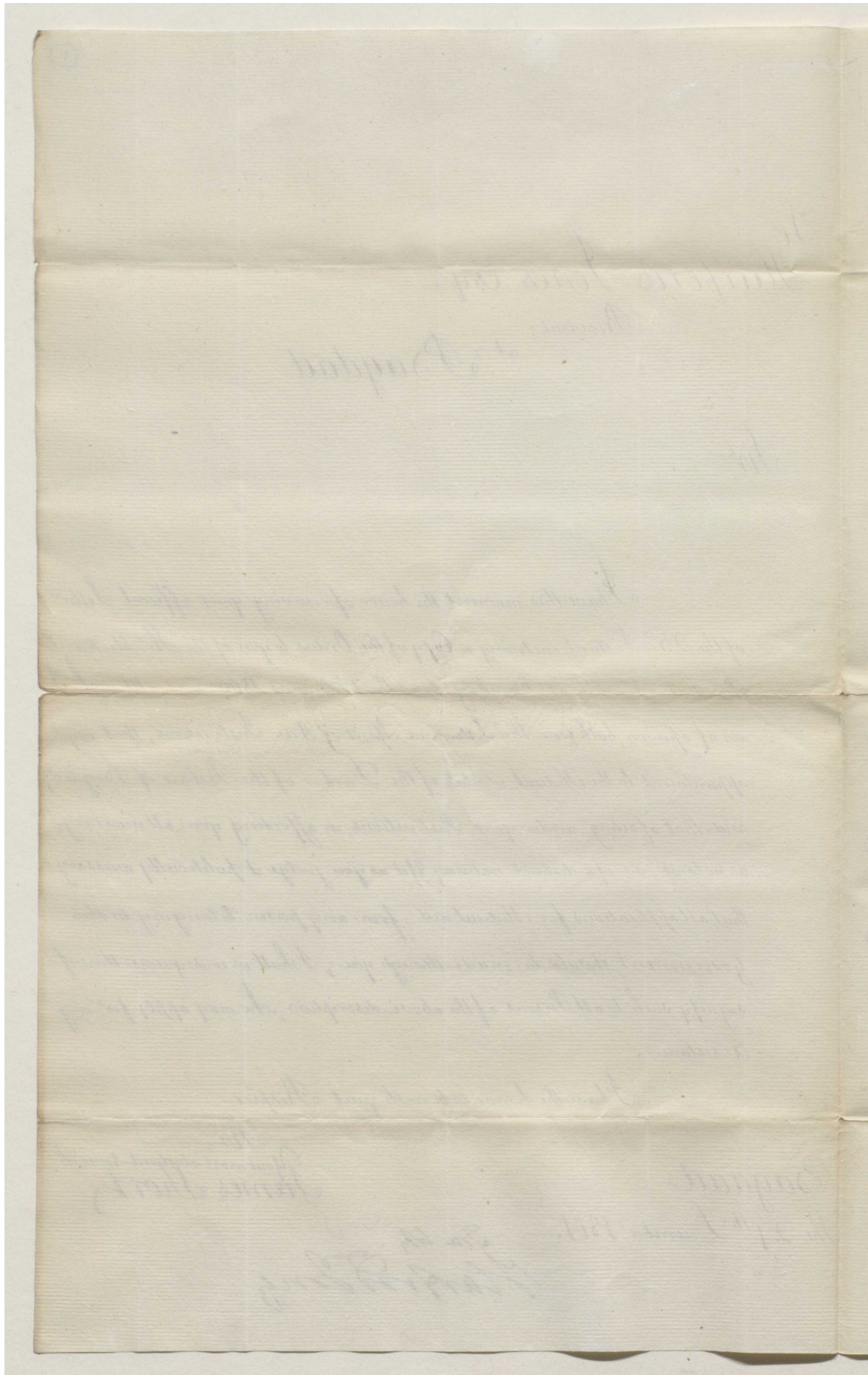

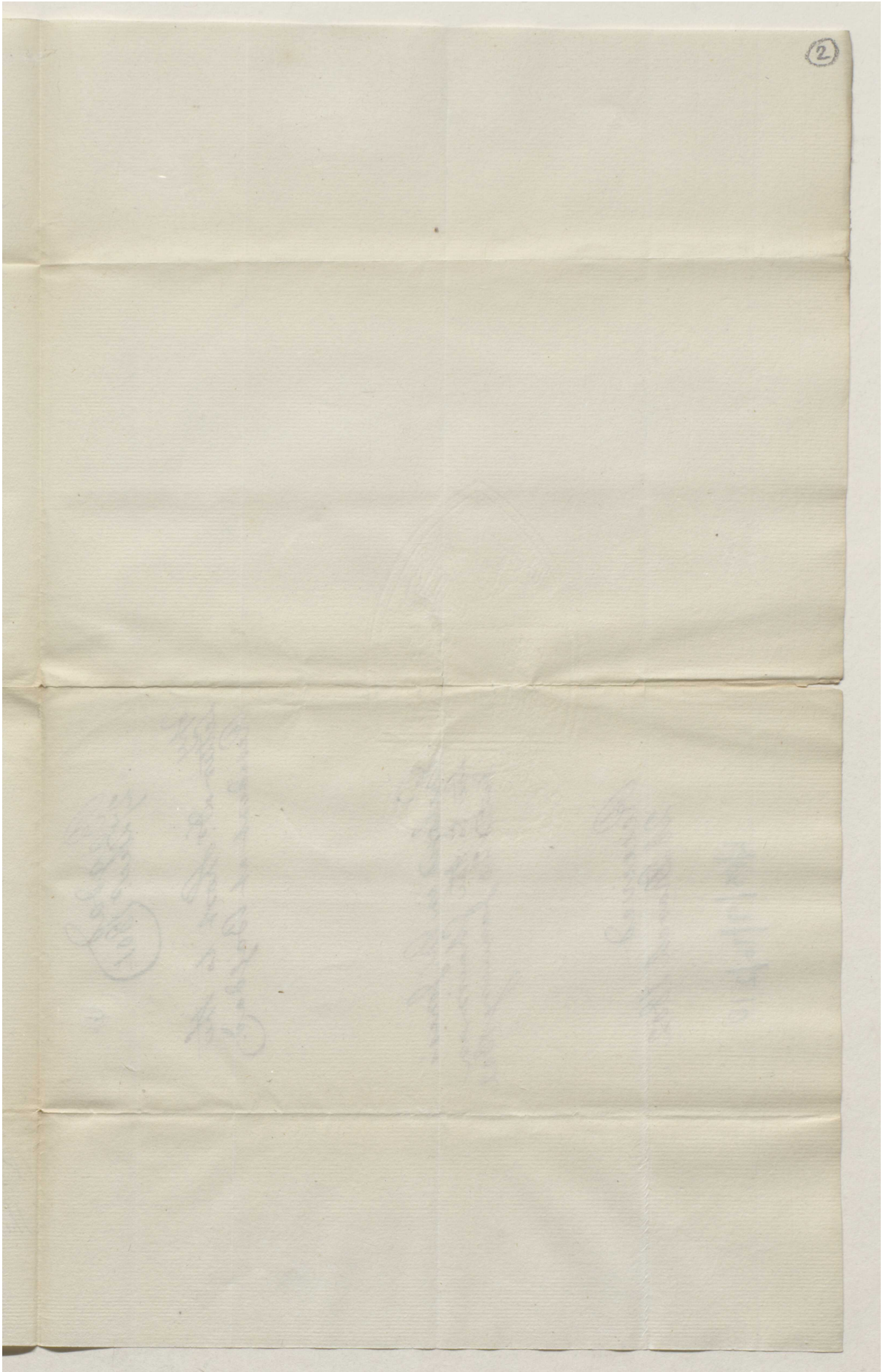
