to dispatch a large original Packet to the
Address of the Honble the Court of Directors,
unexpectedly received this day, by the Honble
Company's Brig, the *Viper*; with the Commands
of the Honble the President in Council of the
23rd September; and the enclosed small Packet
by your Address, from the President at Bombay.
I shall comply, in present communication
to the Honble the Court of Directors, on the
11th Instant, by your Commands of the 2nd of
September; and to the respectful Intimation
of

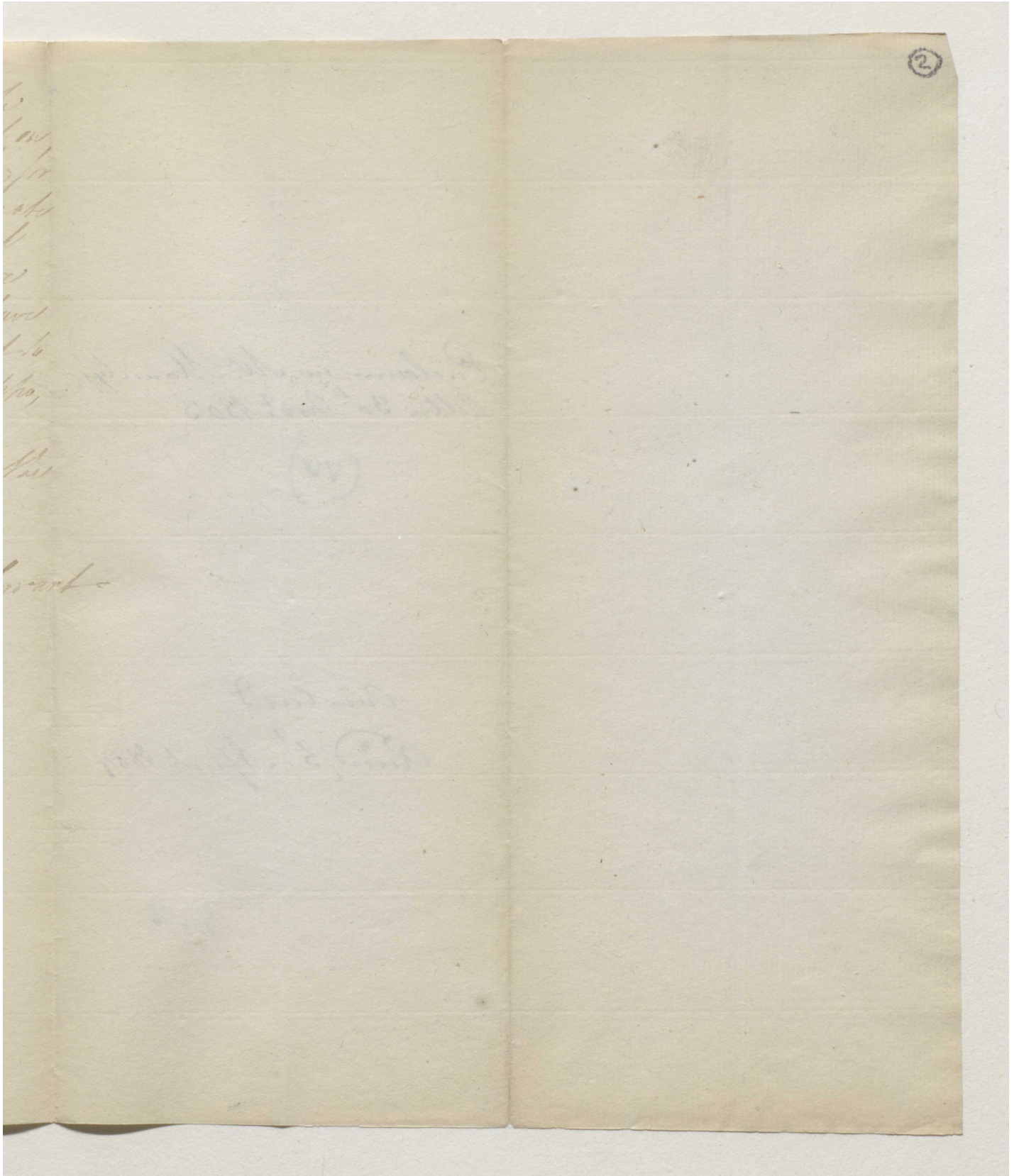

of the Dispatch of the important Packet for the
Commodore, by which they were accompanied, on
the 15th following, by Archdeacon King; but promising for
a few Days, the transmission, with a Duplicate
of the three Packet above mentioned, a general
Report, of late Events and Transactions here
an Exposition of the Circumstances, which have
induced me to adopt the Course of Negotiation
Contracted, in preference to that of Aleppo,
in the Service of my present Adversary.
